

Team Vegetables With Meat For Diet To Build Healthy Families

It's not what to serve that puzzles so many cooks. It's how to serve it that has them stopped. Variety and nutrition are highly important in building a healthier nation. While most homemakers know that their families daily should have two vegetables, one of which should be green or yellow, it's the planning of delicious combinations of other foods with these vegetables which troubles them.

One good way to simplify the job of building good meals is to make lists of foods which not only are good affiliates but which also have the proper food elements as recommended by the National Nutrition Conference. Then these lists may form the basis for many a week's meals. To them, simply add bread and butter, a beverage, and dessert, if you like, and there you are with a complete meal.

A starter list of food combinations which supply necessary food elements is as follows:

- Baked cauliflower, baked sweet potatoes, smoked picnic shoulder.
- Seven-minute cabbage, glazed carrots, stuffed flank steak.
- Celery-cabbage salad, baby beets, lamb shanks.
- Buttered green beans, corn in casserole, boneless rump roast.
- Zucchini in garlic butter, creamed potatoes, cube steaks.
- Steamed broccoli, baked sweet potatoes, fresh ham roast, cabbage and pineapple salad.
- Okra cooked with tomatoes, hamburger ring, pineapple and cottage cheese salad.
- Buttered lima beans, vegetable salad, beef patties.
- Baked squash, scalloped tomatoes and celery, short ribs.
- Hot spiced beets, mashed potatoes, rolled pork shoulder.
- Julienne carrots, "boiling" beef dumplings.
- Fried egg plant, Spanish rice, braised liver.
- Buttered wax beans, asparagus, veal shoulder roast.
- Button onions and potato cubes in beef pie, beet and cucumber salad.
- Mashed rutabagas, browned potatoes, stuffed breast of veal.
- Spinach and hard-cooked egg, corned beef hash.
- Grilled tomato, broiled lamb shoulder steaks, broiled potatoes sprinkled with cheese.
- Baked tomatoes, carrot and pineapple salad, pot roast.
- Eggplant in casserole, boiled potatoes, braised bluffy pork steaks.
- Harvard beets, fluffy rice, creamed dried beef.
- Cabbage wedges, boiled potatoes, corned beef.
- Red cabbage in sour sauce, baked potatoes, stuffed pork chops.
- Braised celery, sweet potatoes, tomato aspic salad, lamb shoulder roast.

FSA To Assist Farmers Hurt By Hurricane

DALLAS, Sept. 25 (AP)—Plans for assisting distressed farmers in the Texas hurricane area were announced by C. M. Evans, regional director of the Farm Security Administration.

Following reports of extensive crop damage in the coastal region, Evans instructed FSA rural supervisors in the stricken counties to make an immediate survey of the need for funds in their areas.

FSA loans are available to farmers who were victims of the hurricane and who are unable to get adequate credit elsewhere, Evans said.

"In cases of acute need, the Farm Security Administration is also prepared to make direct grants for subsistence purposes," Evans said.

The FSA office in Dallas Wednesday had received reports of damage in the agricultural areas of Brazoria, Matagorda, San Patricio, Orange, Harris, Jefferson, Galveston and other coastal area counties.

OH, HOW GOOD IT IS!

A trick which quite checks up the flavor of a cold roast—especially pork—is that of simmering it in a spicy barbecue sauce. Here is a recipe for making it:

Fork in Barbecue Sauce

- 6 thick slices of pork
- 1-2 tablespoons fat
- 6 tablespoons chopped onion
- 3-4 cup chili sauce
- 6 tablespoons vinegar
- 2-4 teaspoon salt
- 3 tablespoons brown sugar
- 1-2 teaspoon dry mustard
- 2-4 teaspoon chili powder

Melt fat in frying pan, add onion and cook over low heat two or three minutes. Add remaining ingredients, mix well and bring to boiling. Add meat, heat thoroughly, and serve.

Americans Stock Up On Liquor; Taxes To Show Up Tardily

WASHINGTON, Sept. 25 (AP)—Thousands of Americans have been stocking up on liquor so heavily lately that the new higher liquor tax won't reach them for months to come.

The treasury revealed today that in August, for instance, the liquor industry withdrew 10,092,469 tax gallons of distilled spirits from warehouses. This was more than double the 4,847,967 gallons of the similar month last year. September figures may be even more startling.

The new tax law, effective Oct. 1, increases the distilled spirits tax from \$5 a gallon to \$6 a gallon and levies a \$1 floor tax on all liquor on hand in liquor-selling establishments on Oct. 1. The new rates are expected to mean an increase of at least 25 cents a quart on bottle goods purchased by consumers.

