## SEWERAGE BOND ISSUE CARRIES--SMALL MAJORITY.

The election held last Saturday to determine whether or not onds to the extent of $\$ 20,000$ should be issued by the City of Memphis for the purpose of building a sewerage system throughout the proposition, those in favor of the sewerage polling only a majority of six, which, however, is as good for the pro-sewerists as if it had

Whanied und are opposed to the building of the sewer for reasons of their own-
