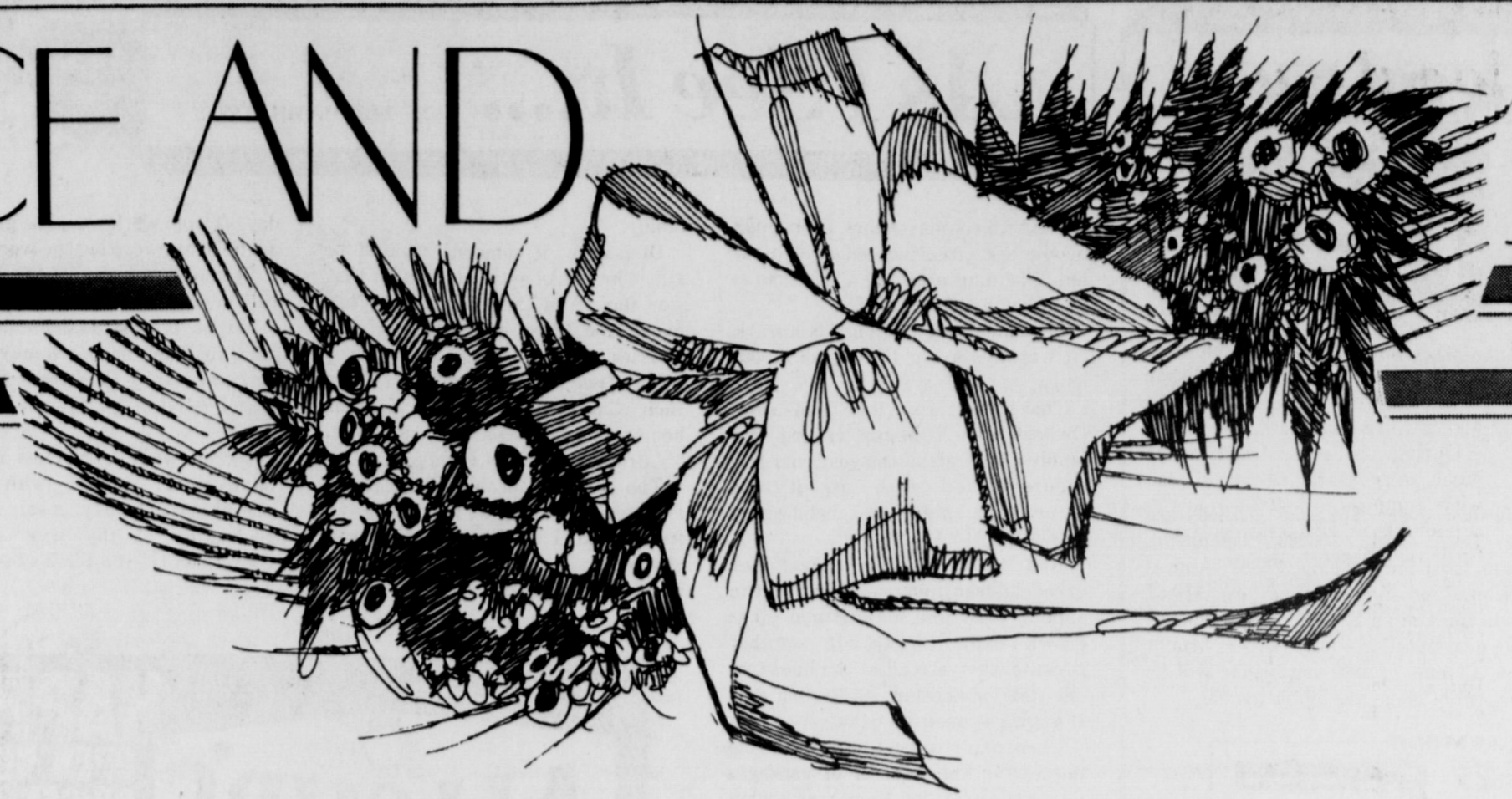

Maybe it was selfishness on my part, insisting on our family staying at home every Christmas. Maybe I feared reliving that Christmas of 1950 again.

I hope your Christmas is a big, happy one, shared with family, presents, a hearty meal, and the realization of the true spirit of Christmas... the birth of our Lord, Jesus Christ.

Recipes for Holiday Cooking

Christmas is a special time for cheerful gatherings of families and friends, joyful celebrations and happy memories. Each family wants the holidays to be full of meaning and as memorable as possible.

One of the happiest times of the season is experienced when families and friends gather around the table for the Christmas dinner and other meals during the holidays. Our cooks for this edition are sharing some of their favorite holiday recipes with us.

STRAWBERRY NUT BREAD

Sift together in large mixing bowl: 3 cups sifted flour, 1 teaspoon soda, 1 teaspoon salt, 1 tablespoon cinnamon, 2 cups sugar.

Combine, mixing well: 4 eggs, beaten, 1/4 cups vegetable oil, 2 cups thawed frozen strawberries, 1/4 cups chopped pecans.

Add strawberry mixture to dry ingredients, stirring just until moistened. Pour into 2 greased 9x5x3 inch loaf pans. Bake in 350 degree oven for 1 hour. Remove from oven and cool 5 minutes before removing from pans. Then cool on wire racks. Makes 2 loaves. You may want to line bottom of pans with wax paper.


