**FEDERAL AID GRANTED FOR MASON ROAD IMPROVEMENT BY WINDROW**

STATE ENGINEER GRANTS McCULLOCH COUNTY EXTENSION OF 90 DAYS TO ACT UPON APPROPRIATION OF \$35,000—COMMITTEE GREATLY ENCOURAGED.

County Judge Evans Adkins, Commissioner R. L. Burns, County Surveyor W. P. Doty of Brady, and E. T. Jordan of Melvin, who composed the committee which went to Austin last Thursday seeking Federal Aid for the Mason highway, returned very enthusiastic over the success attending the trip, and report having been assured by the Highway commission that McCulloch county's appropriations for the improvement of the Puget Sound to the Gulf highway through the county would be matched dollar for dollar by the commission, providing formal application for such aid, together with plans and specifications for the road building, were placed before the highway commission within the next 90 days and had received official approval.

The outstanding feature of the committee's visit is the fact that \$35,000 federal aid is available to McCulloch county for this highway, providing McCulloch county can equal this amount by having work under contract within the next 90 days. This sum was appropriated for McCulloch county nearly four years ago, and unless used by June, 1921, will revert to the Federal treasury. This means that if the Melvin road bonds, which were voted in the sum of \$30,000 over three years ago, can be disposed of and the money available for road improvement along this highway, then McCulloch county will be enabled to take advantage of the \$35,000 federal aid offered.

The committee is enthusiastic about the cordial reception given them by Rollen J. Windrow, state highway en-

gineer, Friday, and by his assurance of extending the co-operation and assistance of his department to McCulloch county in her road-building efforts. Mr. Windrow is a former San Sabate, and is a nephew of Sheriff J. C. Wall of Brady. Quite naturally he feels a kindly interest in the McCulloch county section. The committee's visit to Austin was very timely, inasmuch as Mr. Windrow had just made a notation cancelling the McCulloch county appropriation. In order that The Standard readers may fully understand the nature of this Federal aid, the following brief outline is given:

When Congress, nearly four years ago, passed the appropriation granting Federal aid to the various states in their good roads building, Texas was given an appropriation of \$8,000,000. The State Highway department thereupon allotted various amounts to the counties in Texas, McCulloch county being given an appropriation of \$35,000. Dallas county made heretofore to accept the offer.

If the money is not used within the next ten months it will revert to the Federal treasury. Quite naturally the

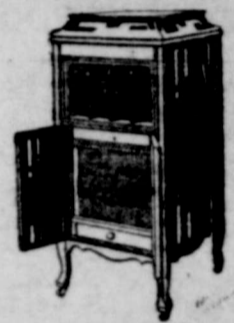
