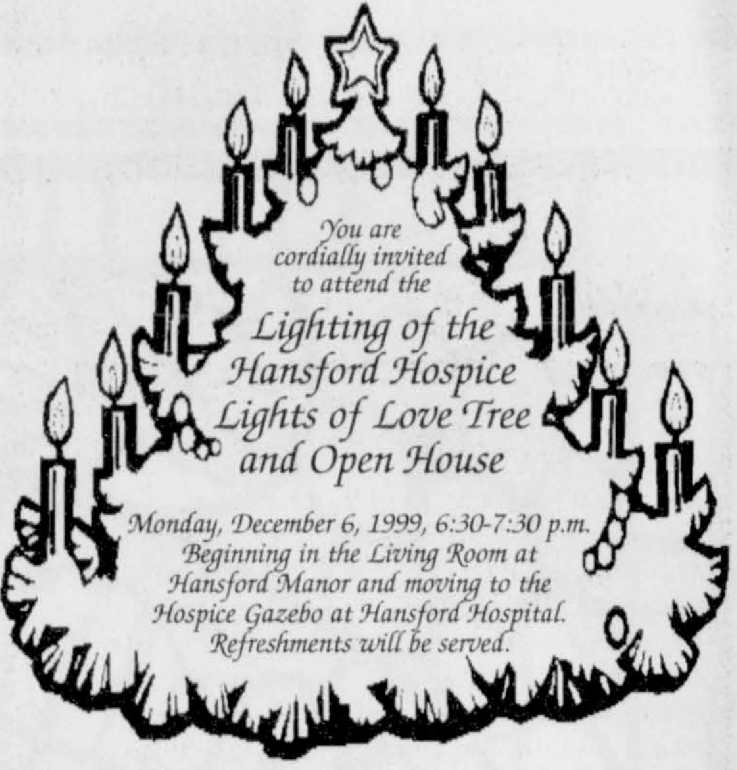

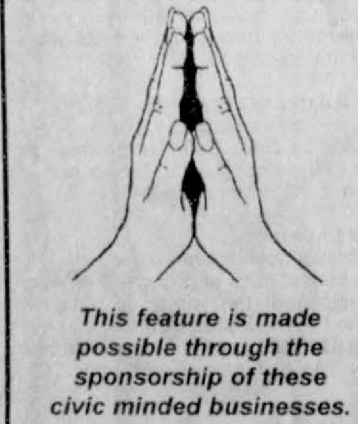

## Hansford Hospice Highlights

### Coping with Grief During the Holidays

Family gatherings. Tokens of thanks and gifts of joy. Food overflowing the tables. Logs crackling softly in the distance. Holidays trigger happy memories with every sight and sound. But it is precisely at these happy times when the loss of a loved one can be felt the strongest. It is a time to remember what is missing.

"Rather than being times of family togetherness, sharing and thanksgiving, the holidays can bring feelings of sadness, loss and emptiness for many people who have experienced death," according to Dr. Alan Wolfelt, noted author and grief educator.

"Since love does not end with death, holidays can renew this sense of personal grief, a feeling of loss unlike that experienced in the routine of daily living. And, though society encourages everyone to join in the holiday spirit, it can be hard, as memories of the one who has died come rushing back with full force."

In addition to clergy, many people turn to their community funeral home director for information on coping with grief. Funeral directors continue their services beyond the funeral itself and are an excellent resource for books, free pamphlets, seminars, workshops and special programs around the holidays.

No simple guidelines exist to take away hurt, but some things can be done to help people better cope with grief during this joyful, yet painful, time of year.

Healing is a personal experience that takes time. So, be tolerant and compassionate with yourself as you continue to heal.

*Dr. Wolfelt serves as director of the Center for Loss and Life Transition in Fort Collins, CO, and has authored several books on understanding and coping with grief.*

This Thanksgiving, while we are eating turkey, we do not have to be "turkeys." We do not need to be uninformed and thoughtless.

