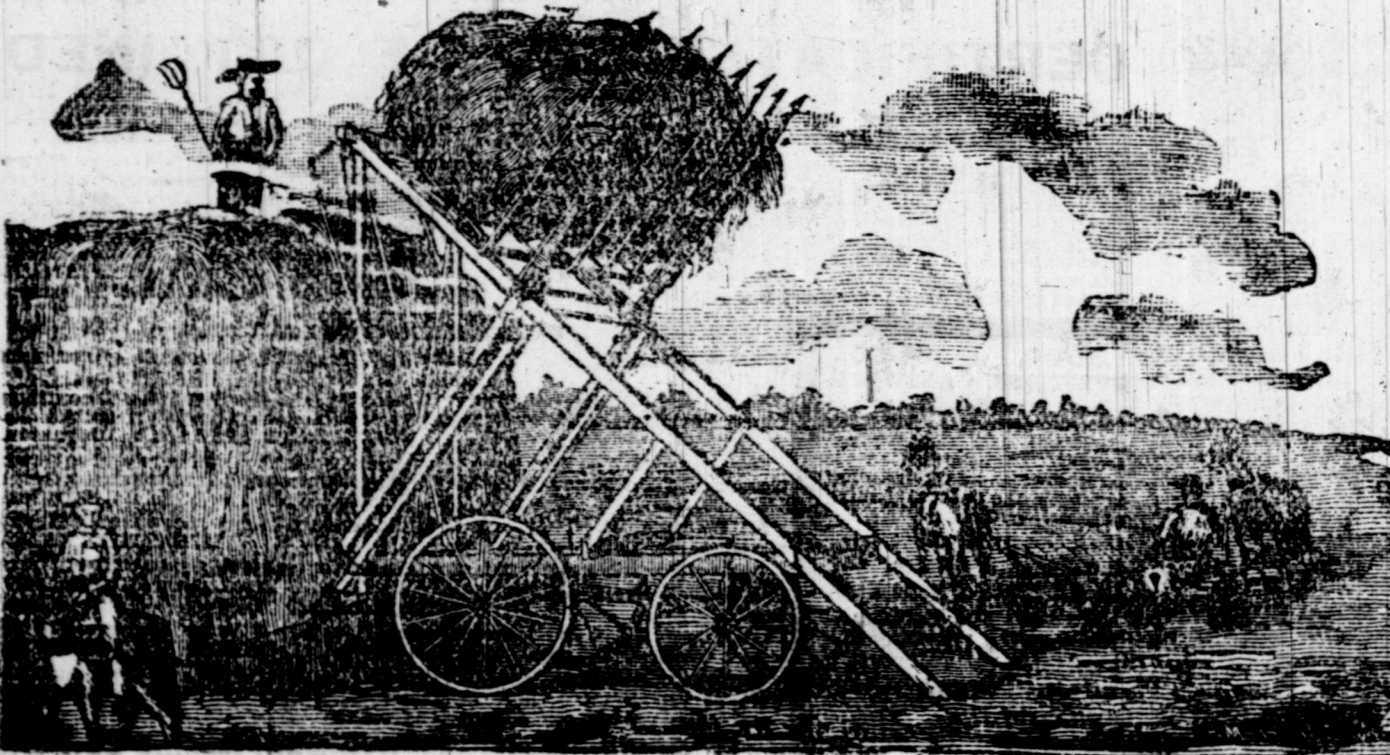

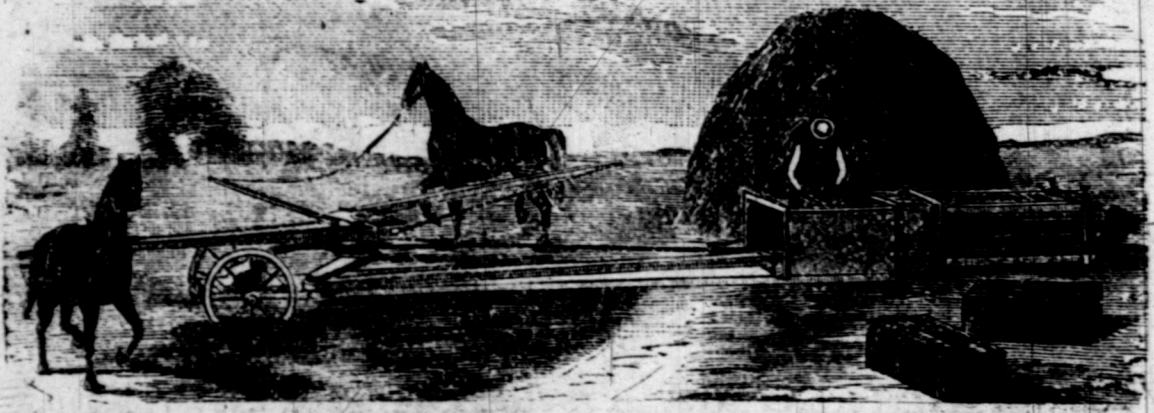

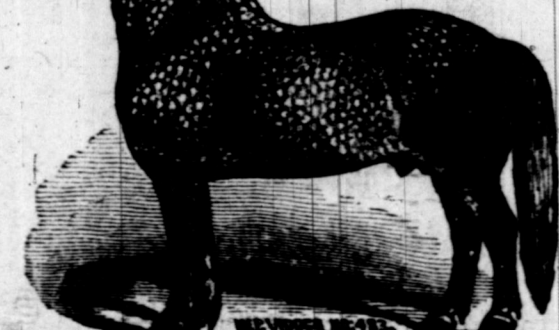

## LIVE STOCK MARKETS.

Latest From Principals.

### CHICAGO MARKET.

UNION STOCK YARDS, CHICAGO, Ill., May 20, 1886.

Special to Texas Live Stock Journal: Receipts of cattle to-day 9,000. The general market active at 10c decline, but offerings of Texans moderate and values steady. Hunter, Evans & Co. sold for M. H. Beauchamp of Fort Worth, 126 Texas steers averaging 1,001 pounds at \$5. Some common 910 pound Texas sold at \$4.25. Corn-fed Texas cattle, poor to extra at \$4 to 5.15. Grass Texas quotable at \$3.25 for cows and \$3.50 to 4.25 for steers, something choice would sell at \$4.00 to 4.75. About 3,000 Texas cattle sold here this week. Texas hogs quotable at \$3.50 to 4.15. Texas sheep shorn \$2.25 to 4.25. I am requested to state that Chicago Live Stock exchange laid the foundation for serving double deck cars for sheep before the St. Louis Live Stock exchange came into being. There was an indignation protest here against the outrageous claims made by St. Louis in last week's JOURNAL.

### ST. LOUIS MARKET.

NATIONAL STOCK YARDS, EAST ST. LOUIS, May 20, 1886.

Special to Texas Live Stock Journal.

The market to-day was active and prices firm on good cattle. Texas and Indian steers in fair supply. Choice corn-fed Texas sold from \$5 to 5.50. Steers of 770 to 950 lbs. at \$4.40 to \$4.90. Grass Texas of 800 to 900 lbs. at \$3.50 to 3.75. Cows and mixed \$3 to 3.30. Yesterday B. O. Walcott of Honey Grove, sold 