DECIDES BOUNDARY SUIT.

Judge C. E. Dubois returned an instructed verdict on all phases involved in the boundary suit brought by A. G. Murphy vs. Miss Lillie Benson, which has been pending in district court all this week, with the exception of the improvements on the land, which was awarded to Murphy by the decision of the jury.

The case was originally filed in Schleicher county but was transferred here by agreement. It was a complicated boundary suit involving extensive ranch property in Schleicher county. Thomas & McCarty of San Angelo and M. E. Sedberry of Eldorado represented Murphy while Blanks, Collins & Jackson represented Miss Benson.

The suit was the outgrowth of another boundary suit tried here about a year ago in which Miss Benson was the plaintiff, and which involved some of the same lands involved in this suit.—San Angelo Standard.

Our friend R. F. Halbert, over at San Angelo, writes us to know if we were in favor of petitioning the Legislature to extend time for paying taxes?

The Success is inclined to believe that the idea is not a feasible one, as the most people would take advantage of the extension, in case the penalty was removed, whether they needed to or not, every school in the country would be effected, no money would be available to keep the teachers paid, as many schools are already short on funds and wholly dependent on a local tax. Again, we are prone to believe that the people as a whole are not eager to ask for credit, they think more about borrowing or extending an old loan than they do about trying to reduce the present indebtedness, the older we get the more we believe in "paying as you go," however, we do not feel able to discuss this proposition in opposition to a banker, as we might want to borrow enough money to pay our taxes.

Christmas Trees by Million

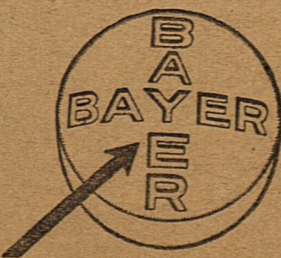