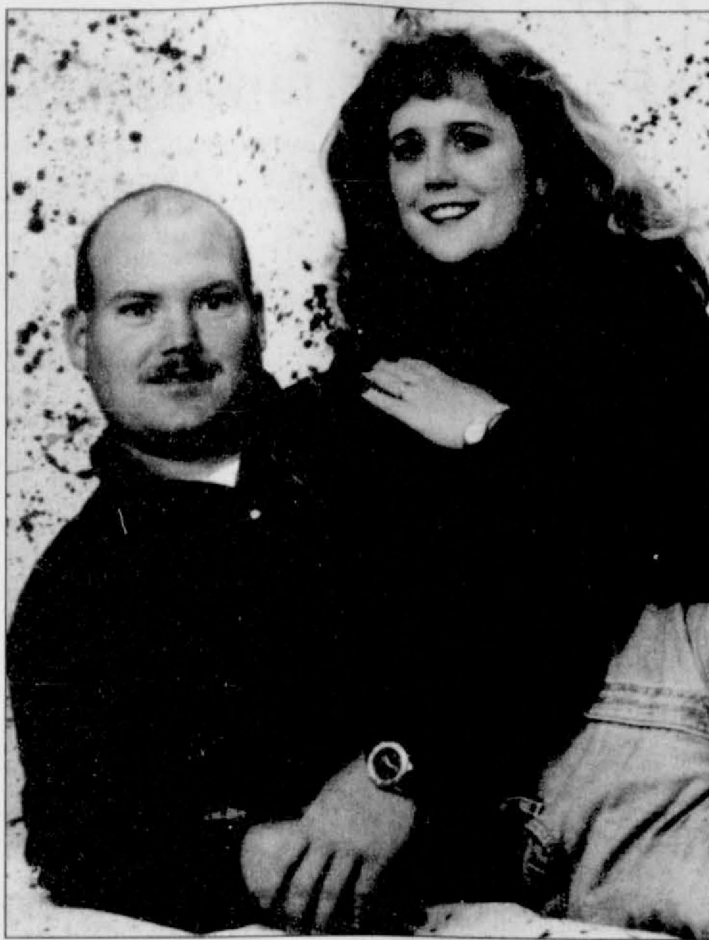
While we are giving thanks and feasting, let us take just a moment to think about those who do not have the luxuries that we enjoy.

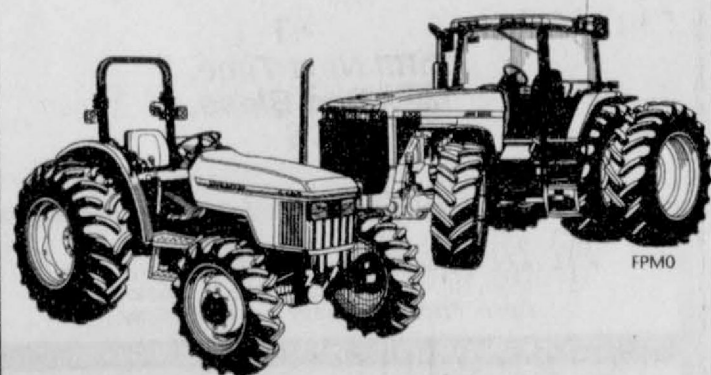

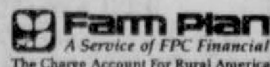

# Lynx Hammer Hamlin

Spearman traveled to Plainview on a beautiful night for football to take on the Pied Pipers of Hamlin in the area game of the high school playoffs. Spearman has been no stranger to the playoffs the last few years and that experience paid off Friday night. The Lynx found out early that they could run right at Hamlin and that is what they did as they won the game 29-17. Behind a great offensive line, the Lynx rolled up 288 total yards that were all on the ground. Spearman will play Sonora next week in the regional game at Lowery field in Lubbock at 7:30. Sonora who is undefeated, beat Seagraves 21-14 in the area game.

Spearman had a good crowd on hand and that crowd should increase as each week goes by. The defense rose to the occasion as they contained the Hamlin quarterback and their big running back. Hamlin could have been very explosive, but the Lynx D (defense) would not let Hamlin much past the line of scrimmage all night long. The Pipers were held to three first downs through the first three quarters. The Lynx came ready to play and they were not going to be denied. Jordan Brock hurt his ankle the first play of the game and did not see any action the rest of the night. Hopefully with another week of healing, he will be ready for Sonora. Hang in there Bucko!

Spearman won the toss and elected to receive as the wind was not a factor. The Lynx started their first drive on their own 24 yard line. Spearman played hard-nosed football all night long as they ran right at Hamlin. They moved the ball out to the Hamlin 42. On 3rd and 4, Dusty Barber ran for a first down to the Hamlin 37. Spearman kept the ball on the ground and had a 1st and 10 from the 12. On 3rd and 3 from the 5, John Brock ran up the middle and was inches short of a first down. On 4th down, Brock ran off tackle for a first down at the 1 yard line. Aaron Winegarner ran a bootleg around the left end on the next play for the touchdown with 4:06 left in the first quarter. Teddie Whitefield's PAT kick was good and the Lynx led 7-0.