19 fancy Texas of 1,182 lbs. at the highest price of the season, namely \$5.50. This beats Chicago. Sales to-day by J. H. Campbell & Co., Hunter, Evans & Co. and Cassidy Bros. & Co. were at a range of \$4.20 to 5.20. Hogs steady. Texas sheep in demand for good. Saturday the railroad managers and the stock exchanges of Kansas City, Chicago and St. Louis met here to arrange reductions in sheep charges.

### KANSAS CITY MARKET.

KANSAS CITY, Mo., May 20, 1886.

Special to Texas Live Stock Journal.

Cattle receipts for the past two days' large, with prices 5 to 10 cents lower: 65 Colorado half-breeds sold yesterday at \$4.95; 24 Texas cow-feds, weights 890 lbs. \$4.40 and 146 Texas cow-feds sold to-day average weight 1,116 lbs. at \$4.85. White & Holmes sold 16 native shippers average 1,755 lbs. at \$5.50. C. G. Means & Son sold 16 native shippers average weight 1,490 lbs. at \$5.40. These were both good sales for this day. Good mutton in fair demand at \$3.75 to 4.25. Twenty cars of Texas horses were received here since yesterday morning and other shipments on the way.

### CHICAGO MARKET LETTER.

Sales of Texans—Double Decks—Better Feeding—Yearling Beef.

UNION STOCK YARDS, CHICAGO, Ill., May 17, '86.

Regular Correspondence TEXAS LIVE STOCK JOURNAL.

Grass Texans are up this year but they will begin to come now very soon. Several trains are now on the way.

W. E. Stovall, Waco, Texas, was here with 34 head of 1144-lb Texas cattle. They sold at \$5.05.

Kendall & Parks, Ennis, Texas, obtained \$4.50 for 22 head of 903-lb Texas cattle.

