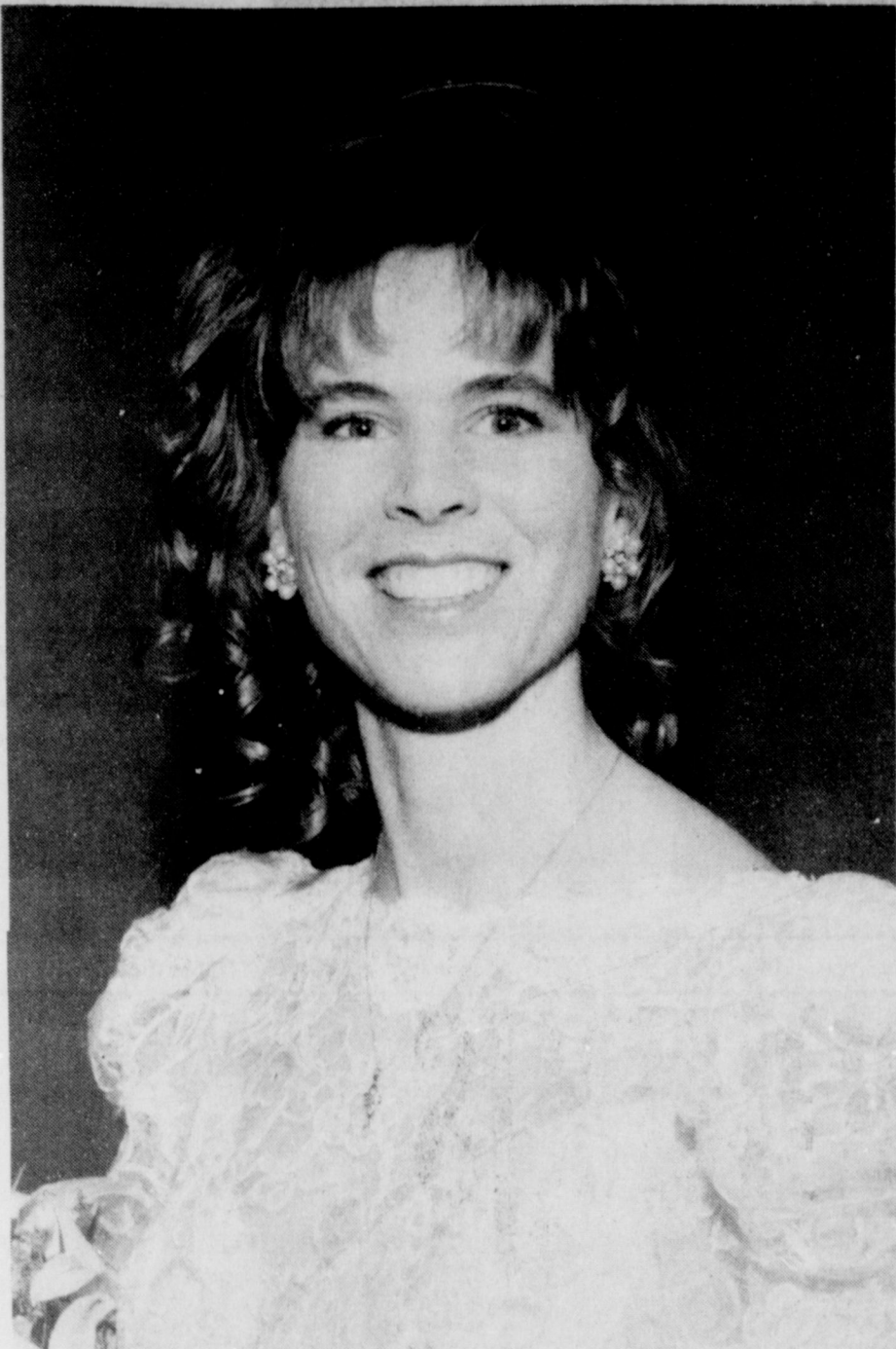

Branch bank to open here

For the first time in 61 years, Iowa Park will soon have a second bank.

Parker Square Bank, N.A. of Wichita Falls, announced Monday that the bank has filed an application with the office of the Comptroller of the Currency to establish a branch banking facility here.

