



**TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY**

The director of the Texas Department of Public Safety today urged motorists to secure their 1961 vehicle inspection stickers "before the time gets short and the lines get long."

Col. Homer Garrison, Jr. said approximately half of the inspection period has expired and only about one-third of the vehicles in the state have been inspected. Unless the number of inspections is increased appreciably soon, he added, long waiting lines will be forming at inspection stations when the April 15 deadline approaches.

After that date, vehicles not displaying the new inspection sticker will be operating in violation of the law, Garrison said.

"The 4,800 authorized inspection stations over the state are ready and capable of handling the inspection of Texas registered vehicles without delay if owners will not wait until just a few days before the deadline," he said.

Garrison called attention to the fact that since the beginning of the inspection program, vehicles having a defect that was a causative factor in fatal accidents decreased from 13 per cent to five per cent.

"The purpose of the motor vehicle inspection program is to discover

any maladjustment which might become a link in a cycle of events leading to an accident and, by removing the link, prevent the accident," he pointed out.

The chimes at midnight December 31, 1960 dealt the death blow to "Old Father Time". But the echoes and visions of his destruction, grinding metal bodies, crashing glass, broken limbs and smashed lives still haunt us. His record in Hockley County has been an impressive one.

In December the Texas Highway Patrol investigated 13 rural traffic accidents in this county. These wrecks accounted for no persons killed, 7 injured and a property damage of \$6,715.00.

For the entire year of 1960 in this county there were 72 accidents accounting for 6 persons killed, 81 injured and a property damage of \$39,947.00.

In comparison of the year 1959 there were 86 accidents accounting for 5 persons killed, 71 injured and a property damage of \$56,453.00.

"The Texas Department of Public Safety closed its Operation Death-Watch period of ten days at midnight January 1961 with 83 traffic deaths as compared to 97 during the holidays the year before. With late deaths of those critically injured, the figure is expected to come close to the predicted 90 motoricides," stated Highway Patrol Sergeant E. L. Stroud.

The DPS has vacancies for qualified young men in the Department's uniformed services. The Sergeant advised that applications may be obtained at any Highway Patrol office and the deadline for receipt of the complete forms is February 10, 1961.

