Briscoe Named Head Of Water Import Group

AUSTIN (AP) - Gov. Dolph Briscoe announced the appointment Monday of former McAllen Mayor Paul Veale, as head of a statewide committee to work for the approval of a proposal to increase the Texas Water Development Fund by \$400 million.

Will Aerosol Sprays Ruin Us? Scientists Still Aren't Sure

WASHINGTON (AP)-Fluorocarbons from aerosol spray cans have damaged the earth's protective ozone shield and will have to be selectively regulated or banned, the National Academy of Sciences said Monday.

Elsewhere in the United States, by way of comparison, the findings are from data compiled by the Public Health Service, the American Cancer Society and others.

The reports were designed to resolve the controversy over the relationship between fluorocarbons and the earth's ozone layer. The panels said there was insufficient evidence to state precisely the extent of damage to the ozone shield.
