The City of Wheeler is planning to dig five test holes west and south of Wheeler in an effort to find additional water for the city's water supply. Wheeler's nitrate levels have been too high for quite

According to surveys, the water in the area of the test wells should have fewer nitrates. The test wells will determine the nitrates, saturation and water available. The city met with the property owners last Tuesday and has their approval for the drilling. The locations are southwest of the city's present wells.



**Dennis Holt Porter In Memory Of Dennis Holt Porter** 


