## SCHOOL TEACHERS

We've probably all had some teachers we liked especially well when we were in school, and I want to mention a few of mine. I don't know if any of them are still alive, but would like to pay my respects to them anyway.

Mrs. Ida Farmer: I know I've mentioned her in the past, but she was our first and second grade teacher. She had her hands full with the bunch of us.

Miss Celeste Wiley: She was the subject of one previous story, and one of the nicest teachers ever. She didn't even send me to the principle's office after finding the sack of chewing tobacco in my desk.

Mr. Logan: He was a tall, blond-headed man, and most of the girls thought he looked like a movie star. He was a good history teacher who expected you to do your work on time. When Bobby Howe and I didn't do our homework one time, he made us copy the whole "United States Constitution" (word for word) including the "Preamble." It took me about twenty five or thirty pages of notebook paper.

Mr. O.K. Henson, Jr.: A very good math teacher, even-tempered and really nice. He was the best "whistler" I've ever heard in my life! One morning at a school assembly in the gym, he did the whole program for us. He whistled for about half an hour, doing one song after the other. These weren't just little short tunes, they were long, complicated songs. We

were all amazed.

Miss Jeanne King: Never married, taught school in Oklahoma fifty years, retired, then came to Wheeler and started over again. English and literature were her subjects, and she really enjoyed her job. She taught two years, then died the summer between our Junior and Senior year. She'll always be remembered for her enthusiasm and dedication.

Mr. B. K. Barham: A finer man never walked the halls of Wheeler High. He was our high school principal and math teacher. I knew he was a lover of history, and it wasn't very hard to get him sidetracked from math to history; just mention someone like "Genghis Khan," or "Alexander the Great." Although he was a very honest and fair man, he was a strict disciplinarian. Like he said, "If you do what you're supposed to do, when you're supposed to do, like you're supposed to, life here will go really well." Sad to say, Jimmy Hill and I seemed to have let that piece of advice slip our minds, because we got into trouble anyway. Naturally, that required a trip to Mr. Barham's office. Being the honest man he was, he just straight-out told us; "I won't try to tell you guys that this is going to hurt me, more than you, because it won't." He sure was right about that!

