## TEXAS RAILROADS PAY

 SUBSTANTIAL PART OF STATE'S TAX BURDEN- Taxes is one of the large fixed charges connected with the operation of Texas railroads. From the standpoint of the welfare of state, counties and communities, railroad taxes are of much importance. This annual obligation must be met from the earning capacity of the rail carriers.
In 1931 the railroads of Texas paid a total of $\$ 8,303,108.47$ in federal, state, county, municipal and miscellaneous taxes. The distribution of this amount to the various tax funds is shown below
