| The Illustrious Dead. <br> Rico did herself prond this afternoon in the elalorate manner in which the solemnits of the day was observed, and the memorial services were impressive. In accordance with the proclamation of Mayor Cox, all business houses were closed between 12 and 4 o'clock, and all united in doing honor to the memory of that great general whose funeral was progressing in distant New York. At 2 p.m. the procession formed at the Armory in this order, and under the commanders designated: <br> Consolidated bauds (Rico Cornet and Pasadena) under W. H. M. Bangs and Harry Iler, <br> Veterans, (U. S. and Ex-Confederates) under W. H. Bean, <br> Rico Guards, under Capt. Wagensler, Silver Crescent Lodge No. 40 I. O. O. F. under N. J. Bradley. <br> City Council, under Clerk Gilbert, School children, under Artie Thompson, Citizens on horseback, under Sheriff Swickhimer, <br> These were all under the supervision of Mayor Cox, marshal of the day. <br> The procession marched through all the principal streets and on returning to the Armory listened to the following ex ercises, of which lack of time forbids extended notice: <br> Overture by the Bands. <br> Reading of the 90th Psalm by Reverend Howard. <br> Song: "My Faith Looks Up to Thee."
