This increased demand for peothat in these prosperous timps many of the best men and wemon have been attracted to other lides of en leayor by the greater fimanclal returns offered by other calquite teaching. All things considered, the teacher is the poores
paid man in the country.
The public will never receiv

the best class of profession serthe best class of profession serof men of the first rank to mold the character and fix the ideals of
the children and the soung men and wemon of this State, aud will make it poesible for a qualified man to devote his life to this great work without sacrificing th by men of like talent and success in other lines of useful employed, Another cause for the increas ing demand for better prepared teachers is the general awazening of edueational sentiment all over
the cuuntry. Inteligent people everywhere will not be willing for their chlldren to we in daily cou lact wilh inferior men and women os sonn as luey give the matter any attention.
Yourg people who read this arficle should rememt.er that thero in desirable localities for teachers who measure theit accomplishments by the grade of cerlificate held. Backward and backwonds communities talk about wanting trachers bolding second grade
certificates, rather than third
grade eerifientes, and they talk first grade certifleate, and sometimes they hold in a kind of rom temppt teachers holding a lower grade certificate; but desirable acter and scholarsthip-those
a cters whose attainments are indicated trouble that arise. Much trouble arises between trustees and teachers, due to a lack of understanding of the conract Let it be understood at the beginning of each year that truslees and teachers should have conract in writing. In the com frnished is the State should 611 ed and signed by all parties to the coutract There should be no eibal understandinge, but what ver is a part of the contract should be written and attached to he regular forms. In independhe districts the written records of he board and the written acceptid contain all the points of agree unbrace. The trustees are not the "boss is" of the teachers, like the own rs of a store or other busines loges, but they are parties to cortract. They can not dismisa bacher unless the teacher prove be iacompetent or violates hi ontract. When boards dismisa eachers thes should remember hat their actions are subjects to those in authrity abov hem, and that the questions of eal contractual rights and school aws will be applied to their ac The contract should be regaried as a compact of honor. The trustees should not undertake to violate it without much provocaale it for Either party mavordado cause d, honorably, from a eontract but nether party shou d abandon ther; and asking to be releasea should not become a habit with Tru Trustees frequently mike un the corps of teacbers.
