SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 4 proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Texas to provide a four year term of office for elective district, county and precinct offices...

Section 1. That Section 9 of Article V of the Constitution of the State of Texas be amended so as to read as follows: "Section 9. There shall be a Clerk for the District Court of each county, who shall be elected by the qualified voters for four years, subject to removal by information or by indictment of a grand jury, and conviction of a felony in case of vacancy the Judge of the District Court shall have the power to appoint a Clerk who shall hold until the office can be filled by election."

Section 2. The foregoing constitutional amendment shall be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of this State at an election to be held throughout the State on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 1954, at which election all ballots shall have printed thereon: "FOR the Constitutional Amendment providing for crediting to members of either the Teachers Retirement System or the Employees Retirement System of Texas all services rendered as either a teacher or as an appointive officer or employee of the State, for retirement benefits under either of said systems."

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION
 NO. 2
 proposing an amendment to Article
 IX of the Constitution of the State
 of Texas by adding thereto a new
 section to be known as Section 4,
 by providing that the Legislature
 may authorize the creation of county-
 wide Hospital Districts in cer-
 tain counties if approved by the
 qualified property taxpaying vot-
 ers at an election held for that pur-
 pose within such District; prescrib-
 ing the powers of such District; pro-
 viding for the submission of the
 proposition to the qualified voters
 of the State of Texas at an election
 to be held on the first Tuesday after
 the first Monday in November of
 1954; prescribing the form of bal-
 lot and providing for the necessary
 proclamation by the Governor and
 publication of notice.
**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGIS-
 LATURE OF THE STATE OF TEX-
 AS:**

Section 1. That Article IX of the
 Constitution of the State of Texas
 be, and the same is hereby amend-
 ed by adding thereto another sec-
 tion, to be designated as Section 4,
 which shall read as follows:
 "Section 4. The Legislature may
 by law authorize the creation of
 county-wide Hospital Districts in
 counties having a population in ex-
 cess of 190,000, and in Galveston
 County, with power to issue bonds
 for the purchase, acquisition, con-
 struction, maintenance and opera-
 tion of any county owned hospital
 or where the hospital system is
 jointly operated by a county and
 city within the county, and to pro-
 vide for the transfer to the county-
 wide Hospital District of the title
 to any land, building or equipment,
 jointly or separately owned, and
 for the assumption by the district
 of any outstanding bonded indebted-
 ness theretofore issued by any
 county or city for the establishment
 of hospitals or hospital facilities; to
 levy a tax not to exceed seventy five
 (\$75) cents on the One Hundred
 (\$100.00) Dollars valuation of all
 taxable property within such dis-
 trict provided, however, that such
 district shall be approved at an
 election held for that purpose, and
 that only qualified, property tax-
 paying voters in such county shall
 vote therein; provided further, that
 such Hospital District shall assume
 full responsibility for providing
 medical and hospital care to needy
 inhabitants of the county and there-
 after such county and cities there-
 in shall not levy any other tax for
 hospital purposes; and provided fur-
 ther that should such Hospital Dis-
 trict construct, maintain, and sup-
 port a hospital or hospital system,
 that the same shall never become a
 charge against the State of Texas,
 nor shall any direct appropriation
 ever be made by the Legislature for
 the construction, maintenance or
 improvement of the said hospital or
 hospitals. Should the Legislature
 enact laws in anticipation of the
 adoption of this amendment, such
 Acts shall not be invalid because of
 their anticipatory character."
 Section 2. The foregoing Consti-
 tutional Amendment shall be sub-
 mitted to a vote of the qualified
 property taxpaying voters of this
 State at the General Election of this
 year to be held on the first Tuesday after
 the first Monday in November, 1954,
 at which election all ballots shall
 have printed thereon:
**"FOR the Constitutional Amend-
 ment granting power to the Legis-
 lature to pass laws authorizing the**

creation of county-wide Hospital
 Districts in any county having a
 population in excess of 190,000
 and in Galveston County, and to
 levy a hospital tax;" and
"AGAINST the Constitutional
 Amendment granting power to the
 Legislature to authorize the crea-
 tion of county-wide Hospital Dis-
 tricts in any county having a
 population in excess of 190,000 and
 in Galveston County and to levy a
 hospital tax."
 Section 3. The Governor shall
 issue the necessary proclamation
 for said election and have the same
 published as required by the Con-
 stitution and laws of this State.