Hamlin started their drive on their own 26. On 3rd and 10, Homer Munoz put the pressure on the QB and caused him to throw an incomplete pass and the Pipers had to punt. Spearman started on their own 49 after a short punt. The Lynx continued to grind it out on the ground. After all they were making 4 to 8 yards a carry so they didn't have to worry about going to the passing game. They drove down to the Hamlin 10 with a first and goal. Winegarner was sacked

for a big loss on 2nd and 7 back to the 18 yard line. Hamlin stopped the Lynx on 3rd and long, and the Lynx settled for a 28 yard field goal by Teddie Whitefield. That made the score 10-0 with 8:35 left in the first half.

The Pied Pipers started their next possession on their own 26 after being tackled by Edward Vasquez. Vasquez has done a great job on the kickoff because he is in on almost every tackle on the kickoffs. Hamlin could not move the ball and went 3 and out and had to punt back to the Lynx. Spearman could not move the ball on this drive and had to give the ball back to the Pipers.

Hamlin started this possession on their own 31 with 5:01 left in the half. They converted on 3rd and 1 from their own 40. Then they converted again on 3rd and 9 from their own 46 with a completed pass down to the Spearman 36 with 1:16 left in the half. They completed another pass over the middle and ran down to the 6 yard line with :13 left. Spearman held on the next play and Hamlin kicked a 22 yard field goal with one second left in the half. The half ended with the score 10-3 in favor of the Lynx.

Spearman came out the second half ready to play football. They had to kick off to Hamlin and they started on their own 29. On 3rd and 15 from their own 24, Teddie Whitefield, Josh Schumann, and Jared Shufeldt smothered the QB for a big loss and Hamlin had to punt.

The Lynx did not waste much time on this drive as they started from the Hamlin 39. The Lynx drove down to the 20 and were facing a 4th and 3. Spearman ran a reverse to Kelsey Henton who ran to the 14 and a first down. Two plays later, Winegarner ran a bootleg around the right end from 11 yards out for the touchdown with 5:59 left in the 3rd quarter. The PAT was good and the Lynx increased their lead to 17-3.

Both teams could not move the ball on their next possessions and they exchanged punts. Hamlin started this drive on their own 19 yard line with :44 left in the third quarter. On the first play from scrimmage, the Pipers fumbled and Brock was there for the recovery at the Hamlin 24. Few plays later, Barber ran to the 1 yard line for a first down. Brock dove over the line on the next play for the TD with 10:13 left in the game. The PAT failed and the Lynx led 23-3.

Hamlin started from their own 25 on this drive and immediately moved the ball out to their own 40. They completed a couple of passes and had the ball at the Lynx 25. Two plays later with 1st and 10 at the 12, Barber sacked the QB at

the 16. On 3rd and 10, Barber again dragged the QB from behind after a short gain. On 4th and 6 from the 8, the Pipers found an open receiver in the end zone for the TD with 6:31 left in the 4th quarter. The PAT was good and the score was 23-10 Spearman.

The Pipers tried an on-side kick, but Jeremy Mackie was there to make the recovery at the Spearman 48. Spearman drove to the Hamlin 35 yard line in two plays. On the next play, Brock ran the sweep around the left end for 35 yards and another Spearman touchdown with 5:05 left. The PAT failed and the score was 29-10.

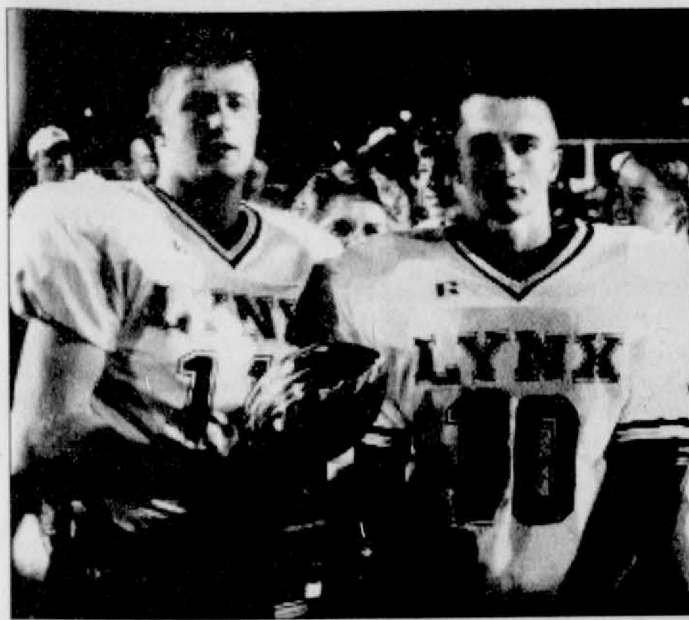
Hamlin took the ball on their next possession and completed a couple of passes and converted once on 4th down and finally put the ball into the end zone with 1:47 left in the game. The PAT kick was good and the Lynx led 29-17. The Lynx recovered another on-side kick and then had to punt back to Hamlin, but they could not get the ball into the end zone before time expired. The final score was Spearman 29 and Hamlin 17.

