organization is "the safest in the world."

## A great pheasant outlook for opening day

O
pening day of pheasant season on December 9 could bring
hunting opportunity every bit as good as a couple of scasons ago, when bird numbers improved markedy in in the oloaca aleas.a. In
fact, if youre tromping through the right locations, hunting ould be really good during the 16 -day season that runs through December Thar's an amazing projection, given the drought-plagued summer we perfectly timed to enhance the early hatching of pheasant broods.
I'm amazed at how many pheasants--and quail-made it through the difference.
Biologists generally project the outlook for pheasant season based on
driving count transect lines over a standard area year after year. They begin to get excited when bird counts average two per mile
Certainly, I don't drive large transects like the biologists do, but in some
pockets of Deaf Smith County I've counted pheasant numbers of from 13 to pockets of Deaf Smith County l've counted pheasant numbers of from 13 to 30 birds per mile--though not over an extended number of miles. Several
times I've stopped in the road so as not to whack into the sheer numbers of hens and roosters running and flying across.
Virtual mass migrations of pheasants from CRP tracts to grain fields have been in evidence.

People are often amazed at what a powerful draw pheasant hunting in the Panhandle is.

Panhandle in fluctuating numbers since the 1960s. Explaining this annual ritual to those who don't participate is a challenge. Why do you need 12 or 15 guys in a group to hunt pheasants? Well, it's a social thing, maybe the sizable party being a practical necessity in order to do a good job of working some of the huge fields that are involved.
By the time you get a decent line of walkers going in a dense stalk field or a CRP thicket and position a sufficient number of blockers and point-men to Yut off escape avenues, you may need a legion of troops.
You need Everybody must be constantly aware to protect one-another's safety You hunt with your safety on. Carry your shotgun so that you can control
your gun muzzle at all times, and don't point your gun at anything you don
want to shoot. When you're in a group you only shoot at high birds, well-clear of walkers, dogs, point men, and blockers. Low birds streaking toward the blockers or drivers or point men are birds you let go. Maneuvering into position when you see scads of pheasants racing down the
rows in front of you is nerve-tingling stuff. You wave blockers over to cut off the running birds. Suspense mounts as you approach the end of the field, amidst constant reminders to watch out for blockers and point men, and to let the birds get high.
You send the tail-swiping dogs thundering in. They are hell-bent to flush
birds, these bundles of enthusiasm with their noses down as they bound birds, these bundles of enthusiasm with their noses
amongst the fodder to eagerly probe the hot scent trails.
amongst the fodder to eagerly probe the hot scent trails.
Prodded by cold canine noses, squawking roosters and whistle-winged hens explode from the stubble, the long-tail-feathered birds careening off in all directions as they climb into the wind.
The thud of rooster-tracking shotguns punctuates the staccato of whirring
wings amidst shouts of wings amidst shouts of warning to watch out for the hens.
Enthusiastic dogs follow the drops, rush in to make pick-ups, respond to their
masters' whistles and praise and fech winged rainows to hand When it's done right, with good discipline and ultimate regard for safety, I enjoy pheasant hunting, whether the group is big or small.

Of the state's 254 counties, 252are de-
clared TB-free. The TB-free zone contains all but around 100 of the state's 153,000 cattle
herds herds. Due to recurring bouts of infection, nearly
all of E1 Paso County and a small portion of Hudspeth County are not TB-free, and have been recognized as a TB modified accredited advanced zone. Some testing, identification
and documentation will be required when moving livestock susceptible to
tuberculosis out of this movement restriction zone. The USDA's final rule will be published after January 2001.

nearly five percent of the nation's herds were affected by the Mycobacterium bovis bacteria, which can cause internal lesions on t

the 252 'free' counties to realize benefits of the new status," commented Dr. Dan Baca, TB epidemiologist for the Texas Animal Health Commission (TAHC). "USDA rules allow cattle from TB-free Itates or zones to move without a TB test.
Individual states have been notified about our new status, but since they may adopt entry requirements that are more stringent nary practitioner should check with the state nary practitioner should check with the sta Baca said nearly all of El Paso County and a small portion of Hudspeth County are in the movement restricted zone.

els and llamas) in the affected area must be tested yearly.

