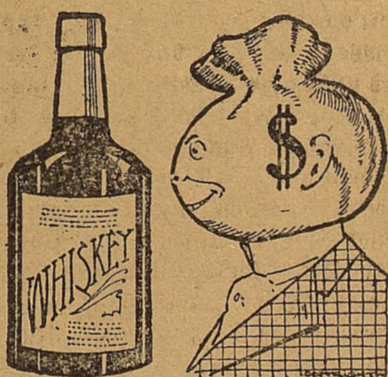
Carl Speers returned Tuesday night from a two weeks visit to home folks near Bremond, his brother Henry Clay accompanied him back and will spend some time here.
