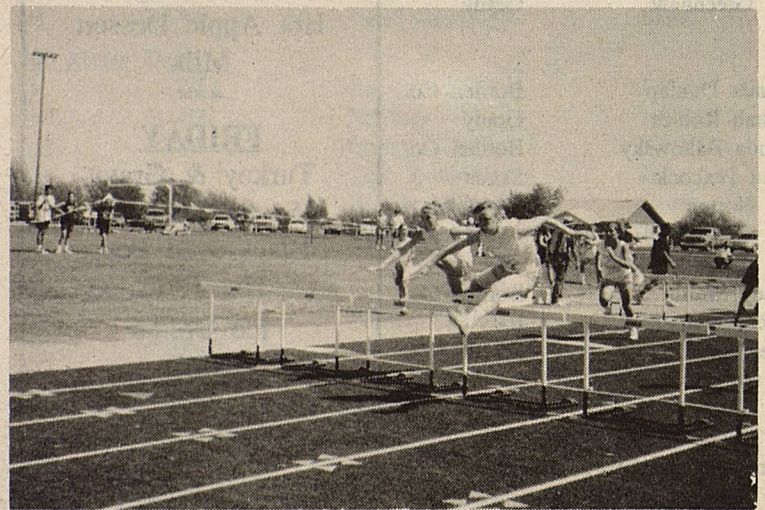

On Your Mark! Get Set! GO! The 400m. Relay gets started with Donnie Moore as the first leg on the team.

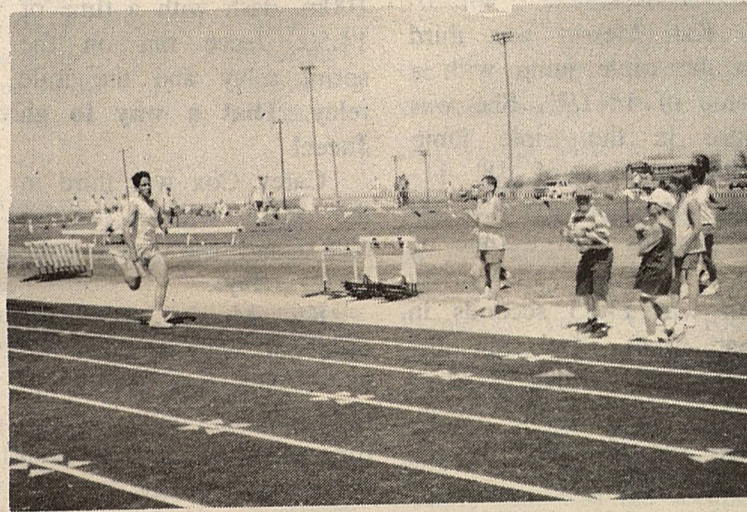


Up and Over! Kati Merritt, Julie Mayes and Adrianna Baeza take home the 1st, 3rd and 4th places during the 100m Hurdles.

consisted of Shaina Isaacs, Staci O'Brien, Amanda Barkowsky, and Renee' Sheen.

Lindsey Smith ran all alone again out in front of the rest in the 2400m. run and the 1600 m. run. Lindsey won both races with a 10:05.78 in the 2400 and a 6:22.09 in the 1600 meters.

Kati Merritt was third in the triple jump with a jump of 14'-1/4". She was third in the triple jump with a jump of 18' 11-1/2", and she won the 100 m. hurdles with a time of 17.60. Katie's preliminary run was 17.55 seconds in that event. Kati ran the 200 meter hurdles in 32.79 for a first place finish. And she also ran on the mile relay.

Julie Mayes did not have such a good day at the track. Some days you just seem to run out of luck. Julie scratched on two attempts in the long jump, and the only mark she received was 12'-1/2", which was not enough to make the finals. Julie did triple jump 28' 10-1/4", to win fourth place. This was a personal best for Julie in the triple. Julie's luck did not continue to improve, she fell and injured her wrist in the finals of the 100m. hurdles. Julie did not hesitate to get up to finish fourth with a time of 20.78. She had to jump the gun in the 200m. hurdles in order to keep from running that event. She then finished the night running a great leg on the mile relay.

Katie Kemp was fifth

place in the triple jump with a 27'-3/4" leap. She was second in the 100m. dash with a time of 14.18. Katie ran a leg on the 400 m. relay, and the mile relay.

Jacee Condit won first place in the long jump with a jump of 14'10-1/4". Jacee was fourth in the 100m. dash with a time of 14.50. Jacee ran on the sprint relay and the mile relay. **That a way to go Jacee!**

Carey Cox was third in the discus with a toss of 62'8", and she ran on the sprint relay.

