Hays-Gibson receive honor

Tommy Hays and Jay Gibson has been awarded the American Farmer Degree, the highest degree presented by the National FI'A Organization. Tommy and Jay was nominated for the degree by the Texas FFA Association. The nomination was approved at a recent meeting of the National FFA Board of Directors in Alexandria, Virginia. Two of the 658 FFA members, Tommy and Jay received the degree in a special ceremony at the 58th National FFA Convention in Kansas City, Missouri. At the convention each American Farmer degree recipient was presented a gold key and certificate.

The American Farmer degree is presented to approximately one member in 600 of the 434,100 member organization. It is presented only by the National FFA Organization to members who have demonstrated exceptional agricultural and leadership achie-

Tommy is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Kenneth Hays and is currently attending Texas Tech University. He earned the American Farmer degree on the basis of his work in swine production and leadership activities.

Jay is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Jerry Gibson and is currently attending Texas Tech University. He earned the American Farmer degree on the basis of his work in livestock and crop production and leadership awards and activities.

The young men's advisors J.T. Naron and Billy Riley point out that to qualify for the American Farmer degree, FFA members must have advanced through a system of degrees unique to the FFA organization. FFA members begin as Greenhands and after one year of membership may be advanced by the local chapter to the degree of "Chapter Farmer". The third degree, that of "Lone Star Farmer", is presented by the Texas FFA Association to not more than two percent of the State's FFA membership in any one year. Merkel has had twenty four in the past eight years. Only students who have earned their prospective State Farmer degree are eligible for the American Farmer degree.