I. D. Wood of Victoria, Texas, sold 80 Texan calves averaging 375 lb. at \$2.62. W. L. Stoner obtained the same price for 41 head of 395-lb. calves. Both lots were in very poor condition.

J. W. C. writing from Kansas City tells us that "Chicago received 15,000 head of stock" that day. Chicago receipts that day were 8,943 cattle, 250 calves, 24,926 hogs, 3353 sheep, or a total of 37,452 head of stock instead of 15,000.

The Northwestern pool railroads refused to haul double deck cars last summer in order to strengthen their southwestern roads in their fight against double decks. Therefore when the Chicago Live Stock Exchange influenced the Northwestern railroads to again haul double decks, it took the first and the most important step toward getting double decks in the southwest. But Chicago is not eager for honor and glory. It is sheep she wants, and sheep she will get; that is if owners appreciate quick sales and the highest prices. However it is unjust to Chicago to let pass such statements as those made, Mr. Editor, by your St. Louis correspondent last week. In speaking of the more of the Missouri Pacific authorities looking to the introduction of double decks, he says "This victory belongs wholly to the St. Louis Live Stock Exchange. The Chicago Exchange did nothing." The simple fact is that St. Louis took no hand in it whatever and claims no credit whatever for securing double decks on the Northwestern pool lines, whereas the Chicago Exchange through its committee worked faithfully and well to gain the victory on the Missouri Pacific. St. Louis did good service in this case, after Chicago had led the way. It is not saying too much to say that without the entering wedge of the Northwestern victory achieved by Chicago, the Missouri Pacific would not have adopted double decks for five years.

There is a much better feeling in the commercial world than awhile ago and prospects are brightening all along the line. There never has been a more favorable time for investors to put their money into well situated live stock enterprises. And, on the very stock en-

ry that the time to sell is when "everybody" wants to buy, we should strongly advise all holders of well located live stock interests to hold to them firmly nothing will pay better. The general prospect for the Texas stock market is better now than it has been for two or three years past; things are on a sound hard pan basis and there is bound to be a great demand for all the good stock that can be produced.

The outlook for inferior canning grades of cattle cannot be counted so good. Those who have very many lean, half fat, light steers and cows on this market this summer better have them somewhere else. But don't be afraid of good fat cattle. They will be wanted; a lot of prime 1186 lb yearling shorthorn steers sold at \$10.00 to a Chicago butcher. They were little beauties, "fat as hogs" and fine as silk. Just wait until Texas begins to turn off that kind of beef, at the same time let it be remembered that if half a dozen other men had had just such cattle on the market on the same day, they would not have sold for more than \$5.50. It was the novelty and variety of such fine "baby beef" which caused it to sell higher than many a lot of prime 1400 to 1500 lb steers. Still there is an important lesson in such transactions. Notable among the recent transactions was the sale of 119 head of 650 lb Texas yearling steers at \$4.50. They were owned by the Inter State Galloway Cattle company, of Nebraska. These cattle were just as old as the Illinois yearlings which sold at \$6.00 about the same time. Probably they were not fed with quite the same care, but the main difference was in the blood; one had the capacity to make large beaves early, which the other did not have. Good breeding without good feeding is thrown away on the beef market, but when they join hands in when the results are best.

Can Texas raise good turnips and other root crops? If so there is no reason why more cattle should not be fed in that way. The American farmer thinks corn and grass are the only foods for fattening stock, but they will do well to remember that the Scotch cattle which bring the highest in the British markets never get an ear of corn and precious little grass. Root crops are more reliable, more abundant and cheaper than corn. Grass and corn will probably continue to reign supreme in this country but Texas men who are beginning to raise feed for their stock will do well to consider the values of turnips, rutabagas, beets, carrots, etc.

READING FOR FEEDERS. The Cost of Producing Good Beef. We take from the Country Gentleman the following article as the most conclusive we have yet seen as to the actual cost of producing good beef.

But, happily, our American Fat Stock show, in 1882, offered prizes under the head of "Cost of Production," and the reports of this show will enable us to prove, pretty conclusively, the cost of a steer at three years old.

I will now give from the secretary's report the cost of raising the heaviest steer to three years old—Mammoth, by John D. Gillett, Elkhardt, Illinois.

It will be noted that this steer made a remarkable gain up to 24 months. The first 12 months he gained 1,400 lbs., or 3.81 lbs. per day—the 2d 12 months he gained 850 lbs., or 2.33 lbs. per day.
