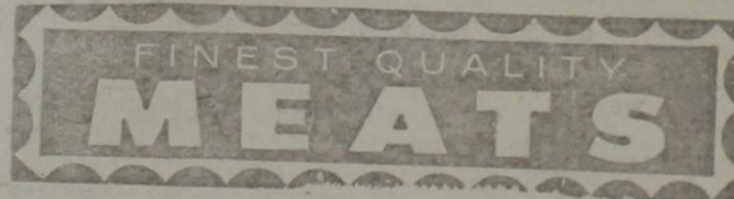

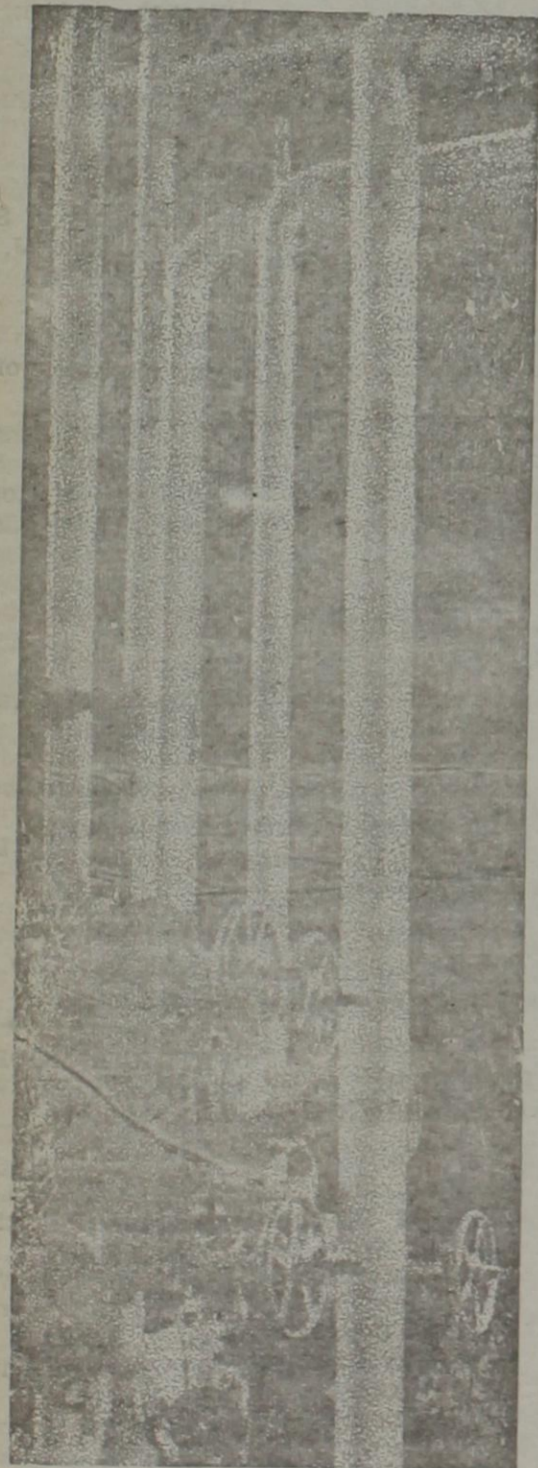

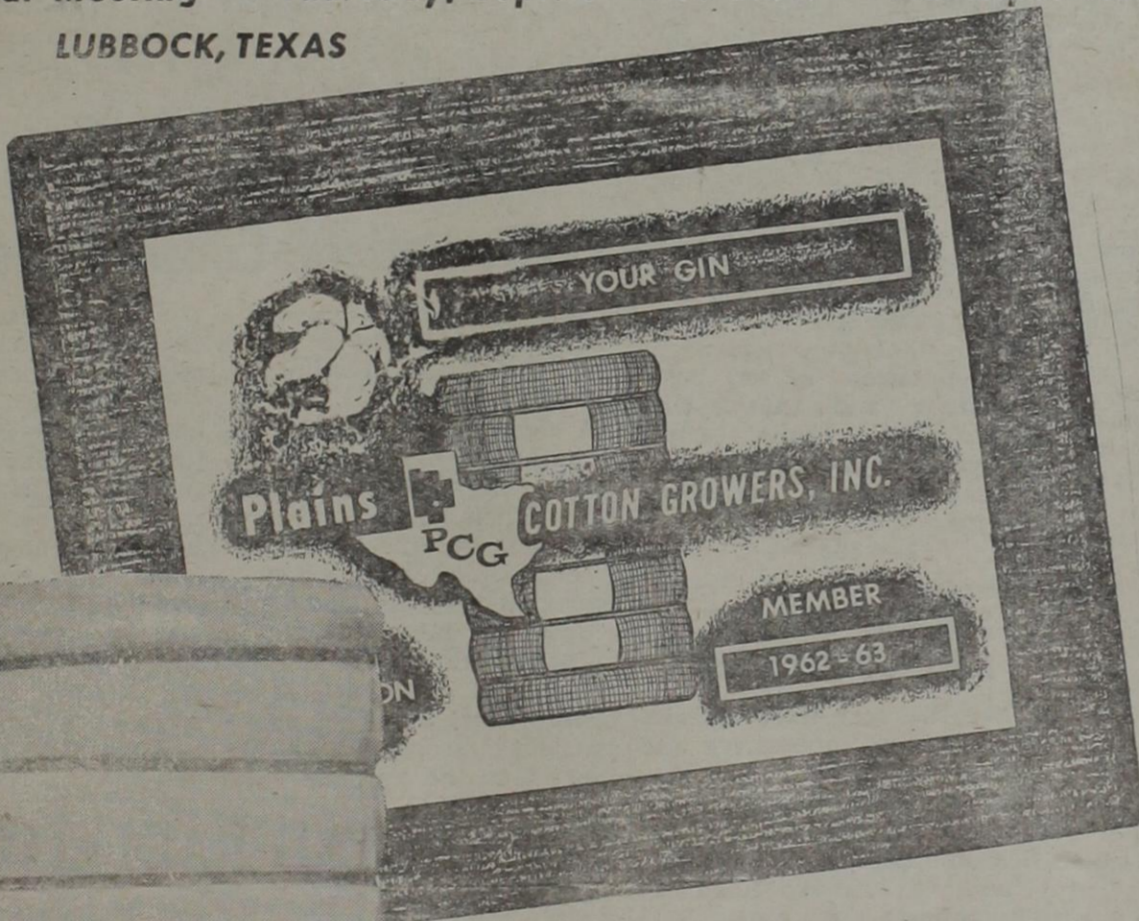

JNO. 8:32

The apostle Paul asked a strange question of the church in Corinth, "Is Christ divided?" I Cor. 1:13. The people in Corinth were following men instead of the Lord and failing to help answer the prayer Jesus prayed in Jno. 17, "that we might all be one". Paul seeing this sad condition wrote, "Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment." I Cor. 1:10. Today, let's ask ourselves, "Is Christ divided". The answer will have to be, NO. Then why will people who profess to be Christians strive to cause division rather than put the same effort in to bringing all men into the one body, the church Jesus died for? THINK on these things.
