## ANNOUNCES FOR GOVERNOR.

R. Y. Bowby, prominent merchant and business man of Kent Texas formally announced his candidacy for the office of Governor of the State of Texas at the next election in opposition to the present incumbent, Gov. Pat M. Neff.

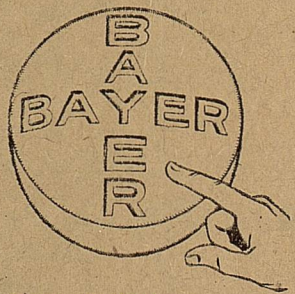
Simultaneously with this announcement, Mr. Bowby issued a statement of the platform upon which he will make his race for office. The platform, among other things, includes a West Texas A. & M.; another college of Industrial Arts to be located in Southwest Texas, a State University which will be the "greatest in America." A complete change for the State Prison System involving the abandonment of the prison and the setting up of factories in which the prisoners may work equal suffrage, a mothers home for aged and dependent women, regulation by the State of motion picture shows and regulation of the purchase of real estate.

Mr. Bowby in his platform also promises that he will, if elected, make a woman his Secretary of State, and that he will give preference in all appointive positions to veterans of the war, such veterans to be recommended to him by the various American Legion posts of the State.

I am in favor of and will recommend to the Legislature a law regulating the purchase of real estate of every kind, both in town and in country, wherein the purchaser of a home makes a cash payment at the time of purchase and gives a note or notes for the balance of the purchase price to be paid in the future, that in the event the purchaser of property can not meet the payment when due and is willing to pay the taxes, insurance and interest up to date and continues to do so from year to year for ten years, then if full settlement is not made, the holder of notes can proceed to foreclose and collect the debt. But in case the holder of notes sees fit not to carry or extend the notes ten years and forces a settlement, he shall pay back to the purchaser the cash payment made at time of purchase less all interest to date.