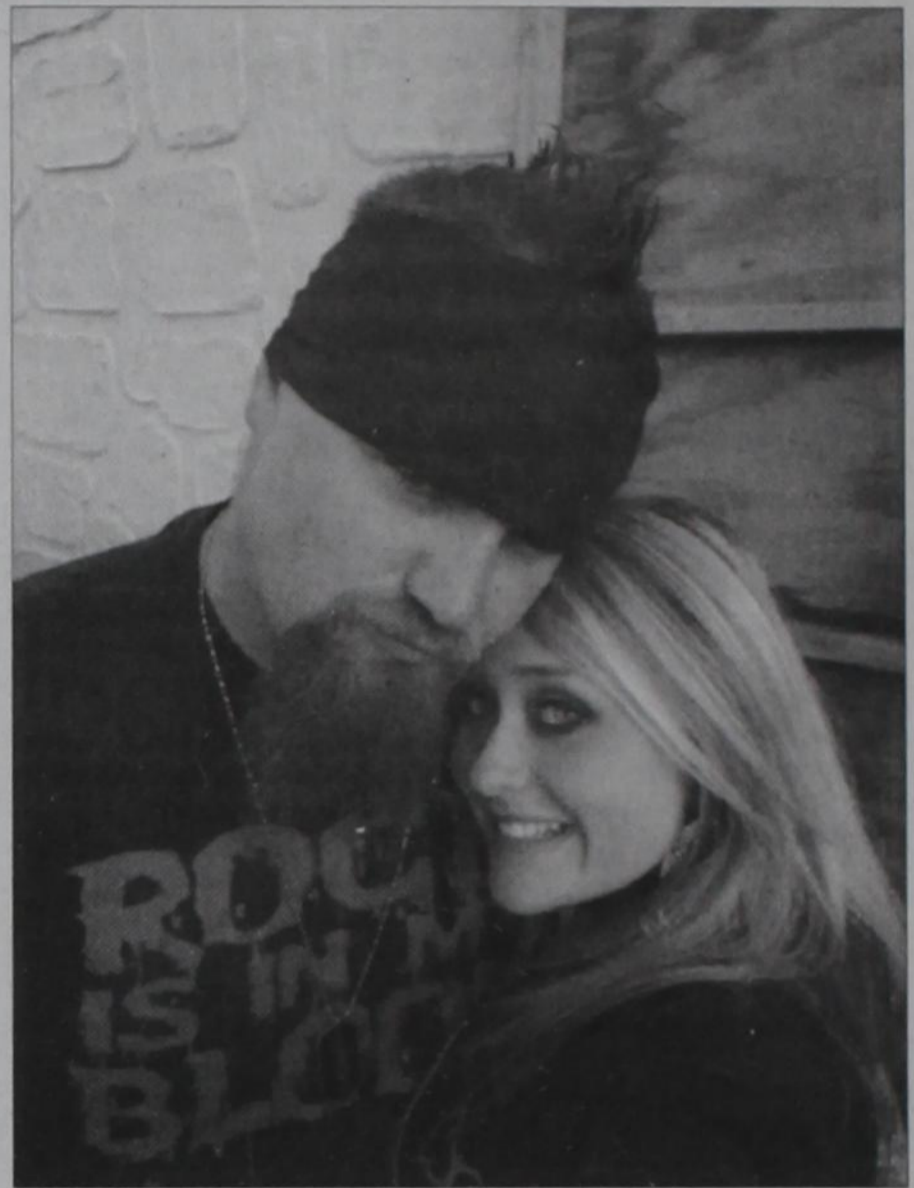

Don Carpenter and his Sand Storms, a West Texas dance band, performed at the American Legion Building on Poppy Day, May 27, 1961 in Wheeler.

The Ex-Student/Teacher's reunion in 1961 was scheduled for August 15.

"Terry McCasland never was good enough to get into a rodeo, so he now has a Souvenir Wagon, following them around."

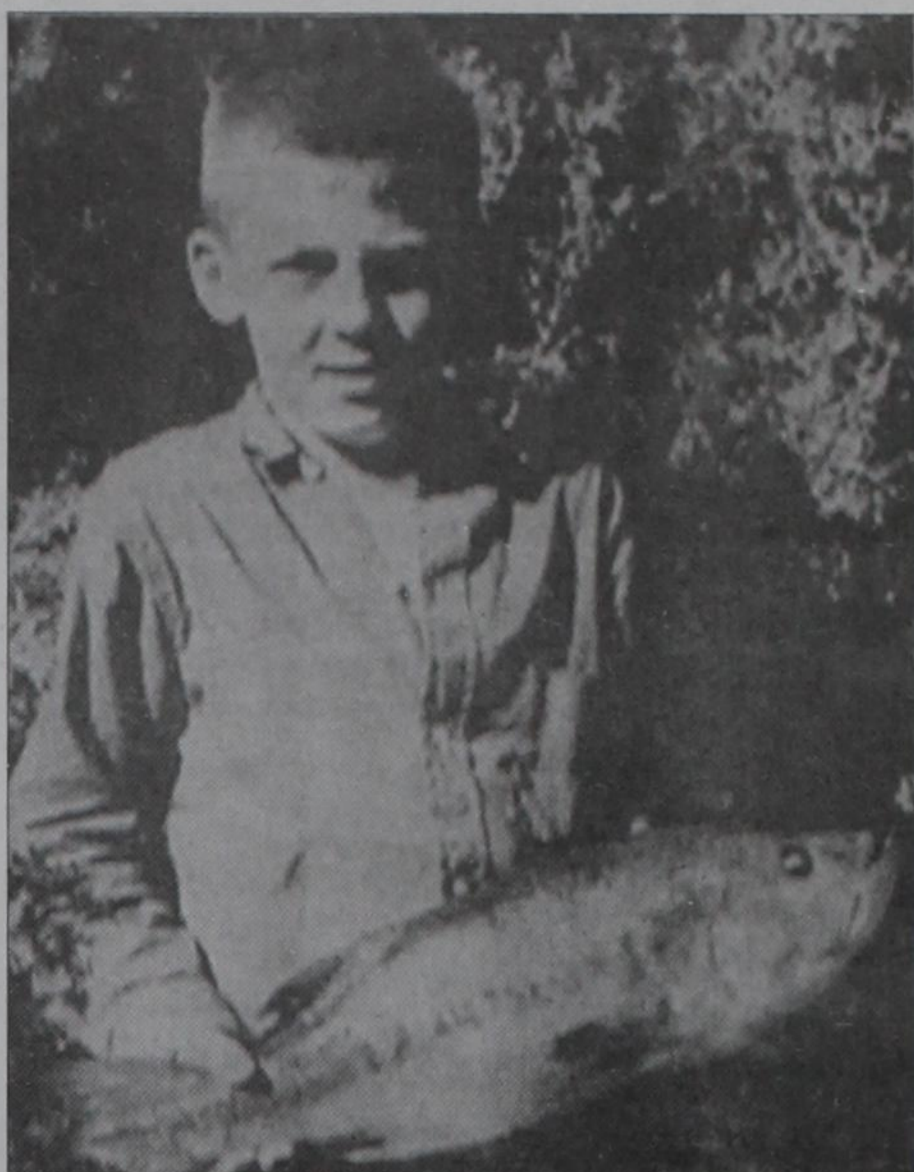
"Larry Garrison will follow in his father's footsteps; he will be master mechanic and body man at Garrison's Fender Bender Body Shop."

