## NOTICE TO PUBLIC AND MERCHANTS OF KERRVILLE

Effective Monday, Oct. 20th, the Price of Our Bread Will Advance to IOc Per Loat Retail

This increase in price is made necessary by the increased cost of raw materials used in baking. If we don't increase the cost of our product there remains but two alternatives: We can reduce the quality and continue at the old price, or we can close our doors and go out of business. Flour has advanced in the past 45 days $\$ 2.80$ per barrel; shortening $\$ 2.00$ per 100 pounds; milk, $\$ 2.00$ per 100 pounds; sugar, about $\$ 1.00$ per 100 ; besides an increase in the price of commodities used in making good bread.
Kerrville has had bread at the cheapest price of any city or town in Texas, when quality is considered; in fact, the retail price has been on too close a margin for the cost of baking, and with the increased cost of the raw materials we cannot sell the same quality without a substantial loss on each loaf.
There are two classes of bakeries--one in which cheap products are made at a cheap price; the other in which quality is the paramount consideration. You will agree with us that the Kerrville Bakery belongs to the
latter class, and we want to continue in this class, for with us baking is a matter of pride, and as long as we continue in business you may be assured that any goods bought from this bakery will be as good as can be made from the best materials obtainable by the best and most experienced workmen we can obtain.
In conversation with one of our bakers recently, he said: "Mr. Lee, I have been a baker for twenty years and this is the first place where I drew a
salary of $\$ 5.00$ or more per day." We can hire bakers for a salary of $\$ 18$ to $\$ 25$ per week to make cheap bread, but will this help to build either our business, the peop
better Kerrville?

We are proud of the reputation our bread and pastries enjoy and of the patronage the people of Kerrville and community have accorded us. Every day
