The Huttos were married Dec. 18, 1973, in Clovis N.M. and have lived in Iowa Park 12 years.







Hopefully the weather will hold no worse than it's been around here the past couple of weeks, and no one will have problems traveling.

And that includes Santa Claus!

Arson, burglary, drugs investigated Monday

When it rains, it pours, and that saying appears to be as much true for Iowa Park police as anything else.

Police had three major events to work Monday, including arson, burglary and possible apprehension of the suspects, and a dope arrest.

Answering a call shortly after 5 p.m. to Family Hairstyles, where vandalism was first described, police quickly determined they had an arson case on their hands.

Family Hairstyles occupies the old home economics building which is leased from Iowa Park school district.

Police found the front door had been broken to gain entry, and someone had poured some kind of liquid into the tanning room, to the right inside the front door, and started it

However, the culprit apparently did not understand fire, because he closed the door to the room, smothering the flames before it ignited anything but the wall covering and paint.

The can was left on the floor, and a book of matches from a Wichita Falls eating place nearby.

Mrs. Turman, owner, said the business was closed on Mondays, and the last time the building had been used was about 3 p.m. Sunday.

Acting police chief Mike Stark said his department is investigating and they have at least one suspect.

Damage, which was mainly to the tanning machine, was estimated at approximately \$4,500.

Some five hours later, at 10:10, a resident at 603 W. Texas reported a burglary. Norma Young told police she was missing a silver tea service and costume jewelry.

Then at 11:35 p.m., according to the police blotter, officers Tom Stephens and Roy Ross reported to the radio dispatcher that they were in pursuit of two men on a motorcycle.

The two, when captured, became suspects in the burglary case, though reasons for suspicision was not told. Traveling east on the old highvehicle just after it passed Bell Road, and the rider was stopped near the entrance to Pleasant Valley Estates.

Taken Tuesday morning before Justice of the Peace Virgil Hill and later to the county jail were: Russell Ray Thomas, 31, of Wichita Falls, charged with burglary of a habitation; and Billy Eugene Hodges, 28, of Iowa Park, charged with burglary of a habitation and eluding officers.

Hodges, according to the blotter, also has outstanding warrants from Wichita County for one count of forgery and two counts of theft.

Monday got its start for police at 1:56 a m., when Kerby Ernest Devers, 25, was taken into custody in the 700 block of East Highway. He was charged with public

intoxication and possession of less than two ounces of marijauna. Devers was released at 7:59 a.m.

Wednesday night of last week. Paul Guyette reported his home at 307 W. Pecan had been burglarized of jewelry and video equipment. The front door had been forced open to gain entry, according to police.

New chief of the Iowa Park

Sheffield said he plans to be on the job the week of Jan. 5.

Selection of the new chief ends a search which commenced with the Oct. 17 resignation of former chief Bob Dean.

The 15-year-veteran of law enforcement will move here with his wife, Loretta, from Crystal Beach, where he has served as chief of that department since June of 1984.

A graduate of Lamar High School in Houston, Sheffield attended Houston Community College, San Jacinto Junior College, the University of Houston and numerous inservice schools.

He began his law enforcement career when he joined the police department of West University Place, a Houston suburb. After seven years he operated a private security firm one year, and then sold his interests and joined the Wharton County sheriff's department where he became director of the major crimes task force and served one year as sheriff when the elected official died.

Crystal Beach is a tourist community of about 1,500 population across the bay from Galveston that has a summer-time population of as many as 20,000.

His department is compared with Iowa Park's, personnel-wise, with seven regular officers and a full compliment of radio dispatchers. But it adds eight part-time officers when the summer population arrives.

A large man, Sheffield stands 6-7 and weighs about 285 pounds.

"I want the citizens to feel they can come in and talk with me, and what they have to say will not fall on a deaf ear. We'll have an open door policy," he said.

Mrs. Sheffield was raised on a South Dakota ranch.

