THE COLORADO RIVER VALLEY RAIL ROAD.

To Be Run From Ballinger Via Robert Lee To Colorado City.

There is a move on foot, with good prospects for success, of the construction of a railroad from Ballinger via Robert Lee to Colorado City, connecting the two roads at the former and latter places. It has long been a recognized fact that a railroad would sooner or later be constructed to connect the Santa Fe and the Texas & Pacific, which will open up an immense freight and passenger traffic between the two lines.

The proposed route will be about 90 miles in length and traverses the fertile Colorado River Valley the entire distance.

The International Promoting Syndicate of New York City is at the head of the enterprise.

They have written some of our citizens, that if the people along the proposed line favor it and believe the road would prove to be a financial success from the start and if they will aid and encourage it to the best of their ability, that they will, without cost to us, send their engineer to look over the situation and will act on his report to them.

Our people have taken hold of the matter with enthusiasm and while we have not yet [Jan. 7] heard from Ballinger and Colorado City, we do not doubt but that they will take hold of the enterprise with the same zeal and earnestness that Robert Lee has manifested. And it is believed further, that all possible encouragement will be extended all along the line, and if this is done it is our opinion that the rail road, the need of which is recognized by all, is assured. A second citizens meeting was held at the court house here last Saturday, Jan. 2, at 2 o'clock p. m. and effected a permanent organization by the election of the following committee:

G. W. Perryman, Chairman, C. C. Merchant, Sec. and S. J. Chapman, D. T. Averitt, L. H. Brightman, W. F. Buchanan and W. C. Merchant.

The following minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved:

"Whereas, Horace A. Garland and F. W. Holmes, members of the International Promoting Syndicate of the city of New York, have opened up correspondence with some of the citizens of Coke county with the view of building a rail road from Ballinger, Bunnels county, Texas, by way of Robert Lee, in Coke county, Texas to the Texas and Pacific at Colorado City, in Mitchell county, Texas; and

Whereas the citizens of Robert Lee held a meeting in said town on the 30th day of December to discuss the propriety of the enterprise and to ascertain the views of the citizens on the subject; and whereas it was agreed to appoint a committee to correspond with the citizens of Ballinger, Texas and to go to Texas to learn

the probabilities of the rail road named herein being a paying route.

The names of the committeemen appointed by said meeting are: G. W. Perryman, J. W. Reed, L. H. Brightman, A. P. McCarty and S. J. Chapman.

After the appointment of this committee the citizens passed resolutions favoring the enterprise, agreeing to assist all in their limited pecuniary means, pledging their personal assistance and influence.

The meeting also passed a resolution asking the COKE COUNTY RUSTLER, a weekly news paper published in Robert Lee, to publish the proceedings of said meeting, and that the committee furnish the said Messrs. Garland and Holmes with a copy of said news paper."

Mad Dogs.

Ed. Rustler:

Perhaps it would be well to let the people know how much danger we are in from mad dogs.

Lee Walker who moved from McCulloch county back to Coke county last month brought a dog that had been bitten by a mad dog some two months before he started.

Lee kept the dog tied 20 odd days to see if he would go mad. As the dog showed no signs of being affected from the bite he brought the dog along.

The dog fought his first dog at Oak Creek on the Ballinger and Lee road, Tuesday, Dec. 22nd 1896 and staid with the wagon all that day, whipping every dog they met. They passed through Bronate and Robert Lee that day and camped that night at the Snyder gin, where the dog had a great many fights with dogs during the night. He was gone the next morning, but we heard of him at Messrs Gosses, Connors, Shaffers and Coopers and he passed on westward through Colorado City, biting everything that got in his way. No person has been bitten as yet that that we know of. Some people are killing their dogs, while others are waiting to see if they go mad.

Why did not Lee Walker kill his dog when he was first bitten? I answer, because he thought maybe so that dog was not, and if it was, mine may not go mad. He is such a good dog I hate to kill him.

Other people are doing the same way now, who know their dogs are liable to go crazy any day. Hoping that we may be able to capture all the others when they first start.

How A Horse Swims.

It must not be supposed that a horse always swims naturally and with ease, the moment he is off his feet in the water. The animal under such circumstances has but one motion to keep his head out of water and to lift his shoulders as high as possible.

In doing this his hind quarters sink and he finds himself almost standing on his tail, or at least in a position three quarters erect.

In such an attitude, if the rider draws up the reins or throws his body back in the least the animal's hind quarters will sink more and more, his body will take a vertical position, and heaving the water uselessly with his forefeet, he will finally sink.

As soon as the horse gets off his feet in the water, let the rider grasp the animal's mane, leaning at the same time well forward upon his shoulders, but without touching his head. The rider's knees should be pressed tightly to the horse's sides, otherwise he is likely to be swept off by the water.

This is the only position which will enable a man to remain in the saddle and the horse to swim at the same time. The reins must be held loosely and each well to one side.
