It bringes people to Austin in droves. And many speak up - very bluntly. <br> This year's lawmakers, particularly in the House, seem to be falling into an early pattern of much work, little play. In part, the shortage of sociability is attributed to the hivided the House er's race. It divided the house into two camps, whose members, for the most part, stayed aloof from each other during early weeks. <br> A second sobering factor is attributed to the new lobby control law.
