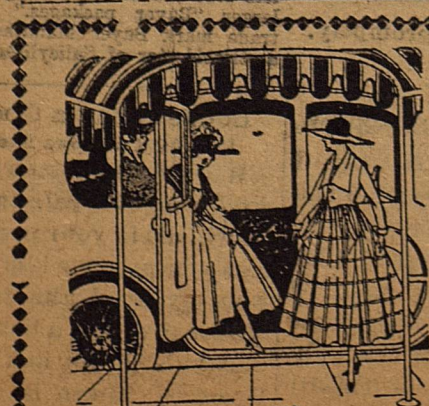

**ELDORADO SCHOOL SECURES FIVE ADDITIONAL UNITS.**

The following letter is explanatory of the five additional units secured by the Eldorado High School, under the supervision of Supt. M. L. Harst, Eldorado, Texas.

This is to give you a notice that the five additional units of affiliation, in English, three units, general science, one unit, and physics one unit. The following comments were made:

English, "Good work. Standards still too low because the high school pupils are poorly trained in lower grades."

I wish to compliment you and your faculty upon the general excellence of the work, which was approved, and sincerely hope that this success will be an inspiration to still further efforts next year.

The five units mentioned in the letter are the only credits applied for this year. At the close of the session in 1919 eight units of affiliation were granted the school. The five secured this year gives the school thirteen units of affiliation, sufficient to admit our graduates to any college or university in Texas. All the subjects taught in the high school are now affiliated except Latin, which will not be taught in the school in the future. Our Latin had not been brought up to standard requirements, and it was not submitted for affiliation. Spanish will be substituted for Latin in the future.

The colleges of the State require 15 units for unconditional admission, but students are admitted with 13 credits and allowed two years to make up the two additional units. Graduates of the Eldorado school may remove this condition at once by passing an examination in the first two years of Latin.

**W. O. ALEXANDER ENTHRASED OVER OIL PROSPECT NEAR HIS RANCH.**

W. O. Alexander, banker and ranchman of this city, is enthused over the oil prospect on the Henderson ranch in Crockett County, Texas, about five miles from the Alexander ranch which is west of Eldorado, 22 miles from Schleicher county. The drilling has reached a depth of 3,500 feet which was the original depth contracted to, but the oil prospects were so encouraging that the well will be drilled deeper. Oil was found at 3,400 feet which is almost identical with that found at Ranger, and is of very fine quality.

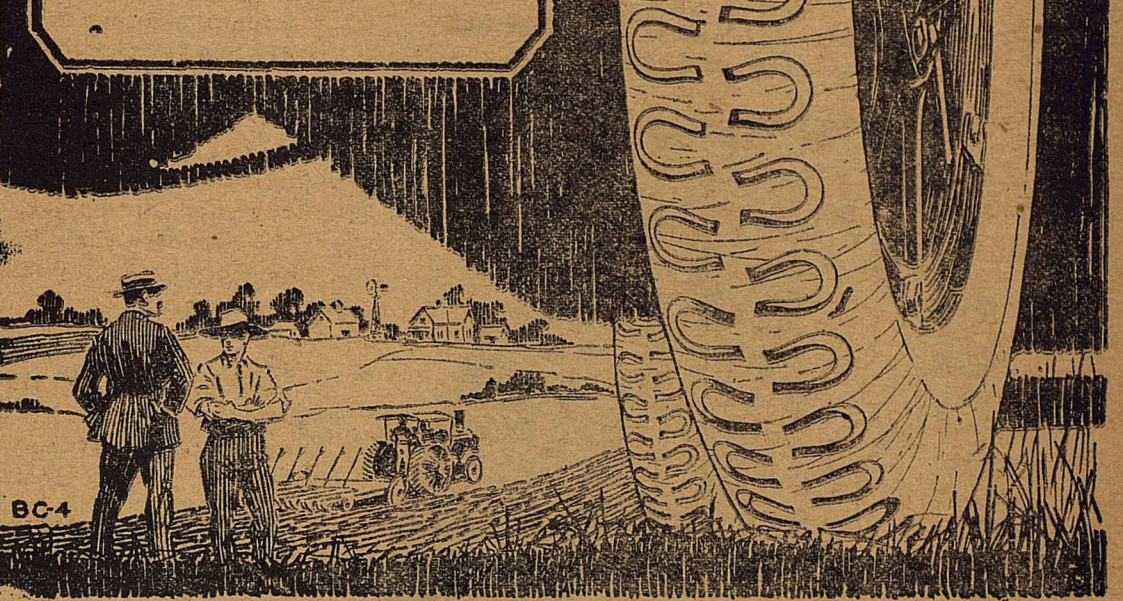

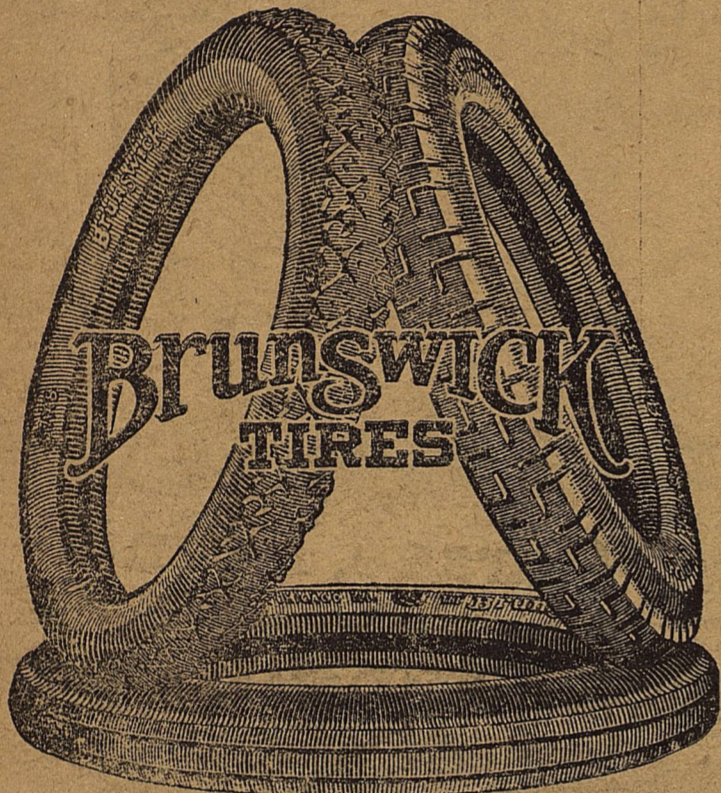

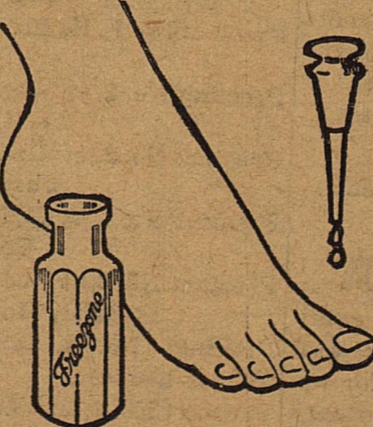
