Paging System To Improve Service

The Groom Volunteer Ambulance Department and the Groom Volunteer Fire Department are fully on-line with a new system of communication. Ambulance and Fire Department volunteers will now have a pager system to call them out for service.

The new system does not do away with any other methods of communication, but adds another option.

"One of the problems we were having with the current system is that there are just not that many of us here in town during the day," stated

Ambulance Service President John Bohr. "We needed a way to let members know that a call for help had come in, even if they are out of hearing of the emergency phones or the emergency whistle."

Thanks to a matching grant, the emergency volunteers will now have pagers to let them know where the emergency is and what type of service is needed. The paging system will take the place of the fire phones.

"The fire phones were always a little confusing because you might have ten people answering at the same time," continued Bohr.

With the new paging system a volunteer will also be able to talk to the person placing the emergency call, thereby knowing the nature of the emergency, the equipment and manpower needed.

Residents can still call the local emergency

phone number 248-7311, or they can call 9-1-1. The emergency whistle will still blow, just in case one of the volunteers doesn't hear his pager.

Northern Natural Gas donated the paging terminal at a cost of approximately \$1800. The rest of the expense was paid equally by the Texas Department of Health and the Groom Volunteer Ambulance Department.

"We are very hopeful that this will improve our response time," said John Bohr. "We should be able to talk to each other also, increasing our range to around 30 miles."

This feature will be especially helpful during grass and range fires.

The Ambulance Department will soon be scheduling EMT classes. Contact any member for more information or attend a meeting on the second Tuesday of each month at the fire hall.

Former Editor & Longtime Resident Passes Away

Helen Virginia Vassey Wade, 83, died Friday, December 18, 1998 in Groom.

Services were Saturday at the First Baptist Church in Groom with Rev. Byron Williamson, pastor, officiating.

Burial was in the Groom Cemetery by Carmichael-Whatley Funeral Directors of Pampa.

Mrs. Wade was born

on June 30, 1915 in Wilbarger County to the pioneer family of D.C. Vassey. Her family moved to Bovina, Texas in 1920. She married Walter Max Wade on July 10, 1932 in Clovis, New Mexico and moved to Groom. She and her husband celebrated their 66th wedding anniversary this past summer. She



We also thank the people and businesses in McLean. Without each other there probably would not be a paper in either town.



Council Approves Retirement Fund Changes, Trustee

The City Council of McLean met in regular session Wednesday, December 9, 1998 in the City Hall. The meeting was called to order by the Mayor and opened with an invocation by Sam Haynes at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Bob Martin, Sam Haynes, Ford Smith, Jr., Jim McDonald, and Charles McClendon. Gordon Sheplor was absent.

Others present were Fred Smith, Toni Bohlar, Allen Mixon, Ann Pierce, Vonda Averett, Ray Kirkland, Garth Thomas, David Haynes, Marvin Conners, and Marvin Graham.

The minutes of the November meeting were approved.

All motions were unanimously approved unless otherwise stated.

EDC business was postponed until January's meeting, with the exception of discussion on the new EDC board members which will be in Executive Session.

David Haynes with Farm Bureau Insurance

gave a progress report on information about the employee's retirement fund. He asked the council to move the retirement annuities from Jackson National and New England to his company which is paying a higher interest rate, and to authorize Toni Bohlar, City Secretary to act as trustee for the retirement fund. The council voted to do so, with the exception of Sam Haynes who abstained from voting.

The mayor opened the only bank depository bid received from Bank of Commerce, McLean, which was for a 2 year period beginning January 1, 1999 and ending December 30, 2000. The council agreed to go with the Bank of Commerce.

Toni Bohlar asked the council to authorize her to act as trustee for the employee's retirement fund and presented a letter that needed to be signed by the council members stating this fact to be sent to American General Annuity company. The council

agreed to the above request.

The council voted to approve the 1998 Tax Roll of \$53,868.56.


The council voted to allow McLean's Lovett Memorial Library to file an application for a TIFB Grant in the amount of \$2,556.20 with the Telecommunications Infrastructure Fund Board.

Bob Martin questioned leasing offices at the hospital clinic building to commercial businesses. He wanted to know if that was done would the city have to pay taxes on the building. The council instructed the city secretary to check with the city attorney.

Discussion was held concerning drawing up a new bond ordinance to amend the original ordinance to change how some of the funds were to be spent. The council decided not to take any action at this time.

Fred Smith informed the council that employee Kevin Johnson was on the agenda to ask for a