The bank will be located at 219 West Park, the current TU Electric office. As of the announcement, TU Electric had not officially made public it was closing the office, however.

John Gavin, president of Parker Square Bank, held a news conference in the TU Electric Reddy Room Monday to announce the institution's intentions.

He was accompanied by Douglas James, who will be manager of the branch, and Bob Pace, chairman of the bank's board of directors.

Both James and Pace are native Iowa Parkans.

"In analyzing our current customer base and potential growth markets of this area, we determined that Iowa Park was an excellent location for us to place

an additional branch facility," said Gavin.

"We also determined that the current Texas Utilities location would provide a perfect facility for our needs. We began negotiations with Texas Utilities for us to assume usage of the facility following their decision to downsize their operations in Iowa Park.

"The strongest benefit we see initially to this facility is that we have contracted to continue collecting utility payments for Texas Utilities. The citizens of Iowa Park will not be inconvenienced with the change, and in fact, we will now be able to provide full service banking convenience to the current Texas Utilities customer base," he continued.

James, son of the late D.O. James and Mrs. James, is currently Senior Vice President at Parker Square. His family was one of the early settlers of the community.

Following his graduation from W.F. George High (now Iowa Park High), he

was graduated from the University of Texas and the Southwestern Graduate School of Banking at Southern Methodist Univ.

James and his wife, Melba, have three children.

"We are extremely fortunate to have someone of Douglas' experience and stature to assume the responsibility for this new location," Gavin said.

"I believe we are evidencing our commitment to make this a successful customer and commercial banking facility by naming Douglas as its manager.

"He has over 25 years experience in banking with our company and will have the autonomy and authority to provide the highest level of service to the Iowa Park customer base."

Parker Square's board president, Pace, is the son of the late Tom and Mrs. Pace. Mr. Pace served the community in numerous ways, including terms as the city mayor, president of the Chamber of Commerce and president of the school board. His grandfather was pastor of the First United Methodist Church here.

The anticipated opening date for the new banking facility will be no later than Mar. 31, following receipt of regulatory approval for the branch location, Gavin announced.

Among those on hand for the announcement were Mayor Wayne House, who was serving as TU Electric office manager when the company moved into the building in 1976, and Alderman Johnny Crawford, who owns the building.

House termed the announcement as "bitter sweet." He said he hated to lose TU Electric, but Parker Square's coming "softened the blow."

Also in the audience was Gene Jordan, president of State National Bank and currently president of the Iowa Park Chamber of Commerce.

Gavin said the branch's staff would consist of three others besides James: two tellers and a secretary.

"We have several residents from Iowa Park already employed, and will give them the opportunity to come over," he added.

Once the branch is opened, this will be the first time since 1932 that two banks have served in the city.

First National Bank, chartered in 1900, and First State Bank, chartered in 1919, consolidated during the Great Depression, in 1932, as the State National Bank.

Couple arrested on theft charges

A man and woman from Wichita Falls were taken into custody during the early morning hours Saturday and charged with a series of thefts here.

Police were alerted at 2:35 a.m. by a resident on Wagonwheel, who said a yellow Cadillac had pulled into his driveway, and left when the driver saw the resident.

Police immediately began searching the city for the vehicle, and immediately began noticing tool box lids on pickups standing open.

The suspect vehicle was located on the Access Road and stopped. After the couple was taken into custody, several items were confiscated to be identified.

Arrested were Keith Brandon Shaffer, 27, and Joell Ballard, 24. They were taken to county jail on charges of burglary. Each was held under a \$3,500 bond.

Ballard's bond was paid later that day and she was released. But Shaffer, who was on probation for an earlier burglary charge, remains in jail.

Items, including tools, fishing tackle and weed-eater, have been returned to their owners. All were from the northwestern part of the city.

However, police have not found items taken Wednesday night of last

week that were reportedly stolen.

A pickup was entered in the 1000 block of Lanelle and two shotguns taken, and tools from a pickup parked at a business on US 287 Access West, have yet to be recovered. Those thefts were reported Thursday morning to police.

Another theft report also was filed Thursday. A resident in the 700 block of East Ruby said two motorcycles, with an estimated value of \$900, had been taken from the front yard sometime during the previous four days.

