Work on Highway Ten Is Awaiting Asphalt Shipment

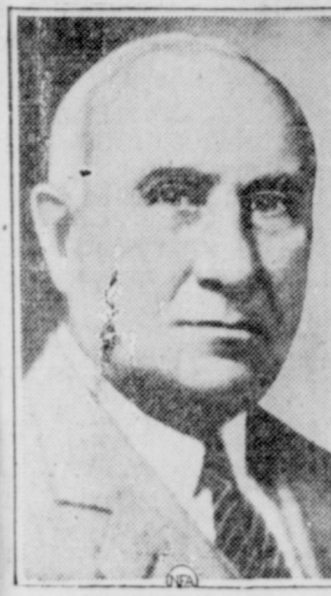
Asphalt work on Highway No. 19 south to the Colorado River was stopped Wednesday afternoon when the supply of asphalt gave out.