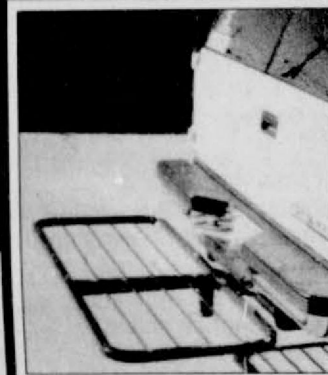

That is down 3 inches from last Monday. I am surprised that it is holding this well.

Jim's Report: A slow week at the Lake. There was only one camper, Chris and Shelley Goodson, now of Dalhart, fish at night some. This week Chris threw a net for shad and only caught one, but that one was bait for a 5# catfish. Shad are hard to find in the winter. They caught other nice catfish and two big crappie.

There were a few boats out on Sunday. Some used the office side boat ramp, but it will not be in service much longer. A Bald Eagle was seen in one of the dead trees in the Lake for the first time this year. Ducks are also moving out from the creeks to the main body.

Thinking of ducks, Amy and Daniel Harris told me they had been seeing some wood ducks on

their end of the Palo Duro. John Tvetven in Bards of Texas writes of wood ducks, "Many of the world's birds exhibit remarkable beauty, but few can equal the iridescent rainbow splendor of this most colorful of ducks."

At best, these ducks are uncommon in the Panhandle other seasons, but in the winter they are irregular, meaning not recorded every year but they may occur in numbers. It and the painted and indigo bunting are at the top of my list of "hope to see" birds.

Helen Fisher seems to think I should know what has happened to her house finches. Ours are gone, too, but I have a theory after reading Flavil Ayers letter in last week's paper. They are going where they are fed. They like sunflower seeds, with black ones first choice. Do you have a feeder out, Helen? I don't.

Around 1940 these pretty little birds were being trapped in the West and sent to New York and sold as "Hollywood finches" to

live the rest of their lives in cages. This illegal practice was stopped by government agents. All native American species are protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty that bans their capture and sale.

**NOTICE OF INTENTION  
TO CONDUCT WEATHER  
MODIFICATION OPERATIONS  
IN THE STATE OF TEXAS**

1. Notice is hereby given that the Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District, 201 W. 3rd St., P.O. Box 637, White Deer, Texas, contact person, C.E. Williams, General Manager (806/883-2501) has filed an application with the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission for a State permit to conduct weather modification operations to change or attempt to change the natural development of clouds for the purpose, objective, period, and by the method summarized herein below.

2. Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District submitted an application for a Texas Weather modification license on November 4, 1999.

3. The purpose of the weather modification operation is to increase rainfall, to affect water resources and agriculture. The period of the permit is: April 1, 2000 through March 31, 2003.

4. The proposed weather modification operation is to be conducted for and on behalf of the Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District, P.O. Box 637, White Deer, Texas 79097.

5. The proposed weather modification operation is to be carried out in both an operational area and a target area to cause the intended effects to occur only in the target area. The operational area is those portions of the following counties within 30 miles of the outer boundary of the target area: Ochiltree, Lipscomb, Swisher, Briscoe, Hansford, Hartley, Deaf Smith, and Moore.

6. The area to be affected by the proposed weather modification operation is the target area. The target area is the counties of Hutchison, Roberts, Carson, Gray, Wheeler, Armstrong, Donley, Potter, Randall, Collingsworth, Hall, Hemphill, Oldham, and Childress.

7. The methods and materials to be used in conducting this operation are summarized herein: A licensed meteorologist will select cumuliform clouds for cloud-seeding using a weather radar display, standard meteorological analysis, forecast techniques, observations, and plume dispersion models to initiate the release of the seeding particles, such as

silver iodide crystals, from one or two aircraft at cloud top or cloud base at a time calculated to affect the formation of cumuliform clouds.

9. Persons interested in knowing more about the technical aspects of the proposed operation should contact C.E. Williams, General Manager, Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District (806/883-2501) or the Water Planning and Assessment Division (512/239-0770) of the Commission.

