Cows sold strong at 10 cents higher, and brought up to 8325 ; a large string of cannes sold at $\$ 230$ early in the week; not many bulls arrived but sales ranged from 8.85 th 83.25. Receipts the first two days this week are light; yesterdays supply was mostly short which sola steady to 10 cents lower than last Friday.
