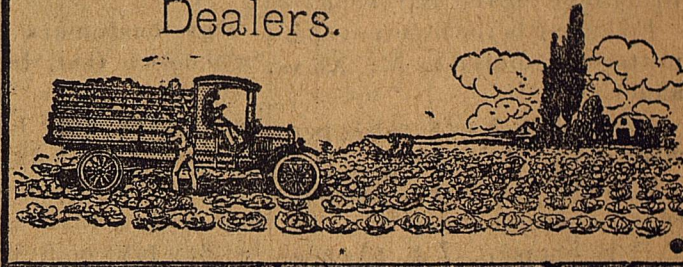

The first person named on each committee is chairman with full power to fill any vacancy that might occur on the committee. It is supposed that each committee shall secure such assistance as they may deem necessary to carry out the work for which they are appointed.

July 13th is expected to be the home gathering of all former Schleicherites, various kind of amusements will be booked, such base ball, goat roping dancing, bull riding and chunking doll babies, so if you are looking for an outing don't forget the date July 13. There will be 13 heaves, 13 sheep, 13 goats and 1300 hundred loaves of bread.

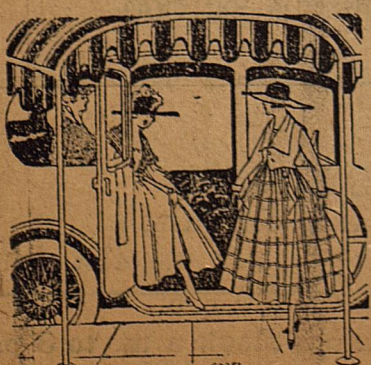

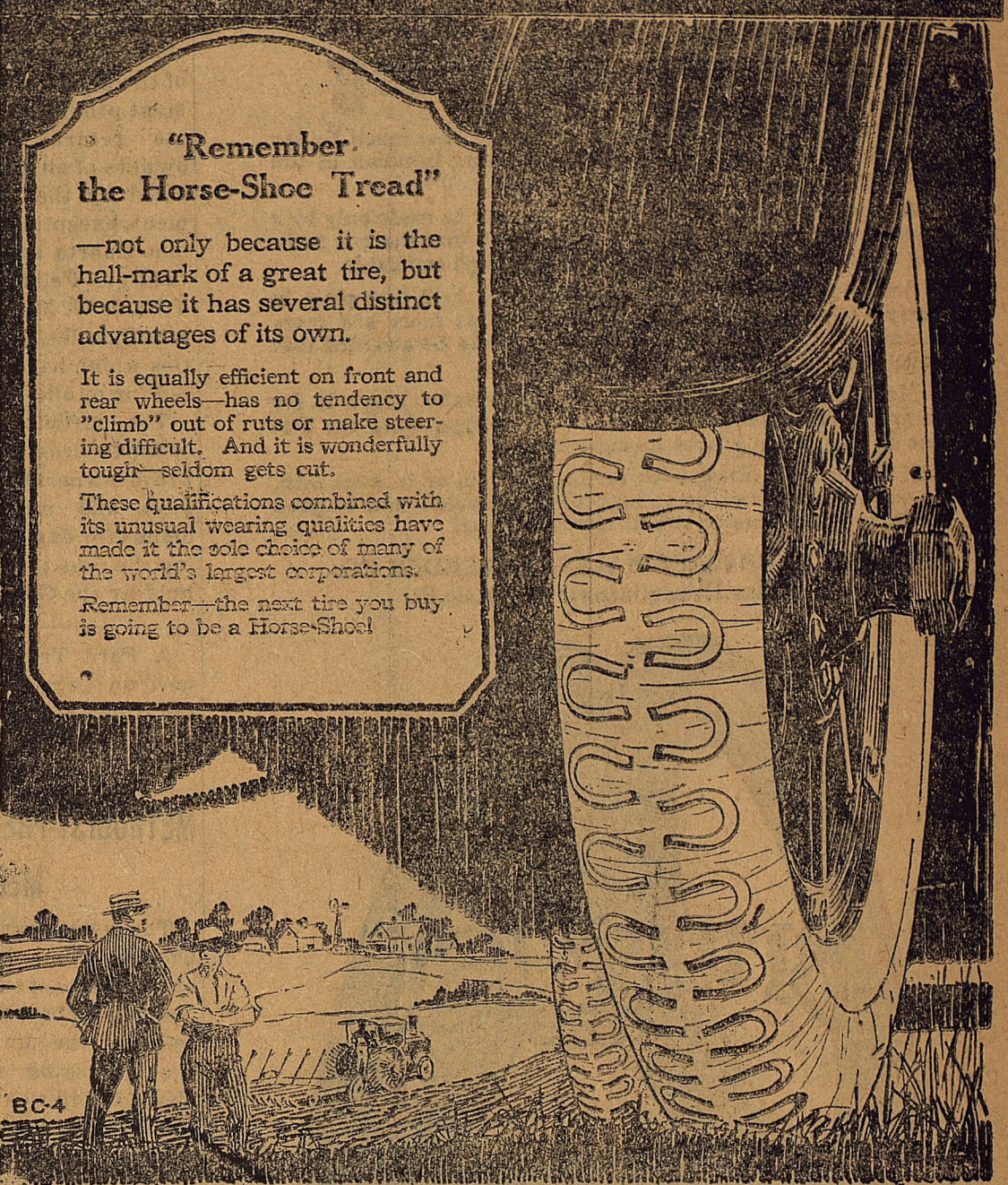

