tears, accompanied Begin's body to the cemetery in Arab east Jerusalem where he was laid to rest next to his
wife, Aliza. Begin, who died Monday at age 78 , was a giant of the Jewish state,
but he wanted - and got - a poople s funeral. There was no or stretcher, wrapped in a prayer shawl. With Begin's death, his friends finally began to explain the riddle of his 1983 resignation. They con-
firmed what most Israelis long suspected - he stepped down because he was depressed over his wife's death a year earlier and because of
the rising Israeli death toll in the the rising Isra

games, to turn around and tax the private funds sand used to stageit would be a blow the American public would not tolerate," Payne said.
Hybl pointed out that the USOC pays taxes on some of its income, such
as clothing and souvenir sales.
