is to be applied must be designated. If the brand is to be applied to more than one location on the animal, it must be so recorded and each additional location for the brand on the animal shall constitute a separate recording of that brand.

The County Clerk of each county shall have this act published in some newspaper of general circulation in the county for a period of 30 days. The act shall be published on the effective date, August 30, 1971, and thereafter for 30 days.

It is the obligation of the County Clerk to assure that no more than one brand of a kind be recorded on the same location on the animal in each county. Therefore, no two people in a county may record the same brand in the same location.

The law applies to all counties in the state of Texas and shall take precedence over any special statutes heretofore applying to individual counties pertaining to recording and re-recording of brands.

Against Hagerman --

Texico Drops Opener

The Texico High School Wolverines dropped their season opener to Hagerman, N.M., last Friday night. The final score was 28-0 in favor of Hagerman.

Part of this was due to the loss of senior quarterback Terry Yell. Yell will out for the season with a broken arm suffered in a recent scrimmage against Clovis B team.

Sophomore Randy Harrison filled in for Yell and did an outstanding job considering he was nervous and inexperienced, according to Jim Wynne, head football coach.

On defense, the Wolverines were practically helpless against Hagerman's fine passing game which counted for three of their four touchdowns.

The first series of downs, the Wolverines tested Hagerman's defensive line and failed to go anywhere. The remainder of the quarter followed suit with neither team posing a scoring threat. The first quarter ended with no score from either side.

In the second quarter, the Wolverines just couldn't seem to put their defense together. Hagerman took advantage of the situation and struck twice on touchdown pass plays and ran the point after touchdown across both times also. This left the score at 16-0 at half-time.

The first play of the second half, Hagerman scored on a running play, but failed to get the PAT leaving the score at 22-0.

The ball then switched hands several times on fumbles. Hagerman came up with the ball on Texico's 16 and again scored on a pass play, the final score of the game, which put Hagerman in front, 28-0.

The brunt of Texico's ground game was carried by seniors, Albert Steward and Ricky Ketcherside. Steward had almost 100 yards to his credit while Ketcherside carried the ball for a total of 56 yards, said coach Wynne.

Harrison, playing his first quarterback role, picked up 46 yards on the ground. His passing game was lacking, though, in that very few passes for short yardage were completed.

The Texico Wolverines now stand at 0-1 for the season. Hagerman is not in the Wolverine's district so the game does not count as a district loss. Texico's next game is this Friday night against Whiteface, Tex.

Coach Jim Wynne credited his team's loss to Hagerman last Friday night to an inexperienced secondary and too many mistakes.

Wynne said only two fumbles out of 10 were recovered by the Wolverines. One bright spot of the game was the rushing yardage totaling approximately 100 yards which was gained by Albert Steward, fullback.

The coach praised the Hagerman quarterback, saying he was
