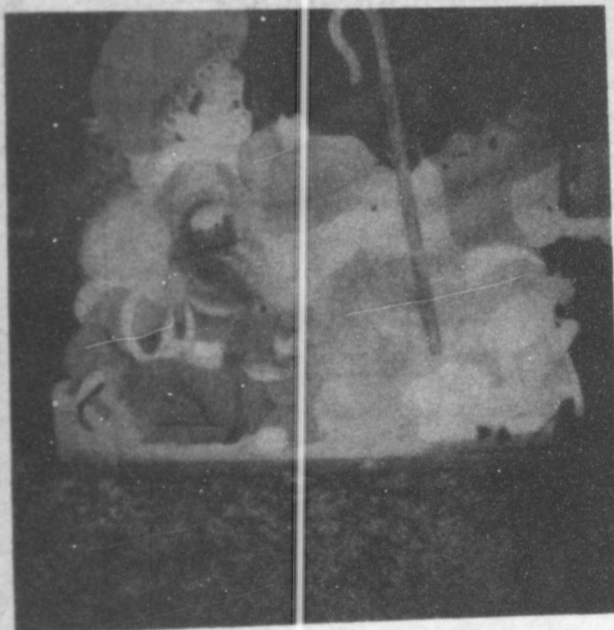

Carson County Commissioners, in regular session Monday, Dec. 14, approved employment of three new persons in the Sheriff's Department. New personnel was needed due to the retirement of Joe and Helen Garcia and reorganization of jailers.

Sandy Rogers was hired as jailer/dispatcher with an annual salary of \$18,436.32 and will begin duties on Jan. 1, 1993.

Angela Wise and Doug Muir were also approved as jailers/dispatchers. The salary for these positions was set at \$12,000 annually for each post. Work began on December 15, 1992.

Commissioners accepted a \$200 bid from George Stevens for the purchase of a 1979 Ford Futura that was involved in a crime that occurred in California.

The court approved the advertising for bids on a new roadgrader for Precinct 1, and for county auto liability insurance. The insurance bids should be scheduled to open January 11, 1993.

1993 Texas Employment Rates Announced

"Texas employers can breathe a sign of relief because their tax rates are not going to escalate significantly," TEC Commissioner Mary Scott Nabers said today as the Texas Employment Commission released tax rates for 1993.

"This has been a trying year. The state's economic woes have caused thousands of businesses to downsize and the result has been massive layoffs throughout Texas. Employment prospects have been so

bleak that unemployment benefits have been extended on an emergency basis numerous times. These factors have greatly concerned Texas employers about their 1993 TEC tax rates," Nabers said.

The maximum rate that could apply to any Texas employer in 1993 will be 6.35 percent according to Nabers. That is up only slightly from last year's maximum rate of 6.30 percent. The lowest rate any business will experience in 1993 will be .35 percent,

up from .30 percent in 1992. The new rates become effective Jan. 1, 1993.

Employers should begin receiving their individual tax rate notices the second week of February. Payment will be due for the first quarter of 1993 in April.

"Employers in Texas pay taxes for every employee's first \$9,000 in wages. Depending on an employer's tax rate, that amount could vary from a low of \$31.50 per person to a high of \$571.50 per person," Nabers said.

This is the time of year that we give thanks and praise to the many ordinary people who give service to our community. Special blessings go to two special people this year.

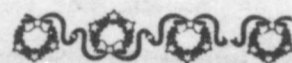
Tom Trostle is one of the good samaritans in McLean who is always there to help with any project.

Indecency with Minors and Child Abuse at various locations in the county. We have been contacted by the Texas Department of Highways regarding several incidents of persons leaving dead cattle, hay, farm

machinery and vehicles along roadways in the county. This not only creates a traffic hazard it is also a violation of the law. Please make every effort to keep the roadways clear and reduce the risk of accidents in the county. While on the topic of accident reduction, it should be noted that pulling sleds, skiers and other pedestrians behind a motor vehicle is

not only a dangerous act, but it, too, is a violation of the law when the vehicle is on a public roadway. While it may seem that law officers in Carson County just don't want you to have a good time, the truth of the matter is that we want you to be able to have a good time with all your body parts left intact. 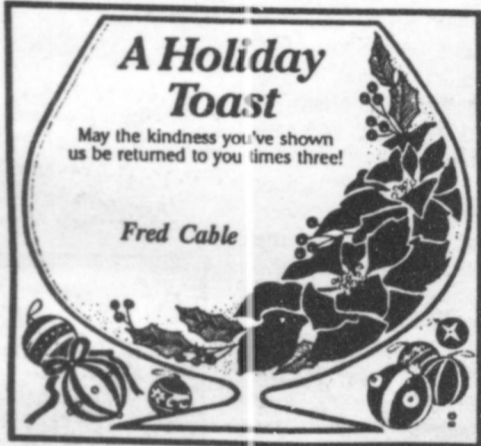

The Court shall award the contract to the responsible bidder who submits the lowest and best bid, or reject all bids and publish a new notice or take such other action as authorized by said Local Government Code.

