The City continues to allow watering between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. Water use between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. is restricted in order to minimize evaporation. The restrictions are part of the City's impation ordinance, which applies from Agril 1s to September 30th each year, and are designed to minimize weter lost to evaporation during the warmer and windier times of day. Exceptions are allowed for newly planted grass or landscaping, stoket house, and wherting by hand.

The City continues to allow watering two days per week with up to one and a half inches of water for each area of the yard. Four Health Care Reform Policies that Positively Effect the Latino Community

to the health care system will not be implemented until 2014, here are four key provisions that show promise to reach the Latino community in the immediate months:

 Insurance Options for Sick Americans. Uninsured because you have a medical problem? You are not alone. Latinos are disproportionately affected by certain chronic diseases and health conditions that often result in denial of health insurance or unaffordable premium rates. By the end of June 2010, the government is expected to set up new insurance options for individuals with serious health conditions who were previously "uninsurable" or "priced out" of insurance.

In the next few months, low-wage firms with less than 25 employees can receive a tax credit for up to 35% of their contributions toward their employees' health coverage, if they
