



RELATING TO THE MANNER OF COMPENSATION OF PUBLIC OFFICIALS.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 7.

A joint resolution of the Legislature of the State of Texas, pro posing an amendment to he constitution of the State by adding to Article 16 thereof a new Section, to be known as Section-60; providing for the compensation of public officials

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

Section 1. That there is hereby added to Article XVI of the Constitution of the State of Texas, a new section to be known as Section 60 of Article XVI of the Constitution of the State of Texas, which shall read as follows:

Section 60. Compensation of Public Officials: All State, district, county and precinct officers within this State shall receive as compensation for their services a salary the amount of which. the terms and methods of payment and the fund out of which such payments shall be made, shall be ascertained, declared and fixed by the Legislature from time to time; provided that the Legislature may make such exceptions as it may deem advisable.

This section shall supersede all other provisions of this constitution fixing and declaring the compensation of officers by salary, fees or otherwise and all provisions for salaries or other compensation for public officials, executive, legislative or judicial.

Sec. 2. The Governor of the State is hereby directed to cause to be issued his necessary proclamation for an electicit to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 1920, at which election this amendmen shall be submitted to the qualified electors of this State for adoption or rejection and shall make the publication required by the constitution and laws of the State.

Said election shall be held under and in accordance with the General Election Laws of the State, and the ballots for said election shall have printed or written thereon in plain letters, the following words:

'Official Ballot'' "For the amendment to Article XV1 of the Constitution of the State of Texas, adding thereto Section 60, providing for compensation of public officials." "Against the amendment to Article XV1 of the Constitution of the State of Texas, adding thereto Section 60, providing for compensation of public officials.

Those voters who favor such amendment shall erase by marking a line through the words "Against the amendment to Article XVI of the Constitution of the Stade of Fexas, providing compensation for public officials." Those who oppose such amendment shall erase by marking a line through them, the words "For the amendment to Article XVI of the Constitution of the State of Texas, providing compensation for public officials." And the pesult of the election shall be published and declared according to the majority of the votes cast in such election.

Sec 3. The sum of Five Thousand Dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the treasury not otherwies appropriated to the purpose of paying the necessary expense of the proclamation and publication of this amendment and the election to be held hereunder. 



election to be held throughout **RELATING TO TAXATION BY** SCHOOL DISTRICTS SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

No. 17. Proposing an amendment to Sec. tion 3 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Texas by exempting indepen dent and common school dis tricts from the limitation of a total tax of one dollar on the one hundred dollars valuation for any one year, and making an appropriation therefor. Be it resolved by the Legislature

ot the State of Texas: Section 1. That Section 3 of Article VII of the Constitution be so amended as hereafter to read as follows: (Creating a new Section 3.) Section 3. One-fourth of the

revenue derived from the State occupation taxes and a poll tax of one (\$1.00) dollar on every inhabitant of this state, between the ages of twenty-one and six ty years, shall be set apart annually for the benefit of the public free schools; and in ad. dition thereto, there shall be levied and collected an annual ad valorem state tax of such amount not to exceed thirtyfive cents on the one hundred (\$100.00) dollars valuation, as with the available school fund arising from all other sources. will be sfficient to maintain and support the public schools of this State for a period of not less than six months in each year, and it shall be the duty of the State Borad of Education to set aside a suufficent amount out of the said tax to provide free text books for the use of child ren attending the public free schools of this State; provided, however, that should the limit of taxation herein named be insufncient the deficit may be met by appropriation from the general funds of the state and the legis lature may also provide for the formation of school districts by general or special law without 3 0 0 0 the local notice required in other 3 eases of special legislation; ard 3 ll such school districts, wheth er created by general or spec al 3