Baca said this can be accomplished at no charge to producers. State and federal per-
sonnel can do the testing, or accredited veterinarians in private practice can do the work and be compensated by the government through "fee-basis" payments.
The remainder of the movement restriction zone is a "surveillance area," where
infection has not been detected. said this creates a buffer between the af fected area and the "TB-free" counties. Cattle
and other susceptible species herds in the and other susceptible species herds in the
surveillance area are be tested at least every two years, also at no cost to producers. The USDA interim rule requires that cattle transported out of state from the movement
restriction zone must have a certificate of restriction zone must have a certificate of
veterinary inspection or other official move-
ment document and be identified with an individually numbered eartag. Breeding ani-
mals must have had a negative TB test within the previous $\mathbf{6 0}$ days.

By Jacqueline Cutler oTVData Features Syndicate For many, there can never be another wacky redhead. The theme song from I Love Lucy is so ingrained in our collective memory that only those cut off from TV for the past half-century couldn't recognize it.
Everyone knows Lucille Ball, or so they think. Even those who don't appreciate the show's broad humor can cite classic episodes. Then there are fans who giggle no matter how many times they've seen Lucy light her nose times they ve seen Lucy light her nose
on fire, swill Vitameatavegamin or stuff chocolates into her hat. Naturally, a sitcom - even the most popular show of its day and most copied comedy in television history - cannot define a woman who lived 77 years. So who was she? American Masters tries to tell us in Lucille Ball: Finding Lucy, premiering Sunday, Dec. 3, on PBS (check local listings). Susan Lacy, executive producer and creator of American Masters, which is celebrating its 15 th season, says, "This series is about those people who really, really shaped their disciplines in this century."
Few fit that bill better than Ball. But this installment of the usually exemplary biography show is, at best, lack luster. It doesn't bother to dig into Ball's Jamestown, N.Y., roots, nor do more than mention her enduring marriage to comic Gary Morton. But what's most troubling about this documentary is its stilted writing, with such lines as "But Lucille Ball, now that's a redhead of a different color.
One can almost hear Ball, whose gravelly voice reflected a lifetime of heavy smoking, scream for a rewrite. But if viewers can ignore the prose and realize Lucy's not found here, then they can just relax and watch clips of what she did best. There's footage from her long career as the queen of B movies,
and many I Love Lucy clips of a glam-

orous star who wasn't afraid to look ridiculous - whether it be as a klutz in ballet ${ }^{\circ}$ class or as a sparring buddy in a wine vat. Lifelong fans Carol Burnett and Fran Drescher are among those interviewed.
Ball, whose grandfather was a Communist, was caught up in the Red hunt of the 1950s. The documentary explains how she adored Desi Arnaz and had to strong-arm network executives into allowing a Cuban to play her husband on TV.
The documentary's best parts are toward the end when it shows rarely seen footage of Ball at Desilu Studios. As Burnett notes, "At (age) 51, she presided over Desilu with $1,700 \mathrm{em}$ ployees. ... Lucille Ball was the first female head of a studio." While there, she approved what were considered two risky shows: Mission: Impossible and Star Trek.
Though Lucy Ricardo was her most memorable role, she tried to revive that nutty persona in three additional shows: The Lucy Show (1962-68), in which her close friend and longtime on-screen sidekick Vivian Vance also starred; Here's Lucy (1968-74), which costarred her real-life children, Lucie and Desi Jr.; and Life With Lucy (1986), a short-lived series in which she played a zany grandmother alongside another longtime foil, Gale Gordon.
When fans rave about her glory, they're usually referring to I Love Lucy (1951-57). The show was so popular that pretty much anyone lucky enough to own a television had it turned to CBS to watch her.
As Van Johnson, who guest starred on I Love Lucy, says, "Who could escape those big baby blues, and that timing? She wrote the book."
