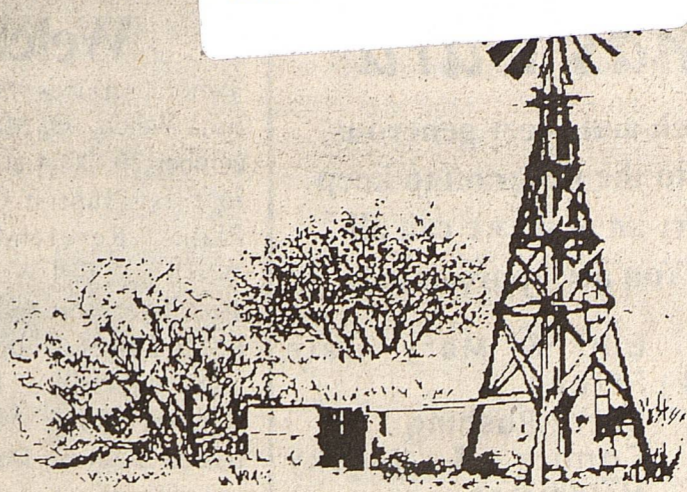

Flu shots now available at both county clinic sites

CCN learned Thursday afternoon both the West Texas Medical Center in Denver City, and the Plains Clinic here, have ample supplies of influenza vaccine to administer flus shots to residents of both communities.

Jo Lena Wall, PA - C at the clinic here, said " Anyone wanting to guard against coming down with the flu by getting a preventive shot may call the clinic for an appointment". She said cost of the inoculation is \$15 per person, payable by cash, Medicare, or other type health insurance. The clinic number is 456-6365. For residents wanting to get their shot in Denver City, appointments may be made at West Texas Medical Center by calling 592-9501. Both site personnel stress senior citizens, and others susceptible to respiratory type illnesses should consider a flu shot during the typical season.

Truck driver arraigned on criminal negligence charges in fatal wreck

Guadalupe Sota Medina, 48, on December 14 appeared in Justice of Peace Court, Precinct 2, where DPS Trooper Carmen Medrano testified before Judge Troy Scott he had good reason to believe the defendant Medrano " did unlawfully and by criminal negligence caused the death of " three Denver City school teachers, Veronica Flores, Martina Natividad and Maria Garza and " acted negligent with respect to circumstances surrounding his conduct by disregarding a stop sign and causing an accident." The three teachers were declared deceased at the scene of the wreck.

Medina, a truck driver for a Post oil field company, posted \$7500 bond the day of his arraignment

Grand Jury indicts 9 on 12 charges

Criminal District Attorney Richard Clark's office reported the Yoakum County Grand Jury, chosen September 30, recently returned twelve true bills of indictments on nine defendants. The following summary lists the defendant, the offense, the degree of the felony, and bond amount and bonding agent. All bonds for felony indictments are set by District Judge Kelly G. Moore.

Robert Parras, driving while intoxicated with child under 15 years of age, a state jail felony

Bond set \$2500, by Jerome Head.

Crime cases in County, District Court

In the December 14 session of District Court, assigned Judge Jack D. Young presiding, two criminal cases were heard.

Gilbert Hernandez pled guilty to tampering with a government record. He was sentenced to serve two years in the Institutional Division of the Department of Criminal Justice, with credit for 37 days served. He must pay \$213 court costs. A cause of making terroristic threat in Yoakum County Court was adjudicated. His attorney was Bill Helwig, and Lupe Garcia, Denver City Police, was investigating officer.

James Brandon Connolly entered a plea bargain with order modifying in an aggravated assault with deadly weapon cause (motion to proceed). He shall report weekly to Yoakum County CSCD within 14 days notification of acceptance into Relapse Treatment and remain in jail until space is available in a substance abuse felony punishment facility for a term of not less than 90 days or more than one year. Paul Mansur served as his attorney.

In County Court December 15, Judge Dallas Brewer presiding, Ruby Lee Padilla pled true to the state's motion to revoke supervision from a prior assault causes bodily injury cause. He will serve 30 days in jail with credit for 29 days served, must pay \$256 delinquent court costs, CSCD fees of \$838, and \$20 restitution. Warren New was his attorney.

Albino Sainz Jr, pled true to the state's motion to revoke supervision from a prior assault causes bodily injury cause. He was ordered to serve 45 days in jail with credit for 48 days served. A hold was issued by the state of Missouri.

Criminal District Attorney Richard Clarke represented the state in both court sessions.

