Two years ago Lubbock Habitat started planning for a large-scale blitz build during Building on Faith week 2000. In 1999 Lubbock Habitat for Humanity was able to acquire a property of 15 acres, which is currently being developed into a subdivision for 78 Habitat homes. During Building on Faith week Lubbock Habitat in partnership with 12 churches, 8 corporations, 2 groups of civic clubs and the West Texas Home Builders Association built 17 houses. The project involved over 4,000 volunteers, almost all of which were from the local community. Before the end of the year Lubbock habitat will complete 3 more houses, two of which have already been started and are near completion.

In July of 2000 Lubbock Habitat received a "Best of the Best" award from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development for its program of vocational education in partnership with Lubbock Independent School District and the Rudd Prison Unit to build affordable homes.

Another exciting partnership was designated by Habitat for Humanity International as a 21st Century Challenge Community, meaning that Lubbock has an organization and a Lubbock prior to 2020, Lubbock was First United Methodist Church and our Habitat Donors.

The average Texas Tech student takes 5.5 years to graduate. The minimum number of hours required for a degree is 120. Ifa student averages 15 hours per semester, that student should graduate in four years. Some degree programs require more hours. which means that students may need to take some summer classes or more hours during the long semesters.

Stenholm opposed to legislative maneuvering, calls for open debate on increasing debt limit

Washington, D.C. U.S. Congressman Charlie Stenholm (TX-17) today opposed an effort to use parliamentaD' maneuvers to slip through an increase in the debt limit to more than \$8 trillion. Stenholm joined colleagues in the Blue Dog Coalition in calling for the Leadership of the House of Representatives to schedule a separate vote on whether to increase the country's debt limit by \$690 billion.

the Leadership added vague, openended language regarding the debt limit to an unrelated, non-controversial defense appropriations bill that is certain to receive the long-term budget policies." approval of the House of Representatives hter today.

"We can all agree we need to support our troops by passing the defense spending bill today, but we have no business using this

long-term increase in the debt ceiling," Stenhohn said. "The rule the House Leadership has crafted would allow Congress to increase the debt ceiling without addressing the fiscal problems that are at the very root of why we have no choice but to increase the debt

"If the Leaders of this House have determined we are in such dire straits that we have to raise the debt burden of every American by Late Monday night, July 21, \$2,000 to avoid default, then by all means this issue deserves its own debate and its own vote. The taxpayers should get nothing less than a serious re-examination of our

"When folks in West Texas realize they are spending more money than they are bringing in, they draw up a new budget and work to get their financial affairs back on track," Stenholm said. important legislation to hide a "Before Congress votes to approve

a substantial increase in the debt limit, Congress and the President should work together to put our nation's fiscal house back in order, just as any responsible, tax-paying family would do back home."

Stenholm joined Congressmen John Tanner (D-TN) and Baron Hill (D-IN), both active members of the Blue Dog Coalition, in calling for Congress to restore "payas-you-go" budget enforcement rules before approving another increase in the debt limit.

"Just like credit card spending limits serve as tools to force families to examine their household budgets, the debt limit reminds Congress and the President to evaluate our budget policies," Stenholm said. "We should be following that principle by working to bring our budget back into balance before approving another increase in our nation's credit

Most Think Real Estate is the Best Investment Overall

Given continuing low interest rates, the recent bear market and solid returns on real estate investments, it is no surprise that most respondents in this year's survey consider real estate to be a better investment than stocks or mutual funds.

Specifically, 61% of Blacks and 51% of Whites say real estate is the best investment overall, while just 28% of Blacks and 32% of Whites cite stocks or mutual funds. This marks the first year that the majority of both Blacks and Whites favor real estate over all other investment categories combined. By comparison, In 2000, just 43% of Blacks and 31% of Whites chose real estate as the best investment. That same year, 40% of Blacks and 56% of Whites chose stocks or mutual funds as the best investment.


Ariel's Hobson said, "Like any other investment category, real estate is cyclical and has its share of ups and downs. We'll see if this perception survives higher interest rates."

The National Women of Color Technology Awards Conference is a venue that offers encouragement for women to seek careers in these fields and knowledge to help them succeed.