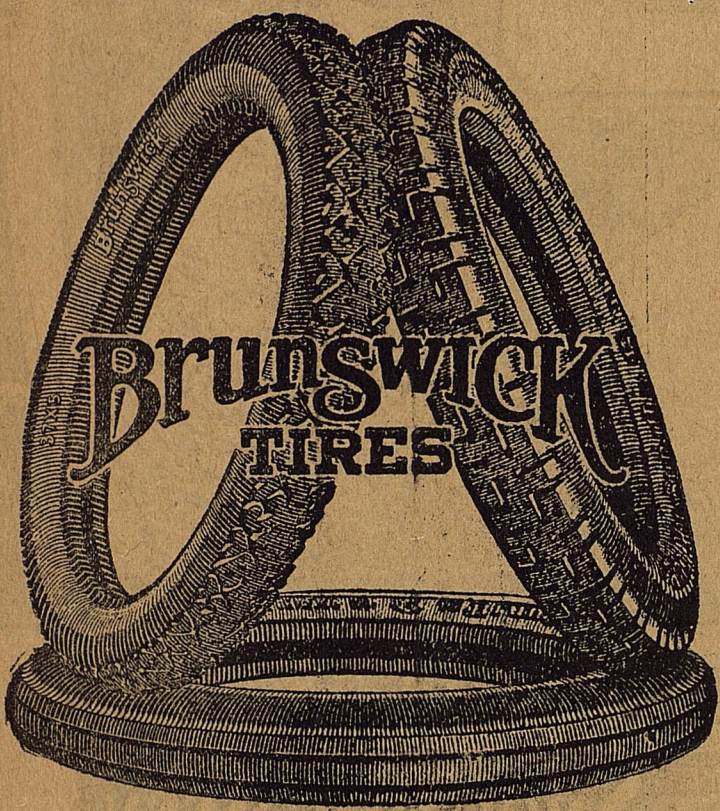

The State Department at Washington has been advised by the American Embassy at Mexico City that the newspapers there had published a circular of the Mexican treasury department providing for the immediate return to their proper owners of all properties confiscated by the Mexican Government, excepting those of Victoriano Huerta and his immediate family. Felix Diaz, Francisco Villa, J. W. Maytorena and Eugenio Paredes, as well as properties which have been expropriated for public purposes.

The circular added that in order to benefit owners must prove ownership within thirty days and must renounce all claims for damages caused during the time the properties were held by the Government.

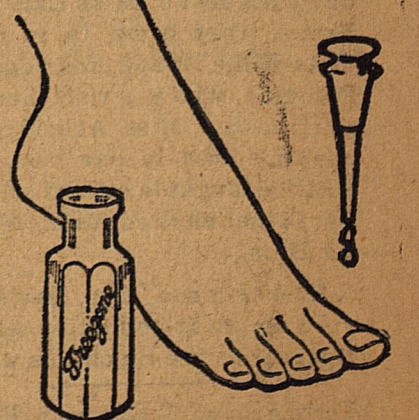
