services they need while they remain in thei homes.
Home hasth care serviturs include part-time skilled nursing care, phycial therapy, ans speec therapy. Moreover, it any of these services if.
needed, Medicare aiso may pay for the part-time needed, Menicare aiso may pay for the par-time
services of an occupational therapist, home heatth aide, or medtoat sociat worker, as wett as for medical supplies and applianness, furnished by a home health agency. A home health agency is a
public or private organization that specializes in providing skilled nursing and other fealth ccre servites to patients th theil own homes. Four criteria must de met if either Medicare hospital or medical insurance is to pay for home
heaith care: (1) the patient must need part-time skilled nursing care or physical or speech therapy; (2) the patient must be confined to the home; (3) a doctor must prescribe home health care and establish a home health care plan; and Medicare.
It these oriteria are met, either Medicare haspital or medinal insurance will pay the reasonable cost for unlimited covered hame will pay for the care.
More detailed information about Mgdicare is contained in Your Medlcare Handbook. Questlon: My inother is receiving home health
care, but she is bedly in need of homemaker services. Is this covered under her Medicare health insurance?
Answer: Homemaker services, such as preparing meals and helping to meat personal
care needs, are not covered under Medicare. Uare needs, are not covered under medicare sre mecessary only for the dlegnoels and Hreatment of an liliness or Injury. Questinn: My father received service by a home