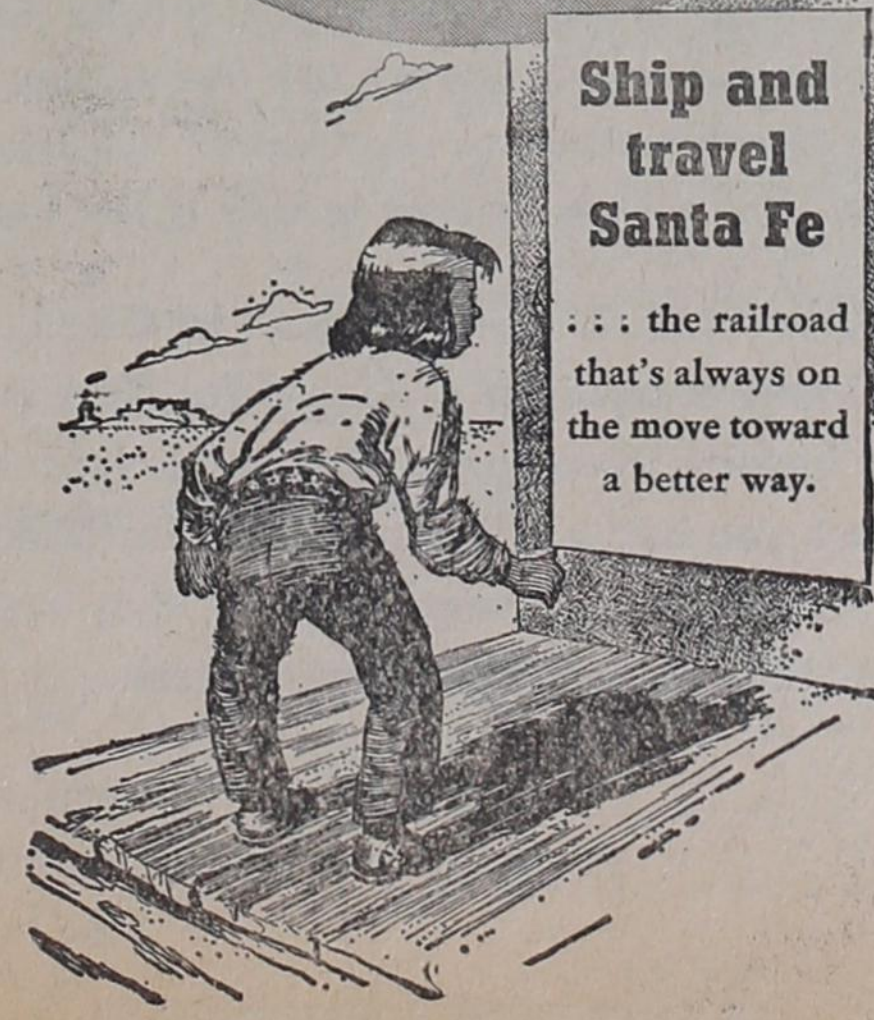

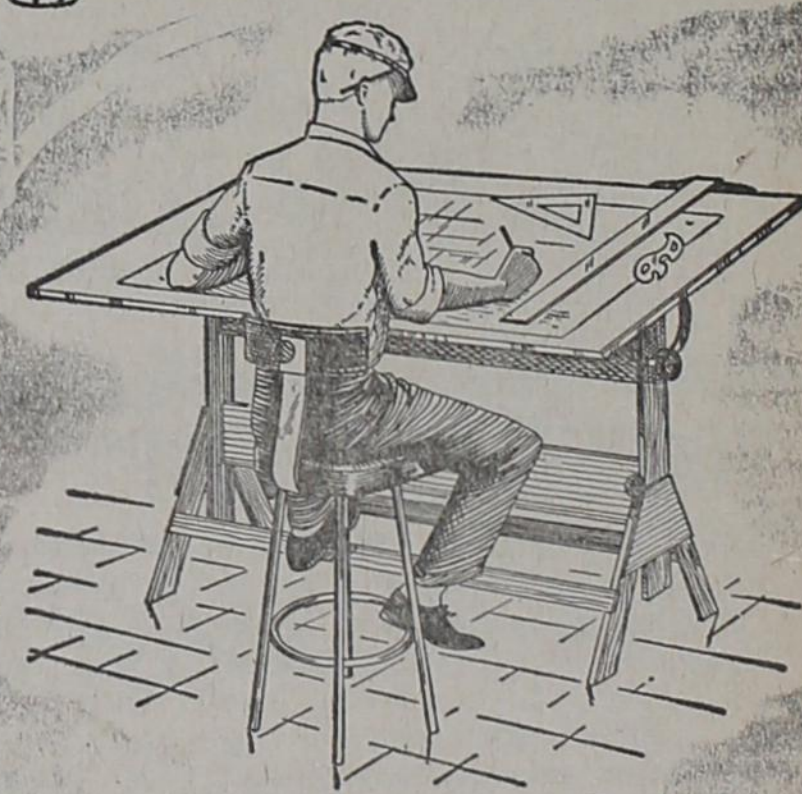

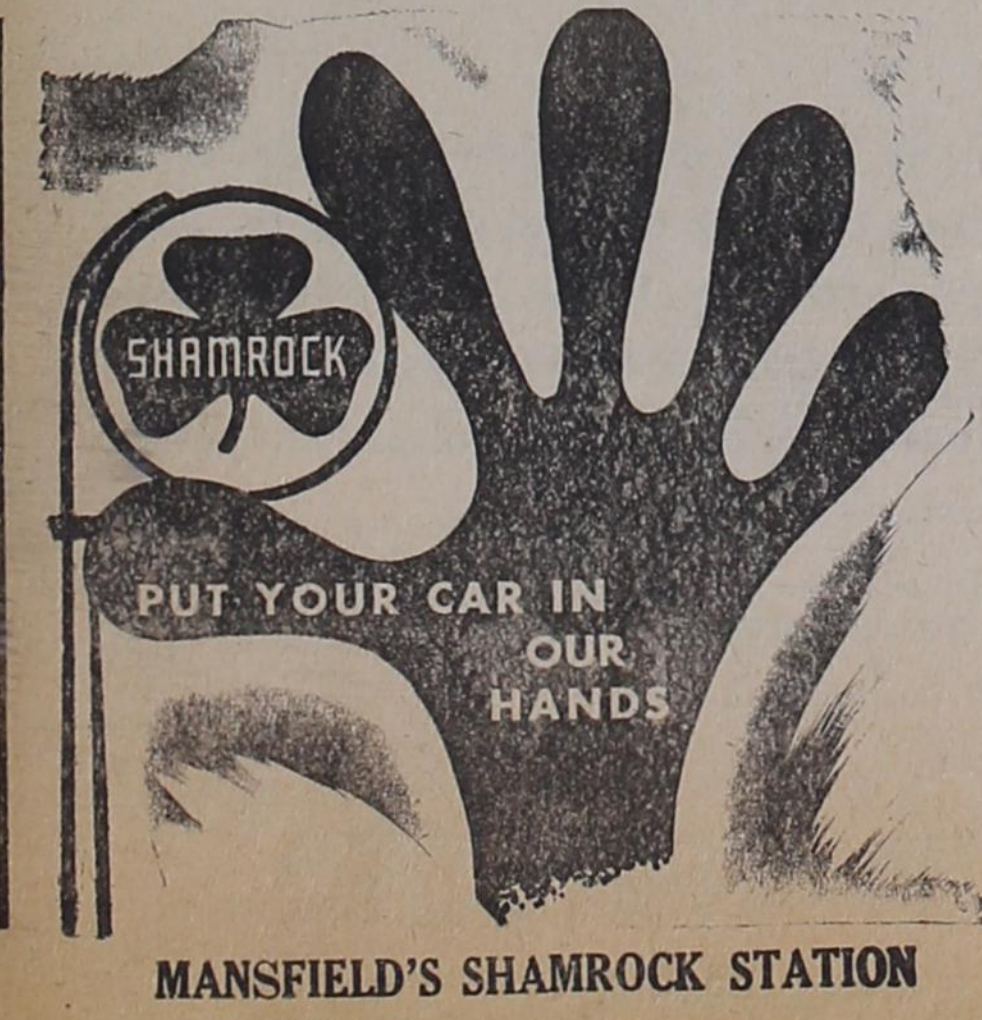