Bill would increase penalty for animal cruelty offense

Rep. Charles Finnell introduced a bill Monday which would increase the penalty for second offense cruelty-to-animals convic-

House Bill 151, which has been pre-filed by Finnell in anticipation of the convening of the 70th Legislative Session on Jan. 13, is designed to discourage mistreatment of animals by raising the penalty for a second or subsequent conviction from a Class A misdemeanor to a third-degree felony.

"Malicious and continued cruelty to animals should not be tolerated as it is when even a second convention is a mere misdemeanor.

"A third-degree felony carries the threat of a prison term and the possibility of a fine up to \$5,000," he said.

"Hopefully, the stigma of a felony and a prison term will help to discourage the repeated cruelty to defenseless creatures," Finnell added.

'Off-road' vehicles prohibited at lakes

Iowa Park city council Monday night named a new police chief, discussed possible improvements on the Lake Buffalo dam, and amended an ordinance which prohibits any "offroad" vehicles on city property.

Bypassing a scheduled executive session, the council unanimously approved Alan Sheffield of Crystal Beach as the new chief of police.

Mayor Tim Hunter explained the council had received 20 applications for the position, had narrowed the field to six based on resumes, and held interviews with the finalists.

"It was a tough decision. We had six strong folks" to consider for the position, Hunter said.

Because of damage being caused to the dams at Lake Iowa Park and Buffalo, as well as tearing up terrain in those areas, and also possible liability insurance problems, aldermen unanimously approved a proposal to prohibit vehicles to be driven on any city property. Riding of animals was included.

Sections approved included:

* It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or propel any motorized vehicle or drive or ride any animal in, over, or through any park except upon designated drives, roads, streets or parking areas:

* It shall be unlawful for any unauthorized person to drive or propel any motorized vehicle not currently and legally licensed by the state for "on-road" use on any city-owned property. This section shall be interpreted to include, but not be limited to parks inside and outside the city limits, lake property, and any other real estate which the city may own at

* The property owned by the city in conjunction with Lake Buffalo and Lake Iowa Park is expressly included for all purposes within the scope of this chapter;

* It shall be unlawful for any unauthorized person to remove, destroy, multilate, damage, or deface in any way any structures, dam, sign, monument, statue, vase, fountain, wall, fence, railing, vehicle, bench, tree, shrub, fern, plant, flower, or other property in any park or playground inside or outside the city limits;

* It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or propel any motorized vehicle on any part of the dams at Lake Buffalo and Lake Iowa Park except on the designated roads at the crest of the dam and the access road at the bottom of the dam.

City Engineer Kerry Maroney discussed an allegation by the Texas Water Resources Board that the Lake Buffalo dam was unsafe.

He explained the allegation was made based on a weather situation which apparenly has never occurred, but a response from the city to the

Maroney told the council the lake has a watershed of 33 square miles, and the state's "Probable Maxiumum Flood" situation could possibly pose a threat to residents downstream.

The maximum flood, according to the state, could come about by a 15-inch rain, followed 15 days later by a 30-inch rainfall on the watershed occurring over a 24-hour period.

The state probably expects additional emergency spillway areas to be constructed and/or the dam raised by another five feet, Maroney said.

Council members authorized Administrator James Barrington to draft a letter of response to the state agency which would not specify any actions to be taken by the city, but to at least acknowledge that the city is aware of state demands.

Other actions of the council at the meeting included:

* passed a resolution appointing Greg Lynn to the Wichita County 9-1-1 communications district board of directors.

* heard a report the city did not receive a bid for grazing leases at either of the city's lakes, which had been advertised;

* authorized the administrator to advertise for bids items of surplus property;

* amended the electrical code; * approved an ordinance which requires work vehicles of building contractors to be identified with signs on their sides;

* amended the ordinance defining junk vehicles;

* and denied a request that stop signs be placed at intersections along East Washington between Victoria and Bell.

Mayor Hunter also displayed the

new logo of the city's which will be put on all city vehicles. Design of the logo was sought

by the city a few months ago, with a \$50 prize to the winning designer.

Council members held a short ceremony when the prize was presented to Mike Price, city public works director, for his winning design.