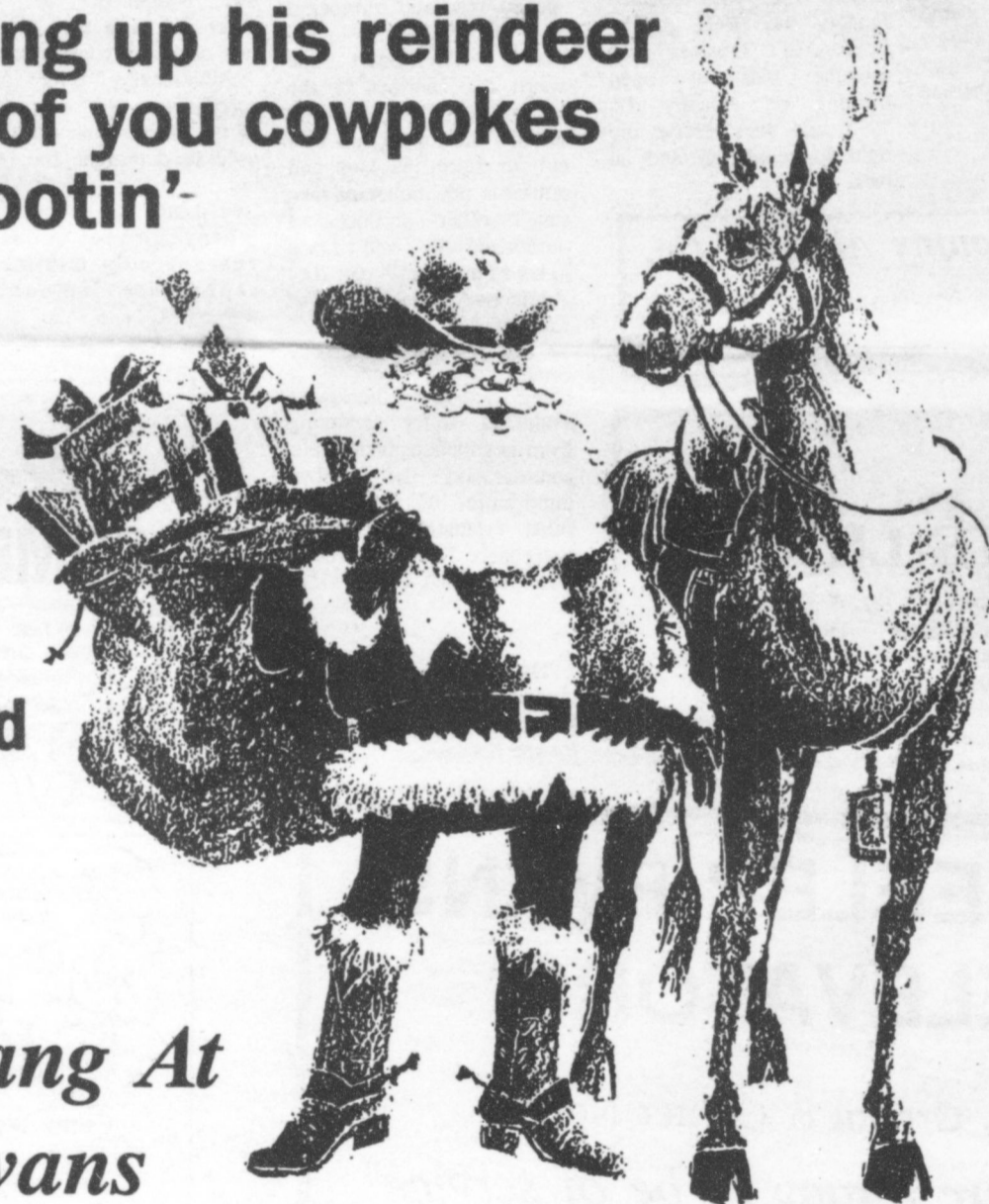
