## Ruby is her name

(Editor's Note: This arxicle appeared in the May 3003 Hillcrest Herald and written by Er est Holsendolph).

Ruby Giddens made her Christian commitment out'y and grew it fabulously as a Marshall Keeble kid. Her tife has been an exemplary one, with faithful family all around her.

We know her now as I he faithful mother of a Hillorest family, including David, Twyle, Daverte, Ryan and the late Eddie Jr., and the wire of Eddie Sr.

But the spiritual beginning for Ruby started in her home town of Lubbock, Texas, when renowned Evangolist Marshall Keeble conducted meeting.

At age 12 Ruby obeyed the gospel. And just two years later she followed the Keeble trail to Tennessee, where she enrolled in the Nashville Christian institute, a oburch preparatory school perhaps best known for preparing best known for preparing black gospel preach-

Ruby, at age 14, was one of the few NCI young ladies, and had very special living quarters.

We girls lived in the Keeble home, about six of us," she said. "One of the boys could come by and drive us to school," she added. "It was a very good education, and we attended chapel services everyday. And, of course, one of the special rewards was listening to Pops, as we called Brother Keeble."

Some historians say NCL which was state-accredited from the beginning and whole president was Marshall Keeble, produced as many as 500 gospel preachers between 1940 and the

school's closing in 1967. Two of the graduates known to just about everybody are Billie Washington and Joe Brown," she said, referring to two prominent gospel preachers from Fort Lauderdale, Florida and Richmond, Virginia, respec-

Another famous graduate is attorney Fred Gray.

Amid protests. MSNBC's Chris Matthews said he was wrong this winter to any Clinton was a candidate because "her husband messed around." And MSNBC reporter David Shuster was suspended for two weeks for saying Clinton's compaign had "pimped out" daughter Cheisea by having her make political phone calls.

"Obame's beby meme" was never mid on the air. Malkin said during her interview that she had seen no grahidous or chesp shots taken against Michelle Obsmir by Republican or conservative crit-
