SPECIFIC NUMBER OF PRECINCTS IN COUNTIES - Results of the upcoming census will require some counties that have grown to more than 30,000 in population to increase the number of justice of the peace and constable precincts. The amendment will allow some counties to avoid this inconvenience by raising the population cut-off to 50,000 . For Cooke County the current
law would require Cooke County to create two additional justice of the law would require Cooke County to create two additional justice of the peace precincts and two constable precincts. Proposition 16 would allow Cooke County to maintain three justices Proponents Say: For some counties, increasing the number of precincts may create a financial burden. The proposal would keep councues from automatically having io increase Opponents Say: Th
Opponents Say: This proposed amendment would allow counties to avoid increasing the number of justices of the peace and constables in
a county even though more people live in the county and need more a county even though more people live in the county and need more
services. The number of these officials should be based on the public's needs, not on a county's budget. There would be no relief from increased workloads for justices of the peace and con
counties that have grown beyond 30,000 . PROPOSITION \#17. PERMANENT UNIVERSITY FUND
INVESTMENTS -The PUF (Permanent University Fund) partially funds the University of Texas and Texas A \& M systems. Proposition 17 allows the board of regents to determine permanent university fund (PUF) distributions to the available university fund (AUF) based on the total return on all PUF assets, including capital gains, rather than
dividends, interest, and other income. Proponents Say: This would modemize the investment and spending

account that today much of the increase in the value of a fund comes in the form of capital gains.
