WAR FINANCE CORPORATION READY TO AID STOCKMEN.

A letter from Senator Hudspeth that appeared in the press last week, states that the War Finance Corporation with headquarters at Fort Worth is ready to aid banks and loan Companies, upon its endorsement, a loan for the full value of the live stock, wool, and mohair, for a period of one year with privilege of renewal for three years, can be secured.

The stockmen and farmers wanting a loan of this kind must make application through the local bank.

LAW IS QUOTED IN KLAN OPINION.

The Attorney General issues ruling in answer to Governor's request.

"All efforts of persons under any name they may have assumed to better the moral conditions of the country through the medium of threats fear, intimidation and personal violence is violate of the spirit and letter of the Constitution and laws of Texas and each and every act done and performed by them carrying out or futhering any illegal purpose or which has for it object the doing of any act forbidden by law would involve the guilt of all participants having knowledge of a general purpose to do illegal acts or actual knowledge of the doing of an illegal act.

"If any order, organization or body or individuals agree and confederate among themselves to do any act which would be in violation of the laws of the country and every act of every individual comprising the conspiracy would be illegal. This applies to the masked parades where such parade is a part of and in furtherance of a purpose to do some act which would be in violation of the law."

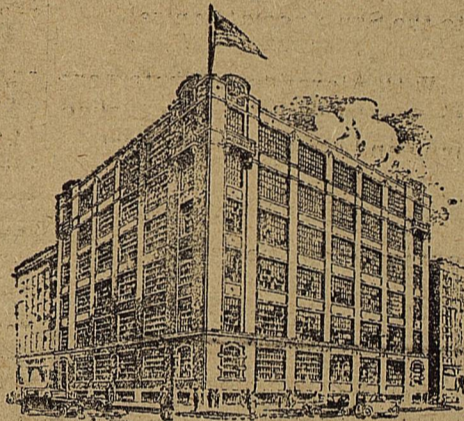



MEXICO NOW SETTLED ATTRACTS THOUSANDS

BUSINESS GROWING RAPIDLY
AND PEOPLE CROWDING INTO
ALL SECTIONS

DEPARTMENTS OFFERING AID

Bureau of Industry, Commerce and Labor Urges Interested Parties to Write.

Assured that revolutionary conditions in Mexico have been adjusted and that the country is entering upon an era of prosperity and rehabilitation business in the Southern Republic has been showing an enormous increase and all trains running to principal points in Mexico have been crowded for months.

Credit ratings have been adjusted and freight congestion has been so enormous that in past months as many as two thousand cars of freight have been waiting at the border for movement. Enormous lines of credit have been extended to the Government and rolling stock, engines, etc., purchased in large numbers for the railroads.

Foreigners Acquire Land

Notwithstanding the persistently circulated statements that the laws of Mexico forbid any foreigner to acquire title to lands without first becoming a Mexican citizen, some 2,023 citizens of other countries as a matter of fact bought lands in various portions of the Republic in the year 1920.

The only requirement as a condition precedent to the acquisition of lands in Mexico by foreigners, is that they shall first sign a pledge to abide by the laws of Mexico, and in all matters pertaining to the lands in question shall be considered as on the same basis as Mexican citizens. This is the tacit requirement of all foreigners acquiring real property in the United States, the only difference being that in this country a foreigner naturally abides by the laws, and no written pledge is exacted while in Mexico many foreigners, presuming upon its position in the family of nations, have the presumption to demand extra consideration and extra privileges as against the native of the country. Hence the necessity for the law in question.

Mexico Not Distant

Many persons when they think of Mexico, believe it to be an untold distance away. To Mexico means the same distance to many as Europe, or Asia or Africa and certainly many feel that South America is closer than Mexico. Yet, compared on the basis of the mileage over the National Lines of Mexico we find that Mexico is not remote or in any sense inconvenient of access. The least rail distance between New York and Portland, Ore., is 380 miles greater than the least rail distance between New York and

Mexico City. Between New York and Los Angeles, 326 miles greater than between New York and Mexico City. Between Chicago and Portland 163 miles greater than between Chicago and Mexico City. Between St. Louis and Portland, Ore., 435 miles greater than between St. Louis and Mexico City. Between St. Louis and Los Angeles, 213 miles greater than between St. Louis and Mexico City. Between San Antonio and Los Angeles, 479 miles greater than between San Antonio and Mexico City.

The demand for offices and buildings for stores and shops is becoming so great in Mexico City that rents are going up in the business district and there are few vacant stores or offices on any of the principal streets.

A decree recently issued provides that all doctors and dentists entering Mexico must pass an examination, but those who have been practicing for three years in the country may continue by registering their diplomas, if they are from foreign institutions of high standing.

Railroads in Good Condition

Mr. Manuel M. Vauclair, President of the Baldwin Locomotive Works, in commenting on conditions in Mexico said:

"The railroads of Mexico are in good condition physically, the road bed is in good shape. The roads are short of equipment, cars and engines have been shot to pieces. Mexico is full of business and the people are travelling. Good order prevails in Mexico City and in the country outside so far as I could see. You can't do things in Mexico City that you could do here, if you did they would put you in jail quicker than a wink. The shops seem to be busy and financial conditions are sound."

The Mexican parcels post business with the United States, as well as the money order business, is increasing very fast. It is a very good indication of the growth of commerce between the two countries. The United States Postoffice Department has just notified the Mexican Postoffice Department that \$100,000 has been placed at the disposition of the Mexican Department, which is due to the Mexican service in the balancing of accounts. This is parcels post business. The United States Postoffice Department, also owes the Mexican Department money on money order business which they intend to remit.

During the last three months the number of postal packages from the United States received in Mexican postoffices were more than 95,000 packages, which is ten times the number received during an average period of three months during the year 1912.