Gas Retailer Points To Idle Tank Cars

MILWAUKEE, Sept. 25 (AP)—Guy Runyon, of Ames, Ia., president of the National Association of Petroleum Retailers, declared here that there were 30,000 idle tank cars in the country, despite "Secretary of Interior Ickes' contention of a gasoline transportation shortage."

Speaking at a convention of the retail gasoline dealers association of Wisconsin, Runyon claimed that retailers had not been consulted by Ickes, petroleum coordinator, as to petroleum policies. Runyon urged unity with the administration wherever possible, but said the administration so far had neglected the retail industry.

Pipelines In Rocky Mountains Break

DENVER, Sept. 25 (AP)—There was little or no gas along part of the eastern slope of the Rockies today, but with their supply of fuel for warmth, nourishment and industry cut off, residents met the crisis with resourcefulness.

New Mexico flood waters cut in two places a natural gas line from the Texas Panhandle through Colorado to Cheyenne, Wyo.

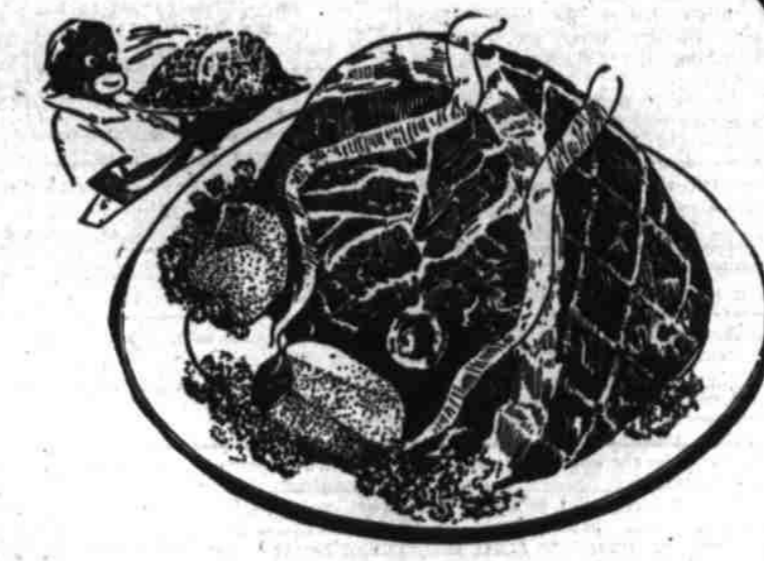

It's Time For Stews, Pot Pies, And Other Homespun Dishes When There's Snap In Air



Dried Beef and Corn Make One Square Meal

It's time for stews, pot pies, savory escalloped dishes and other homespun dishes relished by the family when there is snap in the air.

MEAT PINWHEELS are satisfying, friendly to the budget and have their full quota of health-making material. Make up a soft, rich biscuit dough, pat it out until 1-4 inch thick. Spread lightly with butter and with a pound of hamburger, cooked 5 minutes in water to cover and then drained (reserve the drained stock). Season the meat with salt, pepper, diced celery, parsley and onion and roll up. Cut off 1 1/2 inch slices and arrange, flat sides up, in shallow greased baking pan. Bake 20 minutes in a moderately hot oven. Cover with gravy made from the reserved stock and milk. Serve in the dish in which baked. Bake a cottage pudding or gingerbread along with the pin-

wheels and have it for dessert topped with a hot orange sauce.

MACARONI SCRAMBLE is another main dish just right for a chilly day. Simmer 5 minutes 1-2 cup each chopped onions and celery in 5 tablespoons fat (bacon suggested), add 3 cups cooked macaroni, 2 cups tomatoes, 1 1/4 teaspoons salt, 1-4 teaspoon each of powdered cloves, paprika and poultry seasoning. Simmer 20 minutes. Stir frequently with a fork. Add 1/2 cup grated cheese, mix well and serve.

VEAL CURRY goes under a pastry top. Cut a pound veal shoulder into inch cubes, sprinkle with flour and quickly brown in 4 tablespoons fat, heated in frying

DRIED BEEF AND CORN

(Four Servings)

- 2 1/2 cups corn, No. 2 can
 - 1 1/2 cup dried beef
 - 2 tablespoons butter
 - 2 tablespoons flour
 - 1 cup condensed mushroom soup
 - 4 baking powder biscuits or rolls
1. Drain corn and save liquid for gravy.
 2. Brown corn and shredded dried beef in butter in saucepan until slightly dry; add flour and continue browning for two minutes.
 3. Add soup and liquid from corn and cook about 5 minutes over low direct heat, stirring until thickened. There should be 1-3 cup of liquid; if not enough corn liquid, use milk.
 4. Break baking powder biscuit or rolls in half, toast and butter them and top with dried beef and corn.