Three persons were arrested as a result of two separate domestic disturbances reported Saturday night.

Police took Andrew Louie Hambright, 35, into custody at 11:42 p.m. He was released the next morning after signing a personal recognizance bond.

At 1:43 a.m., officers responded to a domestic disturbance in the 500 block of West Coleman.

There, they arrested Larry Gene Hawkins, 35, on a charge of assault, and Debra Lynn Hawkins, 23, on a charge of public intoxication.

Both were released later that

morning.

Three other arrests were included on this week's police blotter.

An officer on patrol Wednesday evening stopped to assist a stranded vehicle on US 287 near Johnson Road. After the license number was checked, it was determined the driver was wanted on an outstanding warrant from Austin.

Kelly Eugene Kemp, 22, was wanted for violation of parole. He was taken to Wichita County jail.

An officer stopped a man walking in the 100 block of East Jefferson, at 12:26 a.m. Monday. John Phillip Collinsworth, 19, was taken into custody on a charge of public intoxication.

At 12:33 a.m. Wednesday, an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle at West Highway and Park Plaza, and ran identification checks on the two occupants.

The driver was not wanted, but the passenger, Tamara L. Pierce, 28, was found to have an outstanding warrant against her for theft by check, issued by the Wichita County Sheriff's Office.

She was transported to jail by a county deputy, according to the blotter.

City to pick up yule trees

They will be shredded and the chips will be used for ground and garden cover.

Residents are asked to leave their trees, without ornaments, near the curb in front of their homes beginning Monday.

Residents are asked to not put the trees in the alley.

UW funding cut short

All 33 United Way agencies, including Iowa Park's Friendly Door and Recreational Activities Center, will receive less funding in 1993 than they did in 1992, it was announced last week.


The reductions are based on a seven-percent loss in pledges this year and last.

"If we raise more money than projected, all additional funds will be distributed to our agencies," said John Gavin, president of this year's United Way Campaign.

The Friendly Door allocation was set at \$16,066, down from \$16,596 last year, and RAC funding was set at \$17,388, down from \$17,586.

When the final report was made Wednesday of last week, Gavin said 97 percent of the goal, or \$1,485,000, had been pledged for the Greater Wichita Falls United Way drive this year.

Dr. Greg Ammons, pastor, and Rev. Eddie Coast, pastor of Trinity Baptist Church of Lawton, officiated. Burial was in Highland Cemetery under direction of Dutton Funeral Home.

Mrs. Dwyer died Monday in her home in Lawton, Okla.

Born Oct. 5, 1903 in Henderson County, she grew up in Eastland County where she and John Joseph Dwyer were married March 22, 1920. He preceded her in death March 25, 1970. A daughter, Josie Mae died in 1922, a son, James W. "Bill" died in 1987 and a son, Travis, died in 1989.

Mrs. Dwyer lived in Iowa Park 25 years before moving to Lawton two years ago. She had lived in Burk Burnett 14 years before she moved to Iowa Park. She was a homemaker and a member of Trinity Baptist Church of Lawton.

Ivan V. Zeck

Ivan V. Zeck, a former resident of Iowa Park, died Tuesday in a Snyder hospital.

Graveside service is set for 2 p.m. today in Hillside Memorial Gardens in

Snyder. Officiating will be a grandson, Mark Zeck of Snyder.

Zeck, 91, was born in Robinson County, Tenn., and he married Callie Polm on Sept. 27, 1923 in Parkers Landing, Pa.

The oil boom took Mr. Zeck to Snyder in 1949. He lived in Iowa Park and worked for Harlow-Samons, Inc. in Wichita Falls.

After moving to Snyder, he and a partner, Red Young, leased the machine and engine shop business, and Zeck later bought out his partner. The firm changed its name to Y-Z Engineers and now is known as Y-Z Industries, operating world wide.

Zeck also worked for Mobil Oil 12 years, and worked on the first electric cable tool for the company which was then known as Magnolia.

In an 1989 interview, Zeck said he "was always trying to invent something" and that it came naturally. He acquired several patents for oilfield-related products. At age 65, Zeck learned to fly an airplane.

Zeck lived in Waldron, Ark., 12 years, returning to Snyder in 1989.

