## TAX DEBTS ARE JUST OBLIGATIONS

$\mathbf{W}^{\mathbf{E}}$ are nearing the time limit to pay current taxes without additional penalty and interest-January 31. It does not seem likely that the Legislature will take further action regarding remittance of penalties and interest on delinquent taxes. The 43 rd Legislature put itself on record regarding the matter as follows: "a continuation of the policy of remitting the penalty and interest on delinquent taxes would be detrimental to the best interests of the state and would, if, continued lead to still greater delinquencies in tax payments that has ever been in the history of the state."
A tax debt is no different from any other obligation, and the longer it stands unpaid the larger it becomes and the harder it is to pay. A tax debt is a collectible obligation, and we all reaiize that some day we will be called upon to pay.
There are, of course, those who are simply unable to pay their taxes, and no citizen has any desire to urge any taxpayer to do that which he cannot do. However, we do believe that it is the absolute duty of every Americtin citiken to pay his taxes.
if and when it is at all possible for him to do so.
We may feel at times that we receive nothing in return for the money we pay out for tax purposes. However, every convenience that we have, such as educational institutions, good roads, farm relief programs, work relief programs, relief for the destitute and protection for our families, homes and property, is made possible by the money you pay as taxes. Without these facilities and protection, what kind of a country would we have in which to live? It is just as necessary for your country, city and schools to have funds to operate their business on as it is for any other type of business to have financial backing.
Let's each of us do our utmost to contribute our bit, by making every effort possible to pay our current and delinquent taxes this year.
This is your business, as well as the business of your city, school and county, so let's help put it over.
It is much better to keep your current taxes paid, rather than run the risk of lesing your home or property...