Wheeler received hail again on Tuesday, May 16, 1961.

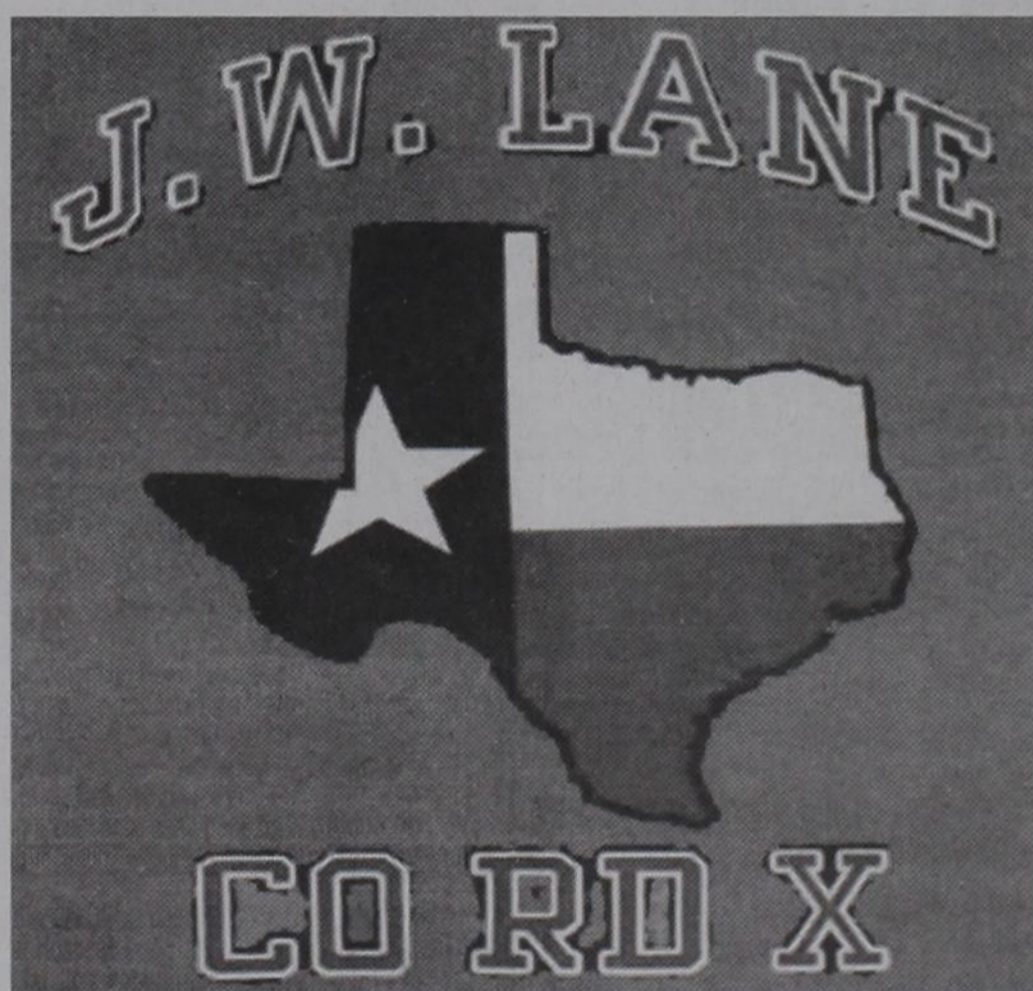
