mer assistant coach John Roberts will rejoin the West Texas State University coaching staff on Feb. l. Roberts' appointment is pending on release from his present obligation to the Stillwater, Oklahoma Public School System.

The vacancy which made it possible for Roberts to join the West Texas staff was created by the resignation of assistant coach Howard White.

White, backfield coach for Kerbel the past two seasons, has been named assistant coach at the University of California at Berkeley under new head coach Ray Willsey.

Roberts, now assistant in his hometown of Stillwater, was a member of the Buffalo staff in 1960 and 1961. He left in 1962 to become head coach at Cameron High School. "I wanted to find out what it was like to be a head coach at the high school level", Roberts said. In 1963 he moved to Stillwater.

"I certainly am looking forward to returning to


Roberts is 27 years old. He married the former Rena Aikens, a West Texas State graduate, in June of 1962. They have no children.


"We feel very fortunate that we were able to secure the services of coach Roberts as our defensive backfield coach", said Kerbel today. "Not only is he one of the keenest




