Both Bourn and the High Ground group have helped Cumpton in his marketing strategy. Also, he said there is a spirit of cooperation among economic development agencies in the Panhandle, not ing he has been put in touch with some prospects by other area communities. "We haven't landed any thing yet, but we've come close. ... I still berieve we have a lot to offer people. have a lot to offer people. Last season, due to federal requirements that all other waterfowl pens, we saw a full week special snow goose conservation season opens, we saw a full week of both the dark goose and sandhill crane
seasons wiped out. Unfortunately, that happened at a time when dark goose and sandhill crane numbers were peaking in the local area, and the rare opportunity to take cranes and geese from the same spread was presenting itself.
Hunters in a portion of the Rolling Plains were also disappointed last
year when their dark goose hunting was ended erlier then print year when their dark goose hunting was ended earlier than printed
regulations indicated that it was supposed to. To correct the problem for that area
To correct the problem for that area, TP\&W is recommending the state. This proposed Central Goose Zone would eliminate the need for an early closure of the dark goose hunting season to accommodate the special snow goose conservation action, according to TP\&W. Early closure of the final days of the dark gcose season in order to allow for the opening of the snow goose conservation action caused
confusion among hunters last season. Some were apparently unaware of the early closure on dark seese and continued bagging Canad geese within the traditional time frame of the seasons as they were outlined in TP\&W regulations brochures handed out with licenses purchased for last season. Waterfowl hunters witnessed a mystifying change in the rules late in the game. People playing by the rules had Canadas landing in their decoys during a part of the season that was suddenly closed to them when it never had been before. Frustrating.

Emmy winner Chad Lowe (Life Goes On) stars in the title role of the new TV movie Take Me Home: The John Denver Story, which premieres Sunday on CBS. Unfortunately, the film fails to do justice to the famous folk singer in the short time it has to tell Denver's story.

Now we know what was going
through Chad Lowe's mind as he sat sobbing during wife Hilary Swank's recent Academy Award acceptance speech:
"My wife wins an Oscar, and I'm doing stuff like Take Me Home: The John Denver Story:"
OK, maybe that's a cheap joke, but then so is much of this CBS movie. which premieres Sunday, April 30. Both Lowe and Kristin Davis (Sex and ing
the City), who plays Denver's firs wife, Annie, deserve far better.
Lowe has proven himself as an actor long before now - he richly deserved the Emmy he won as a young man with AIDS on Life Goes On, and his recurring cast-against-type appearances as a villain on Now and Again are a treat - but he's unable to do much with Jerry London's script, which attempts to condense Denver's story into less than 90 minutes plus commercials. The actor says he's proud of his work in the TV movie but concedes that time constraints inevitably led to some compromises.
"Ideally, I wish we could have had two nights to tell his story," Lowe says. "I mean, it's a man's life, and in an ideal situation, we'd give him more time than this. But I really hope his fans will feel that we treated his story with respect. We certainly tried to do that, anyway."

## that, anyway

With only two weeks to prepare to play such a familiar entertainment fig. ure, Lowe says he immersed himself in listening to Denver's songs, watching hours of videotape and reading the singer's autobiography.
"Obviously, the fact that CBS hired me for the part meant they didn't want to go the look-alike route," says Lowe, who nonetheless does bear a credible resemblance to the singer in midrange shots. "I did try to learn things about

how he stood, some of his voice inflections, things like that - and, of course, the correct fingering for the guitar playing."
Tracks of Denver himself provide the vocals on the 15 Denver songs featured, inclüding "Annie's Song." "Take Me Home, Country Roads" and Rocky Mountain High," with Lowe doing a better than fair job of lip-sync.
"I think you get the real essence of John Denver in his songs," Lowe says, He was so wrapped up in communicating through music that he had troube communicating with people in his wn life. He was more comfortable inging to an audience of 20,000 than he was talking one-on-one with his wife and family."

And that, of course, is another prob lem with choosing Denver as a dramatic subject: He simply isn't inherently dramatic enough. He's remote. closed off in a manner that completely belies the relaxed flow of his songs. As Annie says to him in one scene "You aren't interested in living this life; you just want to sing about it.
Similarly, lake Me Home is most pleasing when it sings, letting Denver's simple songs work their mojo.
When the movie relies on dialogue however, it collapses into a tired string of show-business cliches about the demands of career vs. family, trite father son tensions (Gerald McRaney is a near-parody of himself as Denver's gruff father) and, ultimately, a not alogether sympathetic central figure who stubbornly resists dramatization. Despite earnest work by its leading man. Take Me Home is likely to strike our notes with both fans and crities of Tanes with both fans and critics of

HBO's Sex and the City returns on June 4

Q: When will the new season of HBO's Sex and the City begin? How many episodes will there be? It seems like it's been a long time since we saw a new show. -S.M., Appleton, Wis. A: Sarah Jessica Parker and her Man hattan gal pals return with 18 new episodes beginning Sunday, June 4. HBO's major original series - includ ing $O z$ and The Sopranos - pretty much roll out their new episodes in a continuous stream rather than interspersing them with repeats as the networks do. Once a new season of shows ends, you have to wait many months for a new series of episodes to begin
The 18 -episode order for Sex and the City is evidence of that show's smash-hit status. It's economically unfeasible for cable channel to order two dozen episodes per season, which is roughly what a network orders for a successfu series such as ER. A season of The So pranos runs for 13 episodes, while $O$ produces only eight per year