Survivors include his wife, Callie Zeck of Snyder; a son, Ted E. Zeck of Snyder; two daughters, Bonnie Faye Hale of Waldron, Ark., and Sophie Michie of Snyder; eight grandchildren; and 12 great-grandchildren.





GUIDELINES FOR GIFT SELECTION

"What shall I render unto the Lord for all His benefits toward me?" (Ps. 116:12). Only thoughtless people pass through life receiving and enjoying bountiful blessings without ever giving a thought to the bountiful giver!

Grateful people seek ways to repay those who have contributed to their happiness. The thoughtful husband searches for ways to recompense his wife for her uncomplaining toil. The considerate wife looks for some ways to express gratitude to her hard-working husband for his provisions. The truly thankful person meditates how to repay God for his overwhelming generosity! Here are some thoughts:

The gift must come from genuine gratitude! A mother-in-law told her son-in-law: "You've provided wonderfully for your family, and I know they appreciate it." His unspoken response was, "Oh, if only my wife did appreciate it, that would make the long hours, the pressures, and the anxiety worthwhile. But she doesn't." If men were genuinely grateful for God's goodness, it would bring Him gladness!

The gift must be consistent with conduct! A husband's gift to his wife will not bring happiness if he then tramples on her by inconsiderate words and actions. A gift to the husband becomes meaningless if the wife turns to nagging criticism and a sour disposition. Similarly, dollars dropped in Sunday's baskets to not delight the Lord if His will is forgotten and His name profaned.

The gift must respect the recipient! It makes no difference how expensive the gift may be, it's worthless unless it pleases the receiver. A \$5,000 mink stole is useless to the one who doesn't want it. What does God desire? God wants us! Then everything else comes into place. Paul considered the overwhelming generosity of the Macedonian Christians. The average Christian shuns the stewardship sermon. The Macedonians begged Paul to take their gift. Paul saw they have given beyond their ability (2 Cor. 8:3) and realized the motivation in verse 5; "the Macedonians first gave themselves to the Lord."

Frances Havergal expressed so beautifully: "I gave My life for thee, My precious blood I shed, That thou might'st ransom me, and quickened from the dead; I gave, I gave My life for Thee; what hast thou given for Me?"

"What shall I render unto the Lord for all His benefits toward me?" (Psalm 116:12). What is your answer?

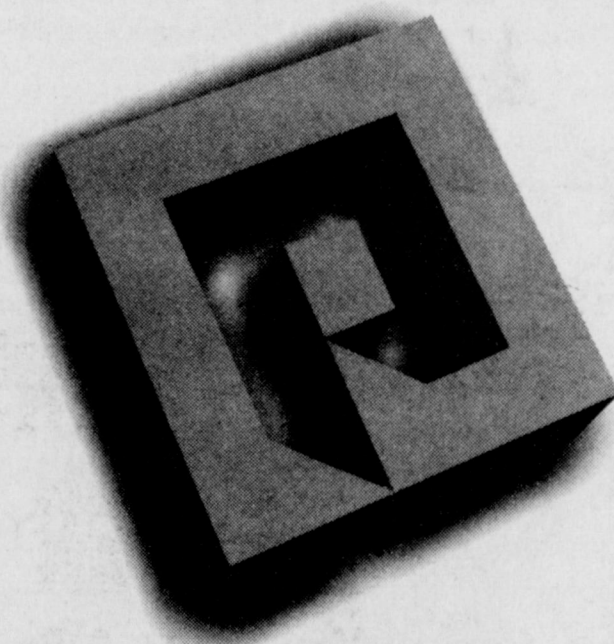

Local stallion national finalist

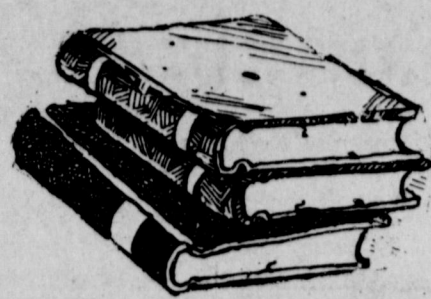

Varsities lose, win

The Lady Hawks and Hawks split their outings this week, both losing to Holliday and both winning against Monday. All the games were played in their local gym.

