That Schleicher county is rapidly turning to farming interests for more diversity of production and better facilities to care for the increasing population is a fact evidenced by the numerous fields of cotton and maize seen by the traverler. Only a few years ago one could trave: through the length of the county, or across the breadth of it, and never an acre of tilled soil would be observe, Now many smilling acres have felt the cold touch of the shining plowshare, and fields fruited unto the harvest may be seen along every thoroughfare, Last year this county produced 652 bales of cotton, and as the acreage is greater this year, it is safe to say the yield will be even larger, notwithstanding an unusually dry year,

Although there are about 5000 acres under cultivation, this being in cotton, maize, kaffir corn and sorghum, there is practically no irrigation, although facilities are such that eventually this innovation will doubtress be accomplish-






