Many more hard yet exciting months passed and in October, 1979, the choir held its first concert. Lawrence added, "The Lord was really with us because He provided the success we needed."

The choir is now in their third year and has a membership of twenty-four members.

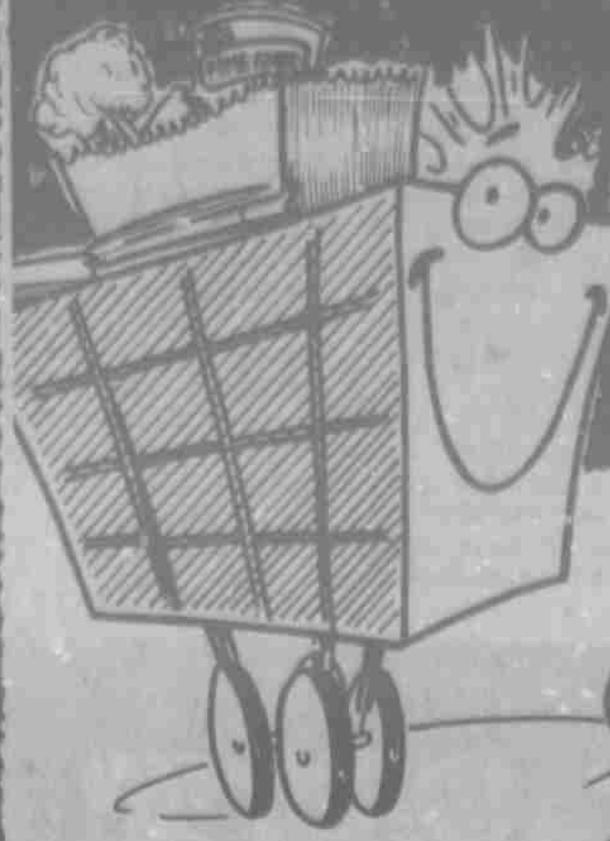