The Lady Hawks will hit the road Tuesday to Haskell, and then they and the Hawks are entered in the annual tournament at Archer City next weekend.

In the varsity girls' game Monday, Iowa Park jumped out to a 13-10 lead by the end of the first quarter, but then went cold, and lost, 49-42. Misty Cook led the locals with 16, and Gina Inman followed with 14.

They returned to the court Tuesday and jumped all over Monday, 65-32. Three Lady Hawks scored in double digits: Inman, 16; Cook, 14, and Mandy Threet, 12.

That extended the Lady Hawks' season record to 11-7.

The Holliday Eagles returned most of their outstanding team from last year, and may have taken the Hawks too lightly at the start of their game Monday.

Iowa Park jumped out to a 17-9 lead in the first quarter. But Holliday turned up the tempo from then on, to lead 29-28 at the half and go on to beat the Hawks, 74-60.

Chad Thompson scored 14 points for Iowa Park and Mark Childs had 13. Monday provided little competition

for the Hawks, now 6-8 on the season, as Iowa Park racked up their Tuesday contest by a 57-44 margin.

Ken Cooper led the locals with 14 and Childs had 10.

The Lady Hawk Junior Varsity was Iowa Park's only winner Monday, defeating Holliday 53-27.

The Hawk JV also lost to Holliday, 57-43, but rebounded with a 71-23 win over Monday the following evening.

In a game played Saturday, the Hawk Freshmen edged Windthorst 57-52.

Retirement party fetes Mrs. Hastings

After a 28-year tenure with the Social Security Administration, Rose Hastings will retire Jan. 2, 1993.

She was honored Saturday evening at a retirement party at the Tom Burnett Memorial Library, with her family, and present and former employees of SSA in attendance.

On the same date as Mrs. Hastings retires, her husband, Willie, is retiring after 34 years with the U. S. Geological Survey.

Thirty years of service or 55 years of age is required for retirement from Civil Service. Mrs. Hastings has accumulated 31 years service since beginning work under Civil Service.

She began working at SAFB as base housing clerk in March 1956 and resigned in March 1958. From 1961 until March 1963 she worked for the Wichita County Home Demonstration Agent's office. Then in December 1964 she began working for the SSA.

Mrs. Hastings began work as a clerk typist, advancing to computations clerk. Her next promotion was claims representative, working directly with Social Security recipients from 1973-76.

For this promotion she attended school nine weeks in San Antonio. From claims representative, Rose became an analyst, and now is retiring as an operations supervisor for the Social Security portion of the program.

There are two programs, the Social Security and the Supplementary Security Income program, that provides assistance for the disabled, or for those under a specific income level.

The retiree has seen many changes take place in the Social

Security office, including the work load, employee changes, and additional programs.

She says her work has consistently been heavy and that the economy affects the work load to a certain degree. "For instance," she pointed out, "the Social Security office began downsizing in 1988 because of the economy."

When Mrs. Hastings began working in 1964 there were 18 employees. She saw that number increase as high as 36 employees, and the last two years the staff has stayed at 24. The office is open from 9 a.m. until 4 p.m. Rose says she has been the one who has opened the office every morning for 15 years.

The year after she began working for the SSA, Medicare became a part of the system. In 1968 several amendments were passed that brought, among other changes, student benefits and automatic COLAs to the program.

When she began working all of office equipment was manual, now everything is computerized.

"Social Security is extremely solvent," Mrs. Hastings said, "and at the present time there is plenty in reserve to last well into the next century."

She added that Social Security administrative costs require a very small portion of tax money.

Mrs. Hastings has received many performance awards throughout the 28 years she has been with the SSA and she was presented a necklace Saturday night that is engraved with her name and length of service.

"My work has been very challenging and demanding, but very rewarding and satisfying. I have enjoyed my job 28 years. The group I

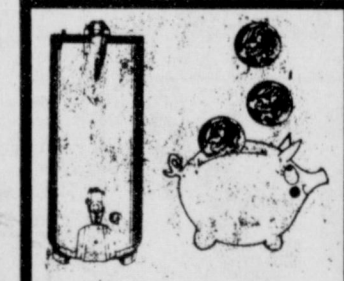
