Some of you may think it is only essential to purchase a poll tax receipt during a national election year...but that's not correct...BE A CITIZEN EVERY YEAR.

You will have only until January 31st to purchase your poll tax receipt. Only those who have purchased this document are permitted to participate in any city, county, state or national election. Anyone who participates in an election must be a gualified voter and you can only vote after presenting a current poll tax receipt and only in the voting box designated on your receipt.

Don't be a "Rip Van Winkle" about purchasing a Poll Tax receipt...he slept for twenty years, without careing about local elections ... and it profited him nothing.