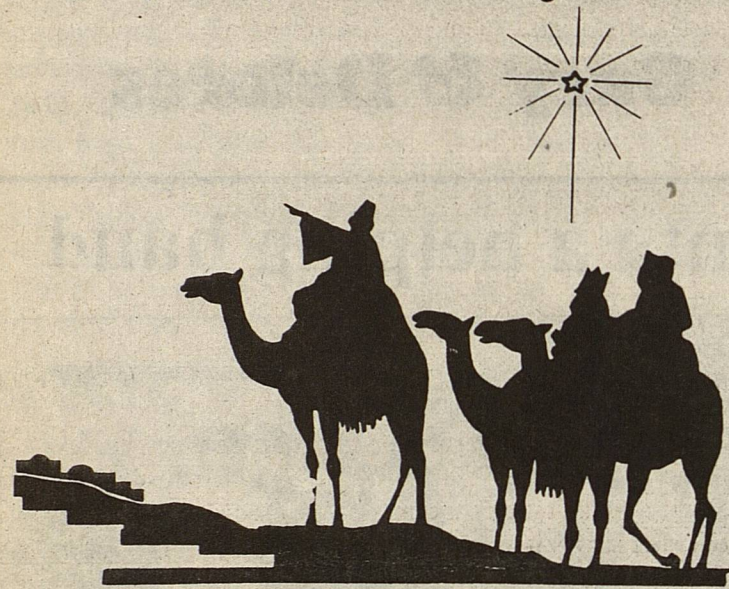

From Rural Texas to Rhode Island: Fresh Ideas for Rural Tourism

Visitors from 18 foreign countries and every state in the Union but one – that's the remarkable boast of the Dumas and Moore County Chamber of Commerce in the Texas Panhandle. Since opening February 2003, the Visitor Center has registered guests from every state except Rhode Island. Not ones to leave a challenge unanswered, leaders from this rural Texas community of just more than 18,000 have launched a tourism marketing campaign to entice visitors from Rhode Island, some 2,000 miles north.

The first Rhode Islander to visit Dumas and register at the Visitor Center will be greeted Texas style – with steak and barbecue dinners, a bed and breakfast stay, a dozen Texas yellow roses and gift certificates from local merchants. Not to be outdone, the department of tourism in Rhode Island is auctioning a similar travel package to Dumas.

Success in attracting that one visitor, and many others along the way, is almost guaranteed, for the history of Dumas is long in perseverance. A plague of grasshoppers followed by a severe winter almost reduced Dumas to a ghost town in 1893, but the residents' determination to stay in the windswept flatlands paid off when oil and natural gas were discovered in 1926. Today Dumas and Moore County lead in producing grain sorghum, natural gas and two-thirds of the nation's helium supply.

Proving no idea is too small to spark success, that's the secret at the heart of Texas Yes!, a member-based program sponsored by the Texas Department of Agriculture for rural communities, businesses and organizations to promote business development, job growth and tourism in rural Texas.

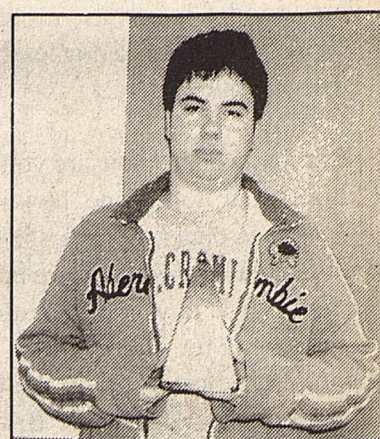

Senior Citizens Corner

It happened again this year, on the same day as all of the years before. The doorbell rang and there stood the delivery girl with a breathtaking Poinsettia! Each year our daughter orders this special early Christmas gift for us. As I set it in prominent place where we could enjoy it everyday, I thought about how the poinsettia has become such an integral part of the Christmas season the world over. Long before Christianity was introduced to the Americans, the Aztec in Mexico were cultivating this colorful red and green plant.

In addition to its ornamental value, the poinsettia has had many uses. The plant's red bracts were used to make a reddish-purple dye, or were placed on a person's chest to stimulate circulation. They were crushed and applied to skin infections. It was also used to fight fevers, however, the plant has little medicinal applications today.

The plant gets its name from an American who first introduced it to the United States. His name was Joel Robert Poinsett, the first U.S. ambassador to Mexico. One year we vacationed in Taxco, Mexico, at Christmas time and saw first-hand this brilliantly colored plant that the Franciscan priests of that area first used in their nativity procession. The poinsettia, an Aztec reminder of human blood sacrifices, soon came to represent the blood of Christ to Catholics and Christians. Today the poinsettia is synonymous with Christmas and is the most popular plant in the world.
