



FEDERAL RESERVE BANK SAYS 753,960 BOUGHT FOURTH LIBERTY BONDS

Dallas, Texas .- When the Fourth Liberty Loan Drive was on in the Eleventh Federal Reserve District, 753,960 persons bought bonds, according to Dinsmore W. Hume, Sav. amount, value, of 31/2 % bonds then bought was \$145,988,525. Interest on these bonds is due semi-annually, the next payment coming October 15. 1920. At that time the interest to be paid will be \$3,102,231.15. A like sum will be payable on March 15, 1921. Regret has been expressed in banking circles that many bond owners have never presented their interest coupons for payment, as is contemplated by the government.

OTTO H. KAHN SAYS **GROWN-UPS SHOULD BUY SAVINGS STAMPS**