9. A public hearing on this application may be called by mailing a petition that requests a hearing to the Executive Director, Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission, P.O. Box 13087, Austin, Texas 78711-3087. The petition must contain (1) the signature, full name, address and phone number of each person requesting; (2) a statement that each person is at least 18 years of age and resides or owns property in the operational area; and (3) a description of each persons interest and how that interest would be adversely affected. Requests for hearing must be received by the Commission within 30 days of the last date the Notice of Intention is published in week one of the mandatory three-week period required by 289.71(j) of Commission rules. If at least 25 eligible persons make written request, the Commission shall hold a public hearing on an application prior to issuance of a permit. Individual members of the public who wish to inquire about the information contained in this notice, or to inquire about other agency permit applications or

First Street, Dumas, Texas, area code (806) 935-6401, facsimile (806) 935-6633, to explain, and to hear comments on the establishment of civil penalties for violation of the District's rules which became effective on October 1, 1995.

The agenda for this hearing will be as follows:

1. Explanation of the necessity for civil penalties where there is a violation of the District's rules, including the existing injunction remedy.
2. Discussion of the statutory basis authorizing the imposition of civil penalties.
3. Discussion of the range of civil penalties being considered.
4. Explanation of policies which will be applied in the calculation

of civil penalties.

5. Comments from persons in attendance.

6. Discussion of Rule 15 (requiring a check-valve on each irrigation well on or before January 1, 2000).

The presiding officer may conduct the hearing in the manner the presiding officer deems most appropriate for the particular proceeding. The presiding officer has the authority for the particular proceeding to administer oaths to all persons presenting testimony; examine witnesses; ensure that information and testimony are introduced as conveniently and expeditiously as possible; conduct the hearing in an orderly manner; recess the hearing from time to time and place to place; exercise any other appropriate power necessary or convenient to effectively carry out the responsibility of the presiding officer.

Any interested person may appear in person or may be represented by counsel, hydrologist, engineer or other representative, provided the representative is fully authorized to speak and act for the principal.

PURSUANT TO SAID HEARING, the District will enter such civil penalties, resolutions and orders as in its judgment the evidence presented may justify, and establishing the effective date of such rules.

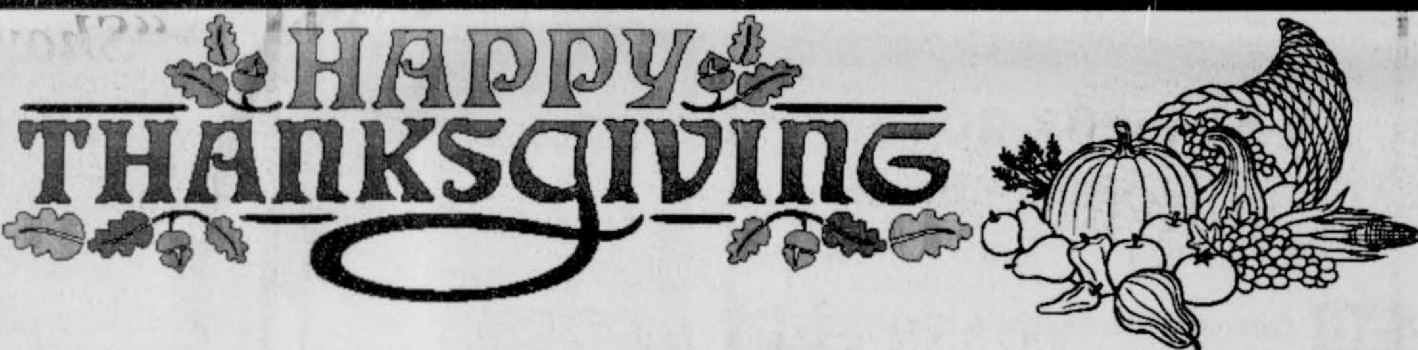

### Local Youth Win in 4-H District Roundup

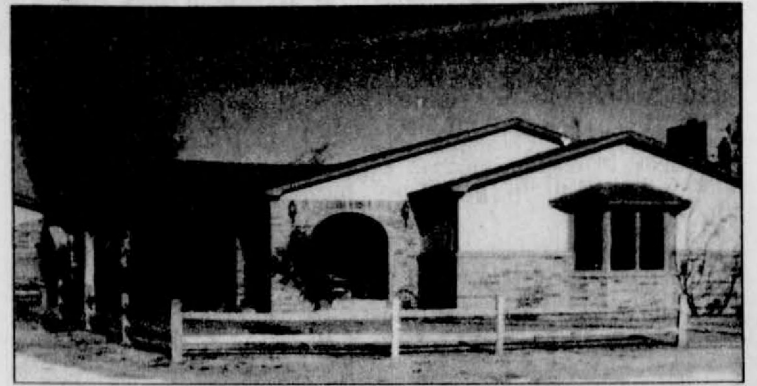
