






Wheeler County Commissioners met Wednesday, August 10, 2011, county may be required to redraw their lines. The commissioners considered

three proposals and chose the one they felt best for their voters. The county's population has

dropped since the 1990 census. The county had a population of 5879 in 1990 and now has 5410. The racial figures showed 90.1% to be Anglo and 9.9% to be minority. The 2010 census showed the county to be 71.11% Anglo and 28.89 minority. The 28.89 was the figure which made it necessary for the county to redesign the precincts.

Also necessary will be the relocation of some voting boxes, according to population and for the convenience of the voters. This will be decided at a later date. Wheeler presently has 10 voting boxes. With the electronic voting, the "ballot" for each voting box cost the county \$1400.

### 2011National Stop Red Week August

Did you know? A new study by the Texas

Transportation Institute at Texas A&M University shows right light cameras at almost 300 intersections statewide were effective in reducing crashes.

Red-light related crashes decreased by 25% at intersections in Texas with red-light safety cameras.

Overall, the state recorded 633 fewer crashes at intersections with red-light safety cameras, an 11% decrease.

Crashes dropped 23% from one year before to one year after cameras were installed, and fell 27% and 21% respectively for the two and three year comparisons.

Fewer collisions were noted at all types of roadways throughout the state.

Traffic crashes are the single most significant cause of preventable death and injury in North America. In 2007 in the U.S., almost 900 people were killed and an estimated 153,000 were injured in crashes that involved red light running.

The busiest intersection is Coulter and Elmhurst. In June 2011, there were 275 violations at Total violations in Amarillo for June were 1.060.

In 2010, there were 19,167 captured events by red light cameras, resulting in 12,705 violations in Amarillo.