Ky Merritt won the shot put with a throw of 27'5". She was second in the 200 m. dash with a time of 31.92, and she ran on the sprint relay.

Wendy McNeely won 5th in the 200m. dash with a time of 33.37.

Rebecca Copeland won second in the shot and fourth in the discus. She threw the shot 27'1", and she threw the discus 58'11".

Brandee Wells threw the discus 54 feet for fifth place.

Renee' Sheen threw the shot put 26 feet for fourth place.

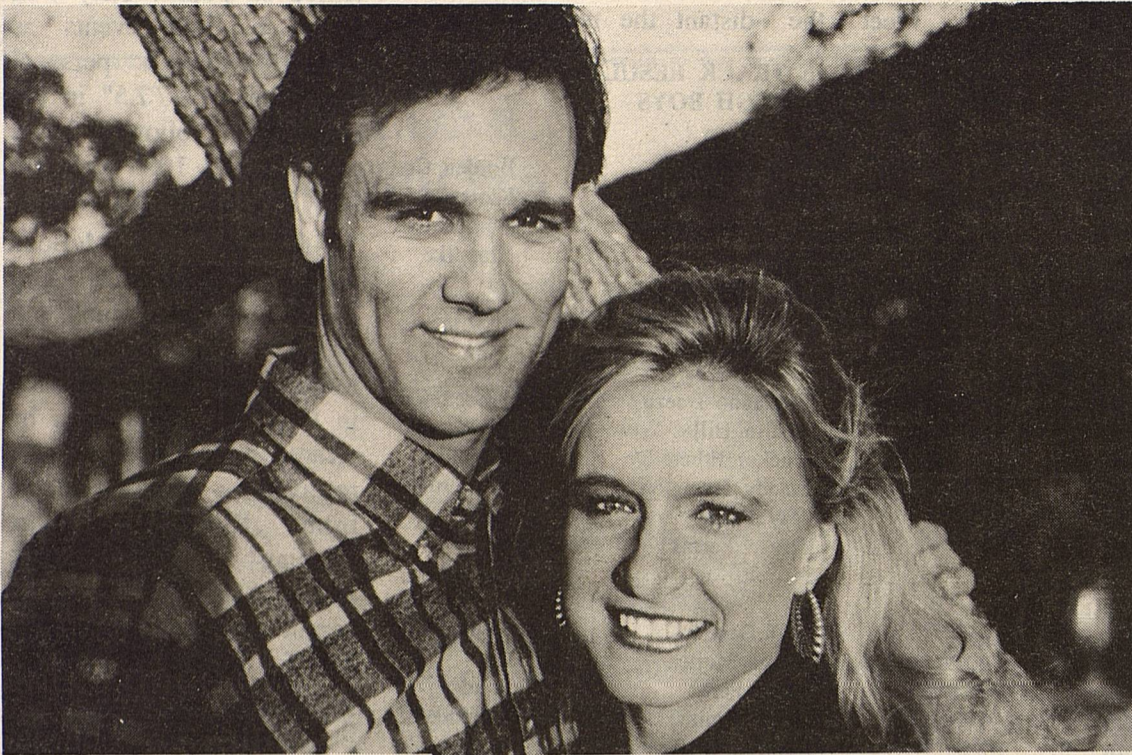

The Pups got things rolling in the field events as they tallied 63 points. They won 4 of 6 field events as starting with a personal best jump of 17'7.5" in the long jump, followed by a personal best 105' throw by Jeff Dennis in the discus. At this time Colt McCook turned in a personal best in the triple jump at 34'6.25". The fourth Gold Medal came from Fernando in the Pole Vault when he cleared 8'6". The Pups also received a Bronze Medal from Kevin Pinkerton, jumping a personal best 32'6". Also, Jeff came in second in the high jump at 5'0" for a Silver Medal.

In the running finals the Pups kept their momentum going with a very convincing victory in the 400 relay. This began a string of six Gold Medals as Jeff won the 800 in a personal best 2:26, Fernando won the 100, Kevin won the 110HH and the 300 low hurdles. In between those two Golds was Colt McCook's 400 victory that was the second race that the Pups took all of the medals as Jeff was second and Colt Miller was in a personal best 65.41. Also Ramon Griffin and Robert Stamper followed Kevin Pinkerton in the 100 HH. Ryan Grant ended the consecutive Golds for the Pups as he completed a rare feat by winning the 200 just after getting the silver in the 300 hurdles. With the illness of the Pup 1600 man Nick Flanigan, the Pups saw their string of 6 Gold Medals end, but in the 1600 relay the Pups got back on track. This closed out a very successful track season as the Pups won every meet that kept point totals. Congratulations!!! I also would like to congratulate the girls on winning their division also. And lastly I would like to thank everyone for the help in putting on a very first class district meet.
